HIGHLIGHTS of Game 02-20: Hart 1 - Canyon 2 (Foothill League)

G#02-20 Hart clipped by Canyon Hart 2-1

A key Hit batsman moved the lead run into scoring position and Hart lost 2-1 to Canyon, thus failing to take over first place in the Foothill League. Late news Jimmy Rohan of Valencia hit a 3 run homer in the 7th to down Saugus 11-8, thus probably dropping Hart to 3rd in the Foothill League.

First place Canyon 16-3 (7-2) avoided a sweep by Hart 11-8-1 (5-3-1) when they scored in the bottom of the 5th inning breaking a 1-1 tie. Winning Pitcher Sergio Almanzar scattered 4 hits, got a key double play in the 7th to end the game.

The Hart crowd was roaring starting the top of the 7th down 2-1. John Curtis led off with a sharp single to left center, and Jake Coash was warming up. As it turned out, he probably would not have come into the game, because I was told by a reporter covering the game who interviewed Coash afterwards, that while warming up in the bull pen he had nothing" so it was Alamnzars game to win or lose.

After Curtis singled, he was sacrificed to 2nd by Danny Williams. Chris Valaika came to bat, and they tried to get him to bite on 2 wide ones, but when he refused, they walked him intentionally. Andy Sevanian pinch hit for Jason Brown and hit one past the mound right at the 2nd base bag, where it was picked up by Canyon shortstop Ryan Burke who stepped on 2nd forcing Valaika and doubled Sevanian easily at first to end the game.

The game started out with Almanzar getting the first 3 Hart batters on ground balls. In the Canyon first Won Yoo gave up an opening single to Ryan Pipho, who then stole 2nd, and moved to 3rd on a groundout. Eric Ashbrook walked and on a double steal attempt, Hart Catcher Giordano fired toward 2nd, but pitcher Yoo leapt high to snag the throw, and then fired to 3rd to catch Pipho trying to scamper back to the bag. Just when it looked like Yoo was going to escape the 1st unscathed, he walked Ryan Burke, and then he gave up a single to Clay Britton, scoring Ashbrook. Score Canyon 1-0

Hart failed to score in the 2nd despite putting the first 2 batters on base, but a failed sacrifice, followed by a strikeout and a pop foul to the catcher ended any further threat.

In the Canyon 3rd, the Cowboys hit the ball hard, but Hart fielders who played errorless ball throughout, kept Yoo and Hart in the game. Almanzar hit a deep drive to center and Jason Brown made a nice catch running it down. Eric Ashbrook then hit a screaming liner to right, but before it cleared the infield, 2nd baseman Mike Alvarado made a super diving catch. After a sharp base hit to left by Ryan Burke, Clay Britton hit a hard line drive on which 3rd baseman Todd Wilson made a leaping catch to end the inning.

Hart finally got on the board in the 4th. With 2 out, Chris Steck blasted a long home run to the deepest part of the ball park, over the wall in left center field near the scoreboard. The distance is 385 feet and it was still going up when it cleared the wall and finally landed in the street. It was Steck's 3rd homer of the year.

In the Hart 5th there was a moment when it looked like 2 players were possibly badly injured. John Curtis led off being hit by pitch. Danny Williams then hit a potential double play grounder near 2nd base. As Curtis was running toward 2nd, Canyon 2nd baseman Josh Schreck crossed into his path to pick up the grounder, and both players collided and each went flying in opposite directions, and both players had their "bells rung". Eventually both recovered, and stayed in the game. Curtis was out for failing to avoid the fielder. Hart failed to score in the inning.

Canyon came to bat in the bottom of the 5th in a 1-1 tie. Up to this point they had threatened in every inning, leaving 6 men on base. Won Yoo walked the leadoff batter Almanzar, and coach Ozella decided to take him out. In came Hart ace closer/reliever Jeff Icenogle.

Icenogle hit Ashbrook, and runners were now on 1st and 2nd. Burk hit to short, but Hart could not convert the double play and got only a force at 2nd of Ashbrook. Clay Britton then executed a perfect squeeze bunt to score Almanzar with the lead run, and Britton beat out the bunt for a hit without a play. A groundout and a strikeout ended any further damage but Canyon now had a 2-1 lead and Jake Coash was warming up.

In the Canyon 6th, Icenogle hit 2 more batters, to make it 4 hit batsman by Hart pitchers in the game. This tied the record of 4, and was the 3rd time this year Hart pitchers have hit 4 batters in a game. Since 1987 it has happened 5 times, and 3 of them this year. The previous season record for Hart pitchers hitting batters was 22 in 1996. Going into this game Hart pitchers had already hit 24 batters. So with 4 more in this game Hart pitchers have now hit 28 batters, and there is a minimum of 6 more games to play.

All in all despite the close score, Hart didn't really seem to be in the game. Canyon only had 5 hits (all singles) to 4 by Hart (3 singles 1 homer). But Canyon benefited by 4 walks and 4 hit batsmen and left 10 men on base.

The Hart hits: Craig Cohen singled to left in the 2nd. Chris Valaika singled to center in the third. Steck homered to left in the 4th, and Curtis hit a long single to left center in the 7th.

Clay Britton had to hits and drove in both Canyon runs. Canyon pitcher Almanzar gave up 1 run in 7 innings, 4 hits struck out 3 and walked 3.

For Hart: Won Yoo [2-1] was the losing pitcher gave up 4 hits in 4 innings, struck out 3 walked 4, hit 1. Icenogle gave 1 hit struck out 1, hit 3 batters.

Hart next plays on Tuesday 4/23/02 at Hart vs Burbank at 3:15pm. Just before the Easter break, Burbank almost upended Canyon, losing only 4-3, so don't count on anything in the very tough Foothill League.

Interesting note: Chris Valaika has had 3 first inning leadoff homers this year against Saugus, Valencia and Canyon. Since 1987, it has been rare that we have had power hitters leading off. Billy Susdorf led off in 2001, but only hit 4 homers last year. Lance Migita had power, but hit only 6 in 4 years, 5 in 1990.
