HIGHLIGHTS of Game 02-22: Hart 12 - Burbank 0 (Foothill League)

G#02-22 Hart 12 Burbank 0 on Fri 4/26/02 (a)

Despite the 12-0 final score, Hart actually had to pull this one out of a close game for 5 innings. Back only a few years ago in 2000 Hart played Burbank at Burbank and scored 11 in the first and 11 in the 2nd on the way to a 5 inning mercy rule 26-0 No Hitter.

Then at Hart a few weeks later they Mercyied them again in 6 innings 11-0.

So who would have expected them to have a hard time 3 days later when they faced them again at Burbank with the short center and right center field fence only a pop up away from a home run. The scoring rule has changed since then at Burbank and those "former" short homers are now doubles.

Amazingly Burbank gave Hart all they could handle as Hart struggled and held only a 3-2 lead going into the top of the 7th and the possibility loomed that defending CIF-SS Champion Hart could be up-ended by the Foothill League "doormat" Burbank. Finally Hart threw a big 11 on the Board in the top of the 7th, & closed Burbank out 14-12

This one on Friday 4-26-02 was just a little different. Won Yoo started and obviously had all his pitches working especially his fast ball which was clocked on the speed gun, topping out at 88mph.

Problem was Burbank brought along their fielding gloves this time, and all the good fielding plays were turned in by Burbank. They went errorless in the field, and some of their plays were spectacular. Their centerfielder ran into the concrete base of the left centerfield wall trying to chase down a double off the bat of Craig Cohen in the 5th, with his team trailing only 4-0. After a delay, he got up and continued in the game. Cohen later scored on a double over the centerfield fence by Chris Steck to make it 5-0. By the way this ball that Steck hit would have gone out of every park Hart has ever played in, however it went out to the right of the Yellow marker, and the ground rules here now call that one a Ground Rule Double.

So Won Yoo took his 4 run lead into the 5th inning, and promptly walked the first batter of the inning Mike Pacheco. Most of his pitches to Pacheco were high which brought out coach Jim Ozella to the mound for a conference. Coach Ozella let him stay in, and he was promptly greeted by Burbank catcher Romeo Papazyan with a line single to center. It was only the 2nd hit off Won, but, it looked like he might be done.

Won as he is capable of doing, then struck out Marco Foschetti for his 7th strikeout of the game, and then got leadoff batter Paul Gonzalez to pop out to short, so it looked like Won was going to escape the 5th unscathed. But when the #2 batter Jesus Sarabia walked on 4 pitches that were almost over his head, Coach Ozella came out to the mound, and that meant Won was gone.

The bases were now loaded, and the tying run was in the on deck circle. In came Hart ace reliever Jeff Icenogle, who promptly blew away the #3 batter Rene Gonzalez on strikes to get Hart out of the tight situation.

The Burbank starting pitcher Jon Bertain had up through the 4th inning kept the Hart nine pretty much in check, and as said earlier he was certainly helped by the Burbank fielders. He gave up 3 runs in the 1st inning. Singles by Chris Valaika and Jason Brown, and a sacrifice bunt by Mike Alvarado put runners on 2nd and 3rd, and the DH Craig Cohen drove in Valaika and Brown with a double to left center.

Hart was hitting the ball hard and far, but the fielding was keeping Burbank in the game. Bertain only struck out 1, but in the 4th, he got in trouble due to wildness when he walked John Curtis and Andy Sevanian. Valaika singled loading the bases, and Curtis scored on a fielders choice RBI by Danny Williams (pinch hitting for Jason Brown), to make it 4-0.

In the 5th, Bertain was replaced by Ivan Novak who Hart had pretty much manhandled in his 2 previous appearances. As mentioned previously, he gave up 1 run in the 5th on the Cohen and Steck Doubles.

In the 6th, the roof fell in on him.

He opened with a walk to Sevanian, and Valaika singled Sevanian to 2nd. Jason Brown re-entered and doubled scoring Sevanian and Valaika. Mike Alvarado singled, and then the biggest hit of the day came when Craig Cohen hit a 3 run bomb into the street in straight away left. I think a passing car now has a nice dent on the hood. This being a very cold day for baseball, now had most of the Burbank fans heading out of the ball yard.

With Hart now leading 10-0, Jeff Icenogle walked the cleanup batter Jonathan Suarez, leading off in the 6th. After a fly out he then had to face Daniel Harris. In previous games Harris had been the entire offense for Burbank. In Tuesday's game he went 3 for 3, driving in their only run, and a few weeks ago he was 1 for 2 with 2 walks and drove in all their runs. In this game he had been up 2 times and struck out both times. This time he hit into a very quick 1-6-3 double play.

In the 7th Hart pinch hitters got their chance to shine. Kyle Boggio (hitting for Sevanian) led off, and we can now call him "DOUBLE OR NOTHING". Kyle has 3 hits all season, and you guessed it, all 3 have been doubles. JP Slauenwhite hitting for Valaika walked. Jason Brown got his 2nd double of the game scoring Ky.Boggio, and Chad Smith, pinch hitting for Alvarado hit a sacrifice fly to left scoring Slauenwhite.

Ryan Ozella then pinch hit for Cohen and singled to center for his first varsity hit.

Hart settled for the 2 runs to make it 12-0.

In the bottom of the 7th the only Hart player out of 20 who had not made an appearance in the game, Ian Feldman took the mound. Note once doing so, the pitching "Save" that Icenogle would have gotten had he finished the game was removed. Feldman who has pitched very well in all of his few pitching chances, immediately got 2 quick outs on a nifty first baseman to pitcher covering play, and then got a strikeout. With one out to go and on a very cold day, he got a little wild and walked 2 straight batters, and with the heart of the Burbank order due up, it looked like the shutout was history. Ian reached back & got a grounder to 3rd baseman Todd Wilson, to put this one away for Hart.

Hitting Stars:

Craig Cohen 3 for 4, 2 doubles, 1 homer, scored 3, drove in 5. Jason Brown 3-4, 2 doubles, drove in 3. Chris Steck 2 for 3 with 2 walks, 1 double, 2 RBI. Chris Valaika 4 for 4 raising his average to .446.

The Foothill League race is tightening up, as Saugus upended Canyon, and with Valencia putting Burroughs away, it now becomes a 3 way race for the Foothill league Crown. Canyon and Valencia are tied for first with 8-3 records, and Hart is 1/2 game behind due to that "messy" 4-4 tie to Burroughs, with a 7-3-1 record.

Another team still in the race is Saugus who Hart plays on Tuesday 4-3-02 at Hart, and again on Friday 5-3-2002.
