11 Innings: Hart 6 Saugus 6: Hart scores 2 in 7th \& 2 in 11, Edwards Homers
Hart next plays on Friday April 23, $3: 15 \mathrm{pm}$ at Saugus. Hart has temporarily taken over 2nd place with a 5-2-1 record. Saugus is 3rd in the Foothill League at 4-2-1. Saugus will play 3 games the week of April 26 to catch up. The schedule got out of "sync" in order to allow Valencia to play in the National Classic.
39 teams in the 13 Division II Leagues will make the playoffs, so there will be 7 wild card games. This means all 13 , 3rd place teams and 1 second place team will play in the Wild Card games.
If Hart wins Friday, they could end in a tie with Saugus for 2nd place. This will create an interesting situation in deciding placing in the playoffs.

Saugus 6, Hart 6 (11 innings)
Hart (10-8-1, 5-2-1) scored twice in the bottom of the seventh to tie the game, 4-4, then answered two Saugus (12-4-1, 4-2-1) runs in the 11th to tie it again before the game was called due to darkness. Cole Valancius went four for five and Matt Valaika went three for five with three RBIs and a double for Hart.

HART VARSITY 2004:

Hart and Saugus hooked up in a game that probably set and tied several records. I think I listed most of them at the end of this newsletter Now I'll just try and describe what turned to be an amazing game that Hart had to come from behind twice to get a tie as they were both times on the brink of a loss.
The tie gave Hart a record of 10-8-1, 5-2-1) Saugus (12-4-1, 4-2-1). Saugus needs to make up a game against Valancia.
We always worry in games early in the season about a possible tie when Daylight Savings time causes games to be over as early as $5: 30 \mathrm{pm}$, and some games are still not near the 7 th inning. This is the first time Hart has played to a tie in a game after the time change that always occurs in early April.
Hart made a great comeback in the bottom of the 7 th with 2 runs and had the bases loaded with 1 out but could not get the winning run in.

After Saugus scored 2 runs in the 11 on an error and a single, it was evident that Hart would get just enough time to bat in the bottom of the 11th as it was extremely dark. However they got the 2 runs to tie, and with men on 1 st and 2nd 2 out, a strikeout ended it and the umpires declared a tie.

Hart practically gave Saugus the game, giving up 12 walks and 2 hit batters. 4 of the walks ( 3 leadoff), and 1 of the hit batters scored accounting for 5 of their 6 runs. What kept the score down for Saugus was they struck out 16 times, and had only 3 hits through the first 7 innings.

Tyler Lyon started for Hart, but was wild. He walked the bases loaded in the first and 1 run scored on a force-out. He got 2 strikeouts in the 2nd, but in the 3rd gave up a bunt single and again walked 2 to load the bases. Another walk forced in a run and Saugus led after 3, 2-0.

When Lyon hit the first batter in the 4th, Josue Iniquez relieved and got out of trouble. Josue walked 2 men in the 5 th and a misjudged fly ball single loaded the bases before Steve Sanchez relieved. A passed ball scored 1 run but he got 2 strikeouts. In the 6th he hit and walked 3, one with the bases loaded forcing over a run. That was his only bad inning as he wound up pitching 5.2 innings giving up only 2 hits.

After the top of the 5th Saugus led 3-0.
Thomas Milone a left hander, started for Saugus:
For Hart, Cole Valancius with 6 hits in his previous 2 games led off the Hart 1st with a single \& made it as far as 3rd.

Nate Maddox singled with 1 out in the $2 n d$.
Valancius opened the 3rd with a walk, but was caught stealing.
Hart was 3 up 3 down in the 4 th.
In the 5th Nate Maddox was hit by pitch and then Ben Edwards crushed his 2nd homer of the season to close the gap 3 - 2 . Cole Valancius got another hit, but was erased on a double play.

Saugus answered back in the top of the 6 th with a hit batter and 3 walks forcing in a run to make it Saugus $4-2$.
Tyler Fick singled in the 6th but Travis Babin relieved Milone and got a fly to center and a strikeout.
In the Saugus 7th after 2 out, Steven Eaton got the 3rd hit for Saugus, the first solid hit for Saugus in the game.
In the Hart 7 th with Travis Babin again on the mound, he got an easy ground out to 2 nd and then an easy grounder to short, but Hart got a break when the DH Ben Edwards hit an easy grounder to the shortstop who mishandled the ball. Hart wanted to pinch run Steve Sanchez who was pitching, but the umpires dis-allowed it. Kevin Baker instead ran for Edwards. Pat Sarkissian then singled to left sending Baker to 2nd. Ryan Petersen ran for Sarkissian. Cole Valancius got his 3rd hit, a single to right loading the bases. Matt Valaika singled to right scoring Baker and Peterson and Valancius took $3 r d$ on an error by the right fielder.
The winning run was now on 3rd with only 1 out. Steve Susdorf was walked intentionally to load the bases. Tyler Fick struck out, and Shane Carlson hit a ball sharply but it was stabbed by the pitcher who ran it to first. But Hart had tied the game 4-4.

The next 2 innings was a pitchers duel. Sanchez put the side down on the 8th and 9th easily. Babin had a little more trouble, leaving 2 on in the 8 th and 1 on in the 9 th.

Sanchez took the mound in the 10th and the first batter popped up a ball between first and the pitchers mound. Sanchez and Robert Van Scoyoc collided and the ball dropped out of a glove for an error. Sanchez got 2 force outs, but gave up a solid single to put 2 runners on, but got a strikeout to end the inning.

Saugus brought in Stephen Grechowsky in the bottom of the 10th, and he looked good, getting a comebacker and 2 strikeouts. Ryan Gagnon entered as a pinch runner in the 8th for his first career appearance. Ryan needs shoulder surgery at the end of the season but had to bat in the 10th and struck out.

Tyler Fick took the mound in the top of the 11th as it was getting dark. Travis Babin opened with a single up the middle, and Ian Bridges walked. Fick then got 2 strikeouts, on Brett Finley and Jason Pfau. For Pfau batting 7 th it was hist 4th "K" of the game, and 5th strikeout for the position as pinch hitter Daniel Hughes pinch hit in the 5th and also struck out. Fick looked like he could be out of the inning when he got a slow squibber but it got past him and was then thrown away by the 2nd baseman allowing Babin to score. Steven Eaton singled in Bridges. Fick struck out leadoff batter Jeff Knosp, but it didn't look good for Hart now down 6-4 and getting very dark.

In the Hart 11th, Grechowsky again took the mound. Pat Sarkissian popped up foul to first, but Cole Valancius got his 4th hit, a single to left. Matt Valaika the hit a long double to right center scoring Valancius. Steve Susdorf grounded to short, Valancius taking 3rd. With 2 out and Hart down by a run, Tyler Fick stroked a single to left scoring Valancius to tie the game 6-6.

Shane Carlson was hit by pitch moving Fick to 2nd, but in almost complete darkness Robert Van Scoyoc struck out to end the inning. The umpires immediately called it a tie game.

Valancius was 4 for 5 with a walk, and now has 10 hits in his last 3 games. Matt Valaika was 3 for 5 with a double and 3 RBI's.

Ben Edwards was 1 for 3 with a walk and a big 2 run homer.
Steve Sanchez pitched 5 and $2 / 3$ innings giving up only 2 hits striking out 7. Tyler Lyon struck out 6 . Saugus batter struck out 16 times but 12 walks and 2 hit batters helped them to 5 of their 6 runs.

Jeff Knosp of Saugus had 7 plate appearances. Robert Van Scoyoc of Hart had 6 at bats tieing a record held by 13 players.
