LOS ANGELES - Junior center fielder Mike Miller (Stevenson Ranch, CA/Hart) tied a Cal State L.A. record with six hits in a game and five Golden Eagles, including Miller, homered on Saturday, but visiting Sonoma State used big innings to sweep a doubleheader from Cal State L.A., 18-15 and 6-5, in CSULA's final home games of the 2004 baseball season.

Hart next plays on Friday April 16, 3:15pm at Canyon Country Canyon, as Foothill League games now continues until the end of the regular season.
Canyon will have to play without their DH C.J. Gurske who used profanity after striking out in the top of the 7 th and the umpire kicked him out of the game, which means he cannot play against Hart on Friday.

Valencia 15, Reno (Nev.) 2
Sophomore Michael Hur hit for the cycle, going four for four with a single, double, triple and a home run, and senior Jared Clark (5-0) pitched a two-hitter with 12 strikeouts in six innings to lift host and No. 2 Valencia (9-3). Reno (Nev.) is 19-1.
It was the Cowboys against the Indians today, and the Indians scalped the Cowboys.
Today Hart defeated Canyon in a well played game by Hart. Tyler Fick was sharp today as he threw a shutout, giving up only 2 hits and 1 walk while striking out 9.

Ben Edwards pinch hit in the 6th with 2 out and Hart leading 4-0 and crushed a 3 run homer to right center over the 356 foot sign and on top of the far left temporary classroom.

Fick only had mild trouble in the first. After an inning opening strikeout Matt Robinson looked overmatched on the first 2 pitches, but then looped a single to right. After a pop up an easy grounder by John Hay to second should have ended the inning, but the throw dropped out of 1st baseman Robert Van Scoyoc's glove. Tyler then got a line out to right on a good catch by Ryan Pettersen.
Fick struck out the side in the second. In the 3 rd Josh Pipho hit a hard grounder that hit the pitchers rubber and bounced 70 feet in the air. By the time it came down he was safe on first. 2 pitches later Hart catcher Pat Sarkissian picked him off first.

In the 4th Canyon went 3 up 3 down with 2 strikeouts. In the 5 th with 2 out Jason Fileds walked, took 2 nd on a wild pitch and died there on an easy grounder to $2 n d$.

In the 6th with 2 out Matt McQueen reached on an error, the inning ending on a strikeout. Tyler got Canyon 3 up 3 down in the 7 th, including his 9 th strikeout for his 4 th win against 1 loss.

Meanwhile Hart batters were doing their job.
In the 1st Matt Valaika walked, took 2nd on a sacrifice by Kevin Baker. Steve Susdorf was safe on an error by Canyon shortstop Tim Anderson. Tyler Fick then tripled home Valaika and Susdorf. Shane Carlson walked putting runners on 1st and 3rd, but Hart failed to score after a strikeout and a failed "pickle" play resulted in Fick out at the plate.

After going 3 up and 3 down in the 2 nd, Hart picked up a run in the 3 rd after 2 out, Steve Susdorf doubled to right center and scored on a single to right by Fick. Hart now led 3-0, all the runs driven in by Fick.

In the Hart 4th, Robert Van Scoyoc doubled to right center and took 3rd when Nate Maddox bunted perfectly and beat it out for a single. Pat Sarkissian then hit a sacrifice fly to right scoring Van Scoyoc. Score Hart 4-0.
In the Hart 5th, Steve Susdorf led off with his 2 nd double to right center, his 5th of the year. With Fick batting, a pitch in the dirt got away from the catcher, but not far enough and Susdorf was out at 3rd stealing.

In the Hart 6th, leading 4-0, Van Scoyoc led off with a single to center. After a flyout, Pat Sarkissian lined a sharp single to left sending Van Scoyoc to 2nd. Ben Edwards then pinch hit for Ryan Pettersen and crushed a tremendou drive over the right center field wall.
After a walk to Matt Valaika (his 3rd walk of the game), Canyon relieved left hander Chris Gschwender with Jerrod Ferguson. After a pop foul to the catcher, Susdorf singled for his 3rd hit of the game, sending Valaika to 3rd. Fick walked loading the bases, but the inning ended on a ground out to 3rd.

Tyler Fick struck out 9 and improved his record to 4-1.
Steve Susdorf went 3 for 4 with 2 doubles, 2 runs scored and appears to be out of a slump.
Matt Valaika had 3 walks. Tyler Fick was 2 for 3, 3 RBI's, and a walk.
Robert Van Scoyoc was 2 for 3, 2 runs scored with a double.
Ben Edwards 1 for 1, a 3 run homer, the first of his career.
Hart now has 4 homers for the year. The low for Team homers is 5 set in 1995, so the 2004 team is 1 from tying for the low homer for the year mark.

Hart is now above . 500 at $9-8$, and is 4-2 in the Foothill League. Canyon is now $7-8$ and $2-4$ in the Foothill League. Hart plays Canyon Friday 4/ 16/2004 at Canyon at 3:15pm.
