**HIGHLIGHTS of Game 04-26: Hart 10 - Burbank 1 (Foothill League Game)**

Hart beats Burbank, 10-1. Tyler Fick pitches great & Homers. Maddox bases loaded 3 bagger

Senior Ivan Novak started for Burbank.

In the Hart 1st: With 1 out Tyler Fick hit a ball over the fence in Right Center. This used to be a home run, but several years ago, the ground rules were changed and now it's a ground rule double. The next 2 batter were out and Fick was stranded.

Tyler Fick started for Hart.

Burbank 1st: Robert Nichols opened with a double to straight away center off a leaping Steve Susdorf's glove. After a bunt that was popped up, Kelly Blatz singled Nichols home. Fick got an inning ending strikeout, but Burbank had drawn first blood 1-0.

Hart 2nd: Ben Edwards lined a ball hard down the left field line but the left fielder made a good play holding him to a single. Steve Sanchez tried to sacrifice bunt Edwards over, but popped the bunt right to the pitcher who flipped to first doubling up Edwards. Nate Maddox was hit by pitch, but the inning ended on a strikeout.

Burbank 2nd: A 1 out single by Shaun Moise followed by a hit batsman on Scott Shutt had Tyler Fick in trouble. Fick buckled down and got a strikeout and fly out and was out of the inning. Score Burbank 1-0.

Hart 3rd: After 1 out Cole Valancius was hit by pitch. Tyler Fick crashed a homer over the left field wall into Glenoaks Blvd.

Matt Valaika walked, Steve Susdorf was safe on an error by the shortstop and Ben Edwards walked to load the bases. Steve Sanchez then hit a screaming liner to right but directly at the right fielder, and the runners held their bases. Nate Maddox then crushed one to left center and drove in all 3 runners with a stand up triple. Coach Ozella almost gave him the signal to try for an inside the park homer, but at the last minute held him up. Ryan Gagnon was hit by pitch, but the inning ended on a grounder to short. Hart now led 5-1

Burbank 3rd: Fick walked Jesse Ayers, but got a strikeout. Score Hart 5-1.

Hart 4th: With 1 out, Fick walked, but was stranded. Score Hart 5-1.

Burbank 4th: Fick got a leadoff strike out and put down the side 1-2-3. Score Hart 5-1.

Hart 5th: Nate Maddox was hit by pitch and stole second but was stranded. Score Hart 5-1.

Burbank 5th: Fick put the side down 1-2-3 with 2 strikeouts. Fick struck out at least 1 batter through 5 innings. Score Hart 5-1.

Hart 6th: Nick Kukta who Hart roughed up on Tuesday came in to pitch. With 1 out Valancius walked and stole 2nd. With 2 out Matt Valaika singled Valancius home. Susdorf walked, but Kukta got the 3rd out with only 1 run scoring. Score Hart 6-1.

Burbank 6th: Steve Sanchez took over pitching duties for Hart, and put down the side 1-2-3 with a strikeout.

Hart 7th: Eric Lemaire came in to pitch. Lemaire was very effective against Hart on Tuesday going 5.2 innings giving up 0 runs and only 4 hits. He looked good again getting an opening strikeout, but Nate Maddox singled. After a fly out it looked like Lemaire was still throttling Hart, but Kevin Baker singled to right and Valancius was hit by pitch to load the bases. Fick hit a topper to 3rd for a single scoring Maddox. Valaika singled to short, scoring Baker and when the shortstop threw the ball away scoring Valancius, Fick took 3rd. Steve Susdorf singled to right scoring Fick and sending Valaika to 3rd. The inning ended on a fly to right. Score Hart 10-1.

Burbank 7th: Steve Sanchez with a 10 run lead and basically getting his "bull pen" session accomplished during his 2 innings gave up two singles, but got a pop up, strikeout and an unassisted fielders choice at 3rd to end the inning and the game. Final Score Hart 10-1.

Hart is now 51-3 against Burbank since 1987.

After next year Burbank and Burroughs "may" go the Pacific League, as Golden Valley will be joining the Foothill league.

Burbank ended up 1-22 on the season, 0-15 in the Foothill League. Burbank's only victory was a 12-3 win against Reseda in the Daily News Tourney in the 4th game of the season.

Hart is 14-11-1,(9-5-1) in the Foothill League.

Hart batters were hit 5 times in this game and were hit 6 times on Tuesday. That was a Record, and today's 5 plunkings' would have tied the old record. Hart batters were hit 11 times in the 2 games against Burbank this week.

The Homer was Tyler Fick's 2nd of the year. He hit his first homer on his first at bat of the year against Peninsula. The Triple by Nate Maddox was his 2nd. The record is 4 in a year by Dave Toledo in 1989, Robby Davis in 1990, & John Aguilar in 1992.

3 Triples were hit by Robbie Davis in 1988, Lance Migita in 1989, Chris Vasquez 1989, Lance Migita 1990, and Jeremy Seipel in 1995.

You will notice the 3 and 4 triples a season were hit when 3 of the 6 Foothill League teams played in Venues with NO Fences. Schurr had only a deep fence in left field. Alhambra had no fences, and Burbank used to play at "no fences" Foy park where the Freshman now play.

Hope Hart can get a Home game on Tuesday. If they win on Tuesday (home or away), they will definitely have to Travel on Friday.

Hart next plays on Tuesday, May 18, at 3:15 in the CIF Southern Section Division II Wild Card Bracket. The opponent and place of game won't be known until the CIF-SS releases the info at 1pm on Monday May 17. As soon as I know, who and where Hart will play, I will send an e-mail to everyone.

The winners of the 7 Wild Card games will advance to the 1st round of 32 teams that will play on Friday, May 21 at 3:15pm. All wild card winners will be Visiting teams, and will "mostly" play League 1st place teams on Friday May 21.

Based on Past performances Hart "may" meet the Golden League 3rd place representative.

At the current moment, that would be either Lancaster or Highland, but the Southern Section could place us against the Marmonte or San Gabriel 3rd place team. The trend is to place teams against each other with a minimum of travel. All 13 Third place teams in Division II will be in the 7 wild Card games. There will be 1 second place team playing in the Wild Card.

Today was the Final regular season game for Hart and the following 6 Hart seniors: Ben Edwards, Josue Iniquez, Nate Maddox, Steve Sanchez, Steve Susdorf, and Cole Valancius.
