## HIGHLIGHTS of Game 02-05: Hart 7 - Narbonne 0

G\#02-05 Hart beats Narbonne 7-0, Chris Valaika 3-3, 3 runs, 4 RBI, Triple, Double.
Chad Smith pitches another gem, 6 innings, 0 runs, 3 hits, 5k's.
Hart pitching continues to shine early in the 2002 season. The Hart batters finally got things going today against the Narbonne Gauchos. Narbonne is a City Section team, and plays in the Marine league against teams like San Pedro (who we beat Tuesday 9-1), Carson, Banning, Gardena and Washington.

Chris Valaika who got the first Hart triple in almost 2 years against Chatsworth on Thursday, came back with another today (Saturday 3/9/2002) at Hart in an 11am game for 3rd place in the Westside Tournament (Red Division). Narbonne reached this game with the same $3-1$ record as Hart, with their starting pitcher Craig Ganser sporting a $2-0$ record.

Chris had a good day going 3 for 3 with a single, double, triple and for good measure hit a line drive deep to center that was caught, but he got a Sacrifice Fly RBI, so the at bat wasn't wasted. In addition he scored 3 times and drove in 4 runs from the leadoff spot.

Chad Smith had another excellent pitching performance going 6 innings with out a run, so he still hasn't given up an earned run in $12 \& 2 / 3$ innings. Chad gave up only 3 singles, one was a blooper, another was of the infield variety, \& few balls were hit hard off him. He struck out 5 and walked 1.

Kyle Boggio made his varsity pitching debut in relief in the 7 th, \& struck out 2 walked 1 . One batter reached base on an error, but he got a ground out to end the game.

As said the Hart batters hitting only . 240 as a team, finally got things going. They wound up with 12 hits. Besides Valaika, Mike Alvarado was 2 for 3 with 2 RBI's, Craig Cohen 2 for 3, 1 RBI. Andy Sevanian 2 for 4 with a double, scored 1 run. J.P. Slauenwhite 1 for 3, double, 1 run scored. Chris Steck 1 for 2 with 2 runs scored. Todd Wilson had a single, and a sacrifice bunt.

Hart scored in the 1st when Chris Valaika opened with a sharp single to left, was sacrificed to 2 nd on a bunt by Mike Alvarado, and scored on a 2 out single to right by Craig Cohen.

In the 2nd, Chris Steck walked, was singled to second by Andy Sevanian, took 3rd on a bunt single by Todd Wilson, and scored on Valaika's line drive (sacrifice fly).

In the 4 th, Hart picked up 2 runs: Sevanian doubled to left center, knocking Narbonne starter Genser out of the game. Steve Drury relieved. Sevanian was sacrificed to 3rd by Wilson, and trotted home on a double by Valaika. Valaika then reached $3 r d$ on a wild pitch and scored on a single by Alvarado.

Hart finished up with 3 runs in the 5th: Chris Steck opened with a single, \& took 3rd on a double by J.P. Slauenwhite to deep center. 2 outs later, Valaika unloaded his triple to center, scoring Steck and Slauenwhite. Mike Alvarado then singled sharply to center scoring Valaika, and that brought in a new pitcher Robert Chavira to stop any further threat.

In the 6th, Hart pinch hitters Paxton Howard and Danny Williams walked, but Chavira then pitched his way out of further trouble.

Hart opens the Foothill League season vs Burroughs, starting on Friday 3/15/2002 at 3:15pm at Hart.
Notes on the Chatsworth game. Besides the record tying 4 hit batters by J.P. Slauenwhite, it also tied a Hart "Team" record of 4. When Andrew Lorraine hit 4 Long Beach Poly batters on 3/10/89, Hart won that game 13-5. On $4 / 21 / 00$ vs Canyon, at Canyon pitchers Jamie Shields and Phil Tognetti each hit 2 batters. 2 of the 4 batters scored in that game, and Hart lost 3-2.

Ex Hart baseball coach Bud Murray made another appearance to watch his old team play.
