HIGHLIGHTS of Game 04-22: Hart 8 - Burroughs 2 (Foothill League Game)

Hart breaks open pitchers duel beats Burrough 8-2

HART VARSITY 2004: Hart breaks open pitchers duel beats Burrough 8-2

Tyler Lyon pitched the best game of his career as Hart beat Burroughs 8-2. Lyon faced the minimum of 12 batters through the first 4 innings.

He was particularly adept at getting ground balls during that span. He put the side down in thru 1st and 4th on easy ground balls. In the 2nd he gave up a leadoff ground ball single to left by Devin Williams who was immediately caught stealing.

In the 3rd he gave up a ground single towards 2nd to Ian Disiere, but got the next hitter to hit into a double play.

Hart infielders were making the plays on the beautifully manicured Hart diamond.

Meantime through the first 4 innings, Hart was having its own problems scoring runs, with excellent chances in the first 2 innings.

In the Hart 1st inning with 1 out, Matt Valaika walked, Steve Susdorf singled to right and Tyler Fick walked to load the bases. A strikeout and fly to center ended to inning without a score.

In the Hart 2nd: Nate Maddox was hit by pitch and was forced at 2nd by Pat Sarkissian. Kevin Baker was safe on an error by the shortstop and Cole Valencius walked to load the bases with 1 out. Matt Valaika lined out hard to 2nd and it was easily converted into a double play.

In the Hart 3rd: Hart was 3 up and 3 down due to a tremendous catch by the left fielder of a sure extra base hit by Tyler Fick.

In the Hart 4th: With 1 out, Nate Maddox singled but was immediately erased in a 4-6-3 double play.

The Burroughs infielders were also taking advantage of the pristine fielding conditions at Hart compared to the Burroughs ball field which is hard and worn, not conducive for good fielding plays.

With the score 0-0, Tyler Lyon took the mound in the top of the 5th against Burroughs.

Devin Williams led off with a long homer to left making the score 1-0 Burroughs. Cameron Collard then hit a dribbler to first and appeared to be an easy out, but the umpire ruled him safe at first on Catchers Interference because Hart catcher Pat Sarkissian "tipped" Collards' bat when he swung. Kenny McCown pinch ran for Collard and was promptly caught stealing. Vincent Hastings was hit by pitch, but was quickly erased on a 4-6-3 double play.

Hart 5th: With the score 1-0 in favor if Burroughs, Kevin Baker open with a double. Cole Valancius then doubled over the left fielders head scoring Baker to tie the score 1-1. Matt Valaika who has been bunting very successfully, did it again beating out a bunt towards 3rd. Steve Susdorf walked to load the bases. Tyler Fick then singled to center scoring Valancius and Valaika putting Hart ahead 3-1. Steve Sanchez then sacrificed the runners to 2nd & 3rd. Robert Van Scoyoc hit a pop foul behind first. The 1st baseman made a great catch with his back to the plate and had no chance getting Susdorf who tagged up and made it to the plate giving Van Scoyoc a sacrifice fly RBI. Hart now had a 4-1 lead. Nate Maddox was hit again by a pitch and Troy Yudin pinch hitting for Sarkissian walked to load the bases. With Kevin Baker batting a wild pitch scored Fick. Maddox and Yudin moved to 2nd and 3rd. Baker then lined out hard to 3rd ending the inning, but Hart had scored 5 and now held a 5-1 lead.

In the Burroughs 6th: Tyler Lyon struck out the first 2 batters in the inning, but Brent Fekety then lofted a high drive to left center which appeared to go out, but then dropped inside the fence. The umpire gave the home-run sign and Fekety trotted around with his 4th homer of the season. Pat Schulthies then doubled deep to left center. With the tying run in the on-deck circle Lyon struck out the next batter, so after only striking out only 1 batter in the 2nd inning, he struck out the side in the 6th. He now had 4 strikeouts and no walks. Hart led 5-2.

In the Hart 6th: With 1 out, Valaika was hit by pitch. Susdorf batting, Valaika stole 2nd, the pitch was wild and Valaika made it to 3rd. Susdorf singled in Valaika. Fick coming out of a slump then doubled to deep center sending Susdorf to 3rd. Steve Sanchez then singled to center scoring Susdorf and Fick. Ryan Pettersen ran for Sanchez. Van Scoyoc singled to right sending Pettersen to 2nd. A double play ended the inning. Hart had 3 more runs, & now led 8-2.

Burroughs 7th: Tyler Fick who got 3 quick outs to save a 4-3 Hart victory on Tuesday at Burroughs, now relieved Tyler Lyon in the 7th. Devin Williams flied to right. Fick then struck out the next two batters to end the game. Hart had the victory 8-2.

Amazingly, for Cole Valancius leading the team in Batting at .444 and hits with 24, his double in the 5th., was his first extra base hit of the season. His on base percentage (.559) is higher than his slugging average (.463).

Hart is now 46-8-1 against Burroughs. Hart has never lost to Burroughs at home. All 8 losses to Burroughs have been "AT" Burroughs. The only "blemish" at Hart was a 4-4 Tie in 2002.

Tyler Lyon improved his record to 3 wins 2 losses. He gave up 5 hits, struck out 4 and best of all walked "NO" one. He hit 1 batter.

Tyler Fick scored 2 runs. He walked in the 1st., just missed an extra base hit when his liner to left was turned into a miracle catch by Burroughs left fielder Vincent Hastings. Fick then singled and doubled in his next 2 AB's, and drove in 2 runs with the double.

Steve Susdorf was 2 for 3 with a walk, 2 runs scored and 1 RBI. Steve Sanchez was 1 for 3, a double with 2 RBI's. Cole Valanius 1 for 3, 1 run, 1 RBI. Matt Valaika, 1 for 2 with a walk, 2 runs scored. Robert Van Scoyoc was 1 for 3 with an RBI. Nate Maddox 1 for 2, was hit by pitch twice. Kevin Baker was 1 for 3, a double and scored a run.

Hart was errorless at Burroughs, but Friday Pat Sarkissian was credited with an error when he committed catchers interference (CI), in the 5th. CI is a play where the offensive team gets a choice depending what transpired on the play. For example if the player hits a homer when his bat is "tipped", the coach can take the homer, and there is no error. In this case the batter was out, so the coach chose the CI, thus the error. There is no At Bat recorded for the batter.

Funny thing, Matt Slavin of BaseballResource.com E-mailed me on Wednesday asking me how to score a "CI". I checked it out on Google as I had completely forgotten the scoring rule on this play.

The Homer by Fekety was hit into the same tree that Eaton Rincon of Arlington hit last year when his apparent triple which would have given him the "cycle" was ruled a homer. Someone needs to get the tree trimmers working on the "over-hanging" trees in left and left center.

I made a mistake in the narration of the 4-3 win at Burroughs during the Hart 3 run rally in the 7th inning on Tuesday April 27. It's since been corrected on Previous game # 04-21 on 4/27/2004
Steve Susdorf did "not" drive in the lead run. Steve was walked intentionally to load the bases with 1 out. Ben Edwards then hit the sacrifice fly to drive in the lead run. Tyler Fick then grounded out to first.

Sophomore Tyler Lyon (3-2) pitched a five-hitter with four strikeouts and no walks in six innings and Tyler Fick went two for three with two RBIs and one double for host Hart (12-9-1, 7-3-1), which scored five runs in the fifth inning to overcome a 1-0 deficit. Devin Williams went two for three with a solo home run in the fifth inning and Brent Fekety went one for three with a solo home run in the sixth inning for Burbank Burroughs (9-11-1, 4-7).

Valencia 9, Canyon Country Canyon 4

Wes Pascolla went three for four with a home run and two RBIs, Trevor Nelson went three for three with an RBI and Senior starting pitcher Matt Aidem (6-1) pitched five innings with eight strikeouts and went two for four, collecting the 160th hit of his four-year career, for visiting Valencia (14-6, 10-1), ranked No. 1 by The Times. Aidem passed Bethel Christian's Daryle Ward and Rio Mesa's Dmitri Young for fourth place on the Southern Section list for most career hits. Canyon Country is 3-8 in league.
