## PAGE 3: 03/17/2004 @ Birmingham High School HIGHLIGHTS of Game 04-07: Hart 4 - West Torrance 5 (2nd. Game Dbl. Hdr.)

Hart batters strike out 13 times, drops 2nd game to West Torrance 5-4, at Birmingham High.
After Hart lost the 1st game against West Torrance 6-5 at Hart, both teams hit the freeway to get to the 2 nd game at Birmingham High School in the San Fernando Valley in Van Nuys.

Birmingham put in lights a few years ago and is probably the only City Section field that has a true backstop instead of a batting cage. The homerun distances are equal to both left and right, far enough to make homers difficult. A large foul territory make it a very fair ball park.

They have a very good scoreboard that shows the score by each inning, the Balls, Strikes and Outs, Batter \#, and the total \# of runs, hits and errors, are all in numbered lights. At Hart and most high schools, only the Runs are in Numbered Lights, the Balls Strikes and Outs use a single Light bulb indicator. "Doctor" Larry Fiscus our scoreboard keeper was at the game on the scoreboard and by the end of the game was working it pretty good.
Unfortunately the PA system blew an amplifier the previous day, so Dick Louis our PA announcer couldn't announce the game.

Many other teams now use the venue for its games and by playoff time it can get raggidy, but this early in the season the grass looks pretty good.

SECOND GAME:
Steve Burton started for Hart. West Torrance went at him immediately. 2 singles, a strike out and a walk loaded the bases. Derek Tafoya then singled in 2 runs and West Torrance led 2-0.

In the Hart 1st: Hart tried to answer back against WT starter John Dunn a left hander. Matt Valaika singled to center, Steve Sanchez singled to left. after a failed bunt pop-up for an out, Tyler Fick singled to left to load the bases. Valaika then scored on a wild pitch, but Hart could get no more out of the inning and WT led 2-1.
WT went down in the 2nd. Ben Edwards singled to open the Hart $2 n d$ but John Dunn struck out the side.

WT 3rd: In the 3rd a leadoff walk, single and a fielders choice at 3rd was followed by a booming double to the wall by Bryan Schwind. Anthony Gaitan then singled in Schwind and West Torrance led 5-1.

Hart 3rd. Steve Sanchez doubled to left, took 3rd on a wild pitch and scored on a sacrifice fly by Steve Susdorf to make it WT 5-2.

WT 4th: Steve Burton opened the 4 th by walking the first 2 batters and Josue Iniquez came in to pitch and Josue threw the best 4 innings of his career.

He easily put down the side in the 4 th stranding Burton's runners.
Then:
In the 5 th gave up a leadoff single by Gaitan, but promptly picked him off.
Josue then got the next 8 batters thanks to some great fielding by Matt Sreden catching a pop foul near the WT dougout on a diving catch, and Nate Maddox making a great sliding catch into the screen on a foul ball near 3 rd.

Hart got a single to short by Kevin Baker in the 4 th but John Dunn again struck out the side.
In the Hart 5th Hart got something going. Down 5-2, Matt Valaika singled to 3rd and Steve Sanchez was hit by pitch. After a pop up and strikeout Shane Carlson then hit a long double to left center driving in Valaika and Sanchez to make it close 5-4.

However lefty John Dunn struck out the side again in the 6th and struck out one more in the 7 th as Hart lost 5 - 4 .
Dunn would up strikeing out 13 Hart players and issued NO walks, and that was a big reason why Hart could not get an attack going.

The record for strikeouts against Hart was 16 by Loyola in 1992 in an 8 inning game.
Josue Iniquez faced the minimum of 12 batters in his 4 innings. He gave up 1 hit and picked him off.
Hart has never beaten West Torrance now in 3 games.
Hart lost a big game in 1997 at West Torrance in the Quarter Finals. Hart led early in that game $9-3$ with Bobby Graves on the mound. In that game Kevin Bell homered in the 1st and Bob Potruch hit a Grand Slam homer in the $2 n d$ for Hart. But Bobby Graves started to falter in the bottom of the 3rd, and West Torrance pecked away for 7 runs in the next 4 innings. Graves left the game in the 6th in a 10-10 tie. Brian Hernandez pitched a great 3 scoreless innings, but in the bottom of the 10 th John Sain who had hit 2 homers off Graves earlier in the game hit his 3 rd of the game and Hart lost 13-10.
