## Page 3: HIGHLIGHTS & PLAY BY Play of Game: Corona Centennial & Hart:

Final Score Centennial Corona 5 Hart 4. This is Hart's 78th loss vs 302 victory's since 1987. This is the 1st time Hart has played Centennial Corona, which is the 119th different opponent they have played since 1987. In Playoff Games since 1987, Hart is 20-12.

Hart has played in the QuarterFinal game 5 times since 1987, and won it 2 times. In 1989 they beat Buena 10-7, and in 1999 they beat Royal 8-4. Both times they also won the Semi Final game and went to the finals. In 1989 they lost to Cerritos at Dodger Stadium 4-1. In 1999 they went to Anaheim Stadium to beat Righetti 10-9.

They have lost the Q-Final game 3 times, and ALL IN EXTRA INNINGS. In 1994 they lost in 9 innings at Rio Mesa 1-0. In 1997 they lost in 10 innings at West Torrance. This year (2000), they lost in 11 innings 5-4 to Centennial/Corona.

Hart ran into a very good left handed Centennial Corona pitcher Mike Stodolka who will be a high draft choice. Centennial scored a run in the 2nd as the result of an error. In the 3rd, they scored 2 more on another error which was followed by a line drive homer to right by Stodolka. The homer was his 17th of the season, and 35th of his career. The 3 run lead was short lived however. In the Hart 3rd, a walk by Matt Moore, single by Ryan Haag was then followed by a 3 run homer by Mike Miller, his 2nd homer of the season.

The 3-3 Tie lasted until the 11th. In the meantime the game from the 3rd thru the 7th settled into a pitchers duel between Stodolka and Eric Posthumus. Several balls hit by both teams would have been homers on ordinary days, but a stiff wind blowing in from center held the long balls into outs. Matt Friedrichsen had 7 putouts in centerfield, which may be a record for a Hart outfielder, however the record for most putouts in a game is held by Tom Wolff a catcher with 17 in 1990 vs Culver City.

Hart's main problem was Stodolka, who came up all of his 6 times at bat with men on base. Hart made 2 pitching changes just to counter him, but he would up on base all 6 times. He wound up with a Homer, 2 singles and 3 walks (2 intentional). Stodolka pitched 8 innings. Hart blew a big chance to win it in the 8th when they had the bases loaded and 1 out, but Brandon Montemayor grounded to 2nd and the lead runner was out at the plate. A strikeout by Matt Friedrichsen followed to end the inning. The victory went to Rafael Torres who started at Shortstop.

Jamie Shields relieved Posthumus in the top of the 7th with 2 outs, and pitched until 2 out in the 11th when he had used up his remaining eligibility of 4 innings due to having pitched 6 innings on Tuesday vs Calexico. He left with a man on 2nd, Brian Richards who had been hit by a pitch, was sacrificed to 2nd, and Stodolka was due up.

Bill Susdorf came in to pitch and intentionally walked Stodolka putting runners on 1st and 2nd. A passed ball moved the runners to 2nd and 3rd. Then Sean Dunne hit a very high fly to short left center, and the wind got hold of it and it fell just out of reach of shortstop Matt Moore, and 2 runs scored making it 5-3.

Hart came roaring back in the bottom of the 11th when Brandon Montemayor and Matt Friedrichsen singled, and Marke Horvat walked to load the bases with none out. Chris Gagnon then hit into a 4-6-3 double play, scoring Montemayor to make it 5-4.. Matt Moore then grounded to 1st ending Hart's hope of repeating as CIF-SS Division 2 Champions.

This was the longest game since 1987. Hart previously had played two 10 inning games vs Burbank on 4/16/91, and against Saugus on 4/28/94.

Other Team Records Tied, 41 opponent At Bats, and 49 Batters faced, done previously by West Torrance in another Quarter Final Defeat on 5/30/97.

Another Team Record Tied was 2 opponents Intentionally walked. This has been done 9 times previously, the last time was in a playoff game vs Quartz Hill in on 5/19/1995.

In the 5th with Sean Dunne batting and his brother Kevin Dunne on third, Sean hit a line drive that struck his brother while he was standing in foul territory, and was injured and had to be removed from the game. His replacement Reggie Johnson later got a single, and in the 11th he was hit by a pitch and later scored the lead run.
