HIGHLIGHTS of Game 04-27: Hart 2 - Palmdale 1 (CIF-SS Wild Card Game)

Hart pulls one out in the 10th beats Palmdale 2-1

This was one of the best played games at the Hart diamond in many years. The score was 0-0 going into the top of the 10th.

Steve Sanchez started for Hart, and Tony Ontiveros started for Palmdale. Neither pitcher gave an inch.

Sanchez pitched great. He went 7.1 innings giving up only 4 singles and struck out 9, walked 1 and hit a batter. He retired the side in order in the 1st, 4th, 5th and 6th, striking out the side in the 4th. He gave up a single in the 7th but got the next 3 batters.

He retired the leadoff batter in the 8th, but then gave up a sharp single to Tyreace House who was a big pain to Hart all day. Pitching coach Roland DeLa Maza then brought in Tyler Fick from right field, and Sanchez took his place in right.

Fick had problems immediately when he wild pitched the speedy House to 2nd, then walked Kyle Evaland and gave up a bloop single to Chad Wolf to load the bases with 1 out. Fick then struck out cleanup hitter Derek Bloom and got a very deep fly to center by Matt Casey.

So Fick escaped the jam in the 8th.

Fick gave up a single in the 9th, but struck out the side.

Meantime Ontiveros was also keeping Hart from scoring. Hart put runners on in 5 of the 6 innings he pitched, but he got Hart batters to hit several ground balls to the shortstop in particular.

Ontiveros walked 2 batters (Ben Edwards and Tyler Fick) in the 2nd with 1 out, but then got a pop upo and fly out. He struck out only 2 batters, but only gave up 4 hits. Singles by Sanchez in the first was wiped out by a double play. Cole Valancius singled and took 2nd on an error in the 3rd, but only got as far as 3rd.

Nate Maddox opened the 5th with a single and was sacrificed to 2nd by Robert Van Scoyoc and got to 3rd on a groundout to the right side, but was stranded. Steve Susdorf Doubled in the 6th with 2 out but was stranded.

Ontiveros gave way in the 7th in favor of Palmdale's best pitcher Mike McCravey, McCravey gave up a 2 out single to Van Scoyoc in the 7th, Hit Batter to Steve Sanchez in the 8th but got a fly out and strikeout. Ben Edwards opened the 9th with a single and was pinch run for by Troy Yudin. Yudin However was eliminated on a strikeout caught stealing double play.

So it all came down to the 10th inning.

With catcher Ben Edwards having been pinch run for a second time, he was replaced at catcher by Matt Sreden who has been out with an injured foot for over a month.

The ever dangerous Tyreace House opened with a walk which for a speedy runner is never a good sign. However, Fick then picked House off first and he was tagged out by Van Scoyoc in a rundown. Fick then struck out Kyle Eveland. An easy grounder to short by Chad Wolf should have ended the inning but the throw was in the dirt and skipped past, and Wolf took 2nd and Walter Woods pinch ran. Derek Bloom wouldn't bite on 2 wide ones and was then intentionally walked. Eddie Lopez ran for Bloom at 1st.

Matt Casey then slammed a double to left center scoring Woods for the lead run, but when pinch runner Lopez attempted to score all the way from 1st he was cut down on a perfect throw to cut off man Matt Valaika and the relay to the plate was perfect as Lopez slid into Sreden's bad foot. Sreden was OK, the inning was over, but Palmdale now led 1-0.

Hart now with its back against the wall needed to get something started and McCravey gave them an opening when he walked Van Scovoc.

Kevin Baker who played 2nd base all game as Pat Sarkissian DH'ed for him, now came to bat as a pinch hitter for the DH. Kevin put down a good bunt, but McCravey was on it like a cat, but as he turned to fire towards 2nd, his back foot slipped, and his throw was week, late, and not on the bag, so Baker was safe at first.

Now the defining play of the game. The Palmdale catcher Chad Wolf was stopping everything all day that was in the dirt, but with Cole Valancius at bat a ball caromed off his shin guard and the runners moved up to 2nd and 3rd. Valancius then singled sharply to left scoring Van Scoyoc and it looked like Coach Jim Ozella was going to give to the "GO" sign to Baker, but at the last minute held him up as the throw to the plate was pretty much on the money.

So Hart had 1st and 3rd with nobody out and the game tied 1-1.

Steve Sanchez took 2 pitches for balls and it looked like they were trying to get him to bite on a pitch but were basically giving him and unintentional Intentional walk.

The next pitch was on the outside of the plate to the left hand batter, and he stroked a long fly to center. The left fielder caught it, but almost fell over trying to save ground, and Kevin Baker easily scored on Steve Sanchez sacrifice fly and Hart had pulled the game out the fire with a 2-1 win in 10 innings.

This was the first time Hart had to play as a Wild Card since at least 1987. Last year Crespi, playing in Division III made the Wild Card on a special league playoff for 3rd place, then went all the way winning the Division Crown, so it can be done.

This was not the longest 0-0 game for Hart. In 1994 in the Quarter Finals at Rio Mesa the score was 0-0 going into the bottom of the 10th when Rio Mesa pulled it out with a Sacrifice Fly 1-0.

Starting pitcher Steve Sanchez threw 7 2/3 scoreless innings and drove in Kevin Baker for the winning run on a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the 10th inning to lead Hart (15-11-1). Robert VanScoyoc scored the tying run earlier in the inning on a single by Cole Valancius. Tyler Fick (6-2) pitched 2 2/3 innings of relief for the Indians. In the top of the 10th, with two outs and no score, Chad Wolf reached base on error, Derek Bloom was intentionally walked and Matt Casey doubled to left-center to score pinch-runner Walter Woods for the Falcons (12-10-1), but the pinch-runner for Bloom, Eddie Lopez, was thrown out at the plate. Palmdale batters struck out 14 times in the game. Hart will play at Murietta Valley Friday.
