Hart 4 Canyon Springs 0 - Steve Sanchez complete game shutout
Pitcher Steve Sanchez (1-2) had ten strikeouts on his way to a complete game and Shane Carlson was two for four with an RBI to lead Hart (8-6), which only managed three hits but walked seven times. Joe Spiers was two for three with a double and a single to extend his hitting streak to 46 games for No. 15 rated Canyon Springs (11-3).

Today Hart played the 2nd game of Pool Play in the Anaheim Canyon Caliber Motors Orange County Select Tournament against Canyon Springs at El Modena High.
Joe Spiers of Canyon Springs brought a 45 game hitting streak into the game and he didn't disappoint his fans when he doubled in the first inning to extend his streak to 46 games.
HOWEVER!!! The day belonged to Hart pitcher Steve Sanchez who pitched a great shutout against a Division 1 team from the Ivy League which came into the game rated 15 th in the Southern California Area, with a Team batting average of .390 and was 11-2. Sanchez struck out 10 gave up 7 hits ( 2 doubles) walked 1 batter.
Hart was the visiting team and faced 6'3" senior Chris Urias. Urias was wild and in the 1 st inning walked 4 batters, gave up 1 hit and had a wild pitch, but managed to only give up 1 run.
In the first Cole Valancius and Kevin Baker walked. Steve Susdorf forced Baker putting runners on 1 st and $3 r d$. Then with Fick batting, the inning might have unraveled when Susdorf was picked off fist base for the 2 nd out.
Tyler Fick walked to put men at 1st and 3rd again. Shane Carlson singled to right scoring Valancius. Robert Van Scoyoc walked to load the bases but a groundout ended what could have been a very big inning, but Hart led 1-0.

Steve Sanchez took the mound for Hart, and the first batter he faced was Joe Spiers and hit 45 game hit streak. Joe hit a shot to left, down the line that looked like it would go out and Spiers easily cruised into 2 nd with a double. A groundout sent him to 3 rd, but Sanchez stranded him getting a strikeout and a comebacker to the mound.
2 Hart batters struck out in the 2nd, then Vanancius walked and stole 2nd, but was stranded after a groundout.
In the CS 2nd inning Ryan Selden led off with a double to deep left center. 2 pitches later he was picked off by Sanchez and tagged out in a rundown. Sanchez then struck out the next 2 batters.
Hart went 3 up 3 down in the 3 rd with 1 strikeout.
In the CS 3rd Sanchez struck out the first 2 batters and then faced the dangerous Joe Spiers. Joe scorched a single to left for his 2nd hit, but Sanchez got an inning ending comebacker.

Hart picked up its 2nd run in the 4 th inning without the benefit of a hit. Van Scoyoc walked. Nate Maddox lined out to center, and Sarkissian grounded to 2nd, Van Scoyoc taking 2nd base. Van Scoyoc took 3rd on a wild pitch, and scored on the next pitch which was also wild. Hart now led 2-0.

In the CS 4th, they looked like they were going to get rolling. Jake Taylor singled to short and Chase Allard singled to left sending Taylor to 3rd. Ryan Selden hit a shot towards 3rd and Taylor decided he couldn't score but was too far off 3rd, dove back to the base but Nate Maddox tagged him out. The cS coach argued long and hard to no avail, but cS now had men on 1 st and 2 nd with 1 out.
Josh Manzano then hit a grounder to Shane Carlson near 2 nd and he turned it into a double play.
Hart was out of the inning still holding a 2-0 lead.
Kevin Baker walked in the 5 th, but Hart didn't score. That was the 7 th walk given up by CS pitcher Chris Urias who left after that inning having given up only 1 hit but went out on the short end of a $2-0$ score.
Steve Sanchez put the side down 1-2-3 in the 6 th for the first time, ending the inning with his 6 th strikeout at that point.

In the Hart 6th Canyon Springs brought in a new pitcher Nick Cotham. Shane Carlson opened with a single and took 2 nd on a wild pitch. Van Scoyoc sacrificed and the pitcher threw the ball away, Carlson scoring and Van Scoyoc took $2 n d$. Van Scoyoc took 3 d on another wild pitch and then scored on a single by Nate Maddox. Hart now led 4-0.
Joe Spiers proved he was human when he grounded out to 3 rd opening the 6 th, and then Sanchez struck out 2 more men for his 7th and 8th strikeouts of the game.
In the Hart 7th with 2 out, a new pitcher Jake Taylor of cS, hit Tyler Fick on the left wrist and Tyler Ryan Pettersen ran for him. A pop up ended the inning and Hart went into the bottom of the 7th leading 4-0.
Steve Sanchez struck out the first batter, the cleanup hitter, Chase Allard and got a very deep fly to dead center field for the 2nd out.
The Canyon Springs coach then sent up a Pinch hitter Michael Sodders who singled to left.
Pinch hitter Steven Quick singled to short.
Pinch hitter Jeff Brogden then walked loading the bases.
Pinch hitter Chuck Reyes then hit for catcher Derek Kennedy who had struck out in his 2 previous at bats.
The big problem at this point was if Reyes could prolong the inning, Joe Spiers was in the on deck circle.
Sanchez got 2 quick strikes on Reyes and then he swung at a pitch in the dirt, catcher Pat Sarkissian kept the ball in front of him and then only needed to step on the plate to end the game and the shutout was in the books. Sanchez had his 10th strikeout and his first win of the year to go with 2 losses.
Sanchez gave up 7 hits, 2 doubles. He only walked 1 man, in the 7 th after 2 out and got the game ending strikeout immediately afterwards.

Hart had only 3 hits, but they got the runs from those 3 hits and made good use of the 7 walks and 5 wild pitches.
Canyon Springs is now 11-3 on the year. Hart is 8-6.
In the Tournament Hart and San Diego Serra are both 2-0.
We finally had a clear day with no cloud cover over the El MOdena area. With a slight breeze blowing in it made the porta-a potty berable.
Then: When the game got "tight" in the 7 th, The Waste Management Company must have read my News Letter yesterday, because their truck showed up to pump the Port-a-Potty out.
Everyone was watching the 7th inning holding their noses. We got through it, and won the game, so things are looking good for tomorrow.
