## PAGE 3: 03/26/2004 @ Canyon HIGHLIGHTS of Game 04-10: Hart 8 - Canyon 5 (Foothill League Game)

Hart gets 16 hits beats Canyon 8-5
After getting only 3 hits in their last 2 games, Hart erupted for 16 hits, all singles to come back from a $5-1$ deficit to win in the late innings 8-5. Tyler Fick had 2 bad innings in the 2nd and 3rd, but was magnificent in the other 5 innings. Once he held them down from the 4 th through the 7 th the Hart bats were able to push across 8 runs with their 16 hits. They left 15 men on base.

Matt McQueen started and gave up walks to Cole Valancius and Tyler Fick, but Hart didn't score. In the 2 nd, Hart got 2 out singles by Pat Sarkissian and Matt Valaika but again didn't score.

Tyler Fick started for Hart and put down the side in the first. In the 2nd, he gave up a inning opening flare single to Matt McQueen. John Hay then doubled in McQueen. Tyler then got 2 strikeouts and a pop up to end the inning.

In the Hart 3rd, 3 straight singles by Steve Sanchez, Steve Susdorf, and Tyler Fick brought in a run to tie the score. Shane Carlson sacrificed and was safe when the Canyon 3rd baseman dropped the force-out throw to load the bases. It looked like Hart would have a big inning at this point, but Robert Van Scoyoc hit an absolute Laser Bullet that was snagged by Canyon pitcher Matt McQueen, and got a double play out of it. Despite hitting the next Hart batter Ryan Pettersen, McQueen was able to get a groundout with the bases loaded to end the inning, but Hart had tied the score.

In the Canyon 3rd, leadoff batter Josh Pipho flied deep to left. Drew Peterson walked and took 2nd on a passed ball. Matt Robinson singled scoring Peterson, and took 2nd on a bad throw to the plate. After J.T. Adams struck out, McQueen singled in Robinson. John Hay got his 2nd double sending McQueen to 3rd. Tim Anderson singled in McQueen and Hay. Canyon now led 5-1.

Hart got going in the 4th. Down 5-1 they got 4 straight singles by Matt Valaika, Cole Valancius, Steve Sanchez and Steve Susdorf for a run. Another scored on a wild pitch. After a walk loaded the bases again, another promising inning came to a close with a pop up, ground out and fly out. So Hart was rattling the cage, but after 4 innings they had left the bases loaded twice and left 2 on twice for a total of 10 left in 4 innings, and trailed 5-3.

In the Canyon 4th, Fick walked the lead off batter Jason Fields. After 2 force outs the runner on first Drew Peterson was picked off and scampered toward 2nd. A throwing error got him all the way to 3rd, but Tyler Fick struck out Matt Robinson.

Fick then got the next 9 batters from the 5 through the 9 th.
Meantime Hart got something going in the 5th after 2 out. Cole Valancius walked and took 3rd on Steve Sanchez 3rd single of the game, Sanchez took 2nd on the throw. Steve Susdorf the got hold of a pitch that looked like it was going over the right center field wall, but the centerfielder Drew Peterson made a great catch and Hart was still down $5-3$.

Canyon went down 1-2-3 in the 5 th.
Hart got things going in the 6th. Tyler Fick and Shane Carlson singled. Robert Van Scoyoc forced Carlson, Fick taking 3rd. Kevin Baker hit for Pettersen. McQueen then committed a balk scoring Fick, and sending Van Scoyoc to 2nd. Baker singled in Van Scoyoc and took 2nd on the throw to the plate. The score was now tied 5-5.
After a pop up for the 2nd out, Matt Valaika singled up the middle (his 3rd hit of the game) scoring Baker and giving Hart its first lead 6-5.

By this time Canyon Pitcher Matt McQueen had faced 36 batters. He was replaced by John Ernenputsch who got the final out.

In the Canyon 6th, Tyler Fick put down Canyon 1-2-3, the 3rd out a deep drive to left by Jason Fields.
With the score only 6-5, Hart went to work on Ernenputsch in the 7 th. Ben Edwards pinch hit for Steve Sanchez and walked. Steve Susdorf was hit by pitch. Both runners moved up on a wild pitch. Tyler Fick drove on Edwards with a sacrifice Fly. Shane Carlson then singled in Susdorf. Anthony DiGiacomo relieved Ernenputsch, and gave up a single to Van Scoyoc but Kevin Baker flied very deep to left.

Tyler Fick again easily put Canyon down 1-2-3 in the 7 th for a complete game 8-5 victory.
Steve Sanchez and Matt Valaika both went 3 for 4. Tyler Fick was 2 for 3 with 2 RBI's. Shane Carlson and Steve Susdorf were 2 for 4.
The 16 Hits (all singles) for Hart is not a record. Hart had 24 hits against Burbank in 2000.16 singles, 2 doubles and 6 homers.

Hart is 30-10 against Canyon since 1987.
Hart next plays Valencia March 30, 2004 at Hart at 3:15pm
UPDATE: An interesting note on future opponent: Canyon Springs.
Hart will be playing Canyon Springs of the Ivy League in the Caliber Motors Orange County Select Easter Tournament on Monday April 5.
Thursday Joe Spiers of Canyon Springs hit in his 41st straight and today went 3 for 5 with a homer in a win against Arlington to extend his hitting streak to 42 games. He is now 1 behind the California State record of 43 games by Jason Kendall of Torrance from 1990-1992. Kendall is an All Star catcher currently playing for the Pittsburgh Pirates. If Spiers keeps it up he will be facing Hart with a 45 game hitting streak trying to go for \# 46 against Hart on Monday 4-5-2004 at El Modena High school.
