HIGHLIGHTS of Game 02-23: Hart 6 - Saugus 5 (Foothill League)

G#02-23 Hart comes from behind on Cohen Grand Slam, hangs on beats Saugus 6-5

Hart was completely outplayed in this one but managed to pull off the victory. They were out hit 8-3, but took advantage of everything Saugus gave to them. The 3 Hits were all converted into runs, and 3 of the 4 walks they got were also scored. One walk to Chris Giordano in the 2nd was erased when he was caught stealing.

Thus Hart left NO runners on base, which set an all time record. Previously Hart had left 1 runner on base against Claremont on 1990, El Dorado in 1995, Loyola in 1998, and Saugus in 2000. Hart won 3 of those previous games, only losing to El Dorado.

Craig Cohen was the hitting star for the second game in a row, as he hit his 2nd Grand Slam of the season. His previous Slam was also against Saugus, but in that game, Hart had things well in hand, easily whipping Saugus 18-5 in that game. This one came in the 5 run 3rd with Hart losing 4-1 and gave Hart a 5-4 lead which they never relinquished, but they were always hanging on as Saugus put men on base in every inning but the 6th, while Hart went 3 up 3 down in 4 out of 6 innings.

Saugus fielded flawlessly; Hart committed 2 errors, one of which resulted in a score. In the first inning JP Slauenwhite pitching for Hart, got a pop up from the 1st batter, Josh Fogle who has one of the highest batting averages in the entire SF Valley and all other Valleys in the area for that matter. After that JP was in trouble. Luke Ajer looped a single to center, just out of the reach of the diving Jason Brown. Matt Underwood then crashed a long double to left center, scoring Ajer from first. Matt Romero then singled sharply to left, but Underwood could only advance to 3rd. After Matt Hughes popped out foul to catcher Chris Giordano, JP was able to get out of the inning with a force out on Adam Tripp.

JP got 2 strikeouts on the 2nd, and it looked like he was back on his game, but in the 3rd he opened by hitting Ajer, and wild pitched him to 2nd. Underwood singled to left sending Ajer to 3rd. Romero hit a sacrifice fly to center scoring Ajer. Hughes then hit a long double to the wall in left center, scoring Underwood, and when the relay to the plate was wide and got away from everyone, Hughes took 3rd, and then scored on a wild pitch, to make the score 4-0 Saugus.

Meantime Saugus starting pitcher Josh Fogel put down the first 6 Hart Batters, although he did walk Giordano in the 2nd, he was erased attempting to steal. In the 3rd down 4-0, with 1 out, John Curtis walked, and was wild pitched to 2nd. Danny Williams walked, but when Chris Valaika hit a lazy fly to center, it was now 2 on but 2 out. Jason Brown lined a single to left, with 2 outs the runners were moving on anything, and thus Curtis scored and Williams took 2nd. Score was now 4-1 Saugus. Mike Alvarado worked a walk to load the bases, and Craig Cohen unloaded his 5th homer on the season over the left field fence for a Grand Slam homer to make it Hart 5, Saugus 4.

JP Slauenwhite then took the mound in the 4th needing to get through the inning to get the victory if Hart could hold the lead the rest of the way. After getting a grounder to 3rd on the first batter, Fogle lined a single to center, and then JP hit Ajer again. Coach Ozella, knew it wasn't JP's day, and took him out in favor of Ace Hart reliever Jeff Icenogle. The Ice man then got a come backer to the mound and he converted it into a quick 1-6-3 double play, and Hart was out of the jam.

In the Hart 4th, Saugus now behind 5-4 brought in Matt Hughes to relieve Josh Fogel. Hart then manufactured a run that was to prove to be decisive. Chris Steck beat out a chopper single to short, and was wild pitched to 2nd. Todd Wilson bunted, but the ball was right back to the pitcher, and Steck had to hold 2nd while Wilson was thrown out. After Curtis struck out for the 2nd out, Danny Williams came to bat. While Williams was at the plate, pitcher Hughes uncorked 2 wild pitches enabling Steck to move to 3rd and then score a run to put Hart ahead 6-4.

Icenogle took the 6-4 lead into the 5th, and got the first batter Romero to line out to left. Matt Hughes then bombed one over the left field fence, and the score was now 6-5, Hart. The Iceman then got the next 2 batters. Ice also got a 3 up 3 down inning in the 6th.

Hart batters were not actually able to touch Hughes for anything. After the infield scratch single by Steck leading off in the 4th and eventually scoring, he got 9 consecutive outs, so the game went into the top of the 7th with Hart holding a slim 6-5 lead.

Icenogle got a pop up to 2nd by Ager, and Underwood squibbed one to John Curtis for an easy out at first. So with 2 down, and no one out, apparently Saugus had Hart right where they wanted them. No one at the ball field felt this game was over, and true to form it wasn't. Romero walked, and Hughes singled to right for his 3rd hit of the game sending Romero to 3rd. The dangerous Adam Tripp worked the Iceman for a walk to load the bases and none of his pitches were close.

Up came Justin Tuttle. Tuttle had a pinch hit single in the first game at Saugus, but in this game he had struck out twice and popped out to the catcher. However Icenogle was now wild, and Tuttle, small in stature looked like he was going to walk as he went to a 3-1 count and all 3 of the balls were high over his head. Tuttle swung at the next pitch and fouled it off, and thus on a 3-2 count, 2 out bases loaded and the runners moving on the pitch, he hit a routine grounder to 2nd as complete silence took over Murray Field. Mike Alvarado handled the bouncer cleanly but there was no sound until the ball was thrown successfully to John Curtis at first ending the game with Hart winning 6-5.

Icenogle got the win to improve his record to 3-5, he gave up 2 hits 1 run in 3 and 2/3 innings. The 2 hit batters increased the Hart pitcher hit batters to 30. The previous high was 22 in 1996

Hart faces Saugus at Saugus on Friday May 3 at 3:15pm. Next week Hart closes out the season with 2 games against Burroughs. Tuesday at Burroughs, and Friday at Hart. Hart is hoping to sweep all of their 3 remaining games. Canyon and Valencia, both currently tied for 1st place will be playing each other in 2 games next week. If they split their pair of games and Hart wins all 3 of theirs, then 1st place would belong to Hart. We will have to see how this all plays out.
