#### PAGE 3: HIGHLIGHTS of Game 02-13: Hart 7 - Arlington/Riverside 13 (OC Tourney)

G#02-13 Hart loses to Arlington 13-7 in Villa Park Tourney opener. Hart fell behind early 6-1 then fought back to tie Arlington 7-7 after 4, but that was the last scoring Hart could accomplish, as Arlington scoring in every inning except the 2nd. to trounce Hart 13-7 in the opening game of the Villa Park Tournament, played at Villa Park High.

The Villa Park field is a beautiful field where Hart won the championship of this tournament last year. The dimensions are quite large, although there are no distance markers posted on any of the walls. Because of the distance to the outfield walls, the fielders seem to be playing in close.

Chris Valaika was 2 for 4 with a walk, scored 2, drove in 2, and crashed his 4th homer (3rd in the last 3 games). Danny Williams was 2 for 4 with a triple, scored 1, drove in 1. John Curtis 2 for 3 with a walk and his 5th double, scored 1 and drove in 1. Valaika's homers in 3 straight games (against Burbank, Saugus and Arlington), is one off the Hart record of 4 straight games set by the late Nolan Lemar in 1999. Nolan hit 4 homers in his career and they were in consecutive games against Saugus (4/27/99), Saugus (4/30/99), Burroughs (5/4/99) and Burroughs (5/7/1999).

Kyle Boggio started for Hart. In the first, Arlington scored 2, when leadoff batter Gary Dudrey was hit by pitch and rode home on a long homer to right by left handed batter, 1st baseman Joe Reyes.

Hart picked up a run in the 2nd when Danny Williams opened with a triple down the right field line, and 2 outs later scored on a double over the centerfielders head by John Curtis.

In the 4th Boggio was chased after giving up 2 doubles, 2 singles and a walk. Jeff Icenogle came in to get a out on a grounder to 3rd, and then got an unusual double play although a run scored. With 1 out and men on 2nd and 3rd Pat Taylor lifted a sacrifice fly to right fielder Chris Steck. The runner at 3rd tagged up and scored, and the runner at 2nd tagged up and went to 3rd. Hart appealed that the runner going from 2nd to 3rd had left 2nd too early, and the umpire agreed and he was declared out. At first the run was removed from the board, but after much discussion and consulting the rule book the run was put back, so Hart was now behind 6-1.

Hart began a comeback in the 3rd, scoring 3. Valaika and Jason Brown opened with walks, and Chris Giordano flared a single to right loading the bases. Craig Cohen singled to center scoring Valaika, and with 1 out and the bases loaded, Chris Steck hit a double play grounder to short, but after forcing Cohen at 2nd, the second baseman threw the ball away trying to complete the double play, with Brown scoring on the force play, and Giordano scoring on the error.

Arlington scored a run off Icenogle in the 4th, on 2 walks, a balk and wild pitch setting the lead runner Kyle Gible in position to score on a slow fielders choice grounder to short.

Hart tied it up 7-7 with 3 runs in the 4th, when Curtis opened with a single to right and was sacrificed to 2nd by Todd Wilson. Chris Valkaika then hit a long 2 run homer to left. After Brown walked and Giordano was hit by pitch, Cohen just got under a pitch and flied deep to left. Williams singled to right scoring Brown. Steck ended the inning with a deep drive to right, but with the score now tied 7-7, Hart was looking like they could take this game.

Arlington immediately answered back in the 5th against Icenogle when Larry Mendoza opened with a homer to left to take an 8-7 lead.

Hart went down in the 5th although Curtis hit one deep to center that was hauled in at the wall. That was it for Hart, but Arlington was not through.

In the 6th, with 1 out, 2 straight singles brought in J.P.Slauenwhite who immediately induced a ground ball to 3rd, but an error scored 1 run, and when the following batter Reyes singled to center, and the ball went through the centerfielders legs 2 more runs scored. Mendoza then singled in the 4th run of the inning, and Hart was now behind 12-7.

Ian Feldman came in to pitch the 7th, and the opening batter was safe on an error by the shortstop Valaika. Feldman then unleashed a wild pitch sending the runner Geno Lunetta to 2nd, and then he committed a balk sending him to 3rd. Ian then got 2 quick strikeouts, but gave up a ground ball single to the right side by pinch hitter Chris Lopez scoring Lunetta.

Final score Arlington 13, Hart 7.

In the game played before the Hart game, Villa Park won in the bottom of the 7th 10-9 over Los Alamitos. Hart next plays Los Alamitos on Monday at 11am. Last year Hart beat Arlington in this tournament 11-6.

When Hart played in the Championship game in 1999 at 4:30pm, in the Division 2 game, Arlington was waiting in the wings to play in the Division 1 game at 7:30pm. Like Hart, They were the winners also.

In case you haven't heard, next Year a new Southern Section rule will revert the Baseball Playoffs to what they had been prior to 1997. The Playoff divisions will be based on strength of League, and all teams in the league will be in the same division. This rule applies to all sports that do not declare a State Champion. Thus Baseball & Football will be by League strength. Basketball, Track and most other sports where a State Championship is played for is determined by enrollment.

Thus the 6 Foothill League teams will play in the same division. Currently the Playoff division a team plays in is determined by enrollment. Thus Valencia plays in Div 1. Hart, Canyon, and Saugus are in Div 2, and Burroughs and Burbank are in Div. 3

In past years when the same rule was in effect, the Foothill league was mostly in Division 2, however because of Hart they played up into Division 1 in 1991 and 1992 (they called it 5a in those years). They dropped to Div 3 in 1995 and 1996, and have been in Div 2 according to enrollment since 1997.
