## HART 3，El Dorado 1：HIGHLIGHTS \＆PLAY BY Play of Game：\＆Rule Book Info．

3－18－00 Baseball－Hart Splits a Double header with Orange County powerhouse El Dorado．
Hart only got 9 hits all day，but managed to get a split with the Golden Hawks trom Paiecentia in Orange county． With a littie luck they could have won both games．

Second Game HART 3 EI Dorado 1.
Junıor pıtcher Jett Witcomb who had only pıtched 1 varsity inning against Mary Star took a 0．00 ERA into the 2nd game against one ot the top rated teams in the Southern Section，and didn＇t disappoint anyone，except El Dorado． went 3 up 3 down in every one of his 6 innings against the Golden Hawks except in the 3rd when El Dorado managed 2 walks and a single by Justin McCauley to squeak across 1 run．Witcomb gave up a single in the 1st to scrappy El Dorado second baseman Zac Mullinax，but got him erased in a double play．In the 5th McCauley got his second hit a bunt single，went to second on a wild pitch，but was gunned down trying to steal 3rd，by Brandon Montemayor．
Meanwhile El Dorado pıtcher Mıke Droste was getting the 1st 10 outs on ground balls and was making it look easy． Only Ryan Haag was doing any hitting with an opening single and a ringing double to lett center．Hart tinally tied the game in the 5 th when Marke Horvat（who homered the previous day against Canyon），comıng out ot a mild siump hit a leadott homer to right center．In the bottom ot the 6th Hart tinally took the lead．With 1 out Bill Susdort walked， Joe Alolsi ran tor him，and promptiy stole 2nd．Matt Friedrichsen was hit by a pitch．Brandon Montemayor then lined a single to right center scoring Aloisi and sending Friedrichsen to 3rd．Evan Anderson ran tor Montemayor．Then Hart got a gitt when pıtcher Droste dropped the bail as he was startıng to delıver the 1st pıtch to Marke Horvat．The Baık scored Friedrichsen to make it 3－1．

In the top of the 7 th Hart brought 1 n Bill Susdort who has become the ace cıoser on the Hart statt with 18 strikeouts in 9.2 ınnıngs．Susdort got the cleanup hitter Mıcan Hazen on called strikes，and gave up a single to Brett Marro who went to 2nd on a wild pitch．But Susdort reared back and got Brian Hott and Justin Angevine on swinging strikes．
