HIGHLIGHTS of Game 04-28: Hart 8 - Murrietta Valley 4 (CIF-SS First Round)

Tyler Fick strikes out 10 in 3.2 innings, Hart beats Murrieta Valley 8-4.

What more can I say. It took the Hart team bus 3 hours to get down to Murrieta Valley today as they hit a major traffic jam while on the I-15 Freeway, trying to get through the I-60 Freeway Interchange. Then a road closure only 1/2 mile from the Murrieta Valley high school, forced them to backtrack to the Freeway and take the next off-ramp. So they got there about 40 minutes before game time.

Hart scored single runs in the 1st 3 innings, 2 of them "gifts", for a 3-0 lead. In the 3rd Murrieta Valley scored 4 runs to take a 4-3 lead. Hart answered back in the 4th with 4 runs in the 4th to re-take the lead 7-4.

When MV threatened in the 4th, Hart brought in Tyler Fick with 1 out and 2 on in the 4th and it was LIGHTS OUT for the next 3 and 2/3 inning as Tyler struck out 10, gave up NO HITS, walked 3.

Hart picked up another run in the 5th to make it 8-4

Hart is now 16-11-1. Murrieta Valley the 1st place finisher in the Southwestern league finished up 18-9.

Mike Evola started for Murrieta Valley and Cole Valancius greeted him with a single. Steve Sanchez sacrificed him to 2nd, Matt Valaika singled Valencius to 3rd and Steve Susdorf singled to right scoring Valancius.

Tyler Lyon started for Hart and struck out the first 2 batters, then gave up a single to Mike Evola, and got a flyout by their cleanup hitter Jim Brunner.

In the Hart 2nd: Tyler Fick was hit by pitch, took 2nd and 3rd on consecutive wild pitches and scored on a double by Robert Van Scoyoc. With that gift run Hart led 2-0.

In the MV 2nd: Lyon struck out the first batter, then got a deep fly to left. Brian Wininger got a "Baltimore Chop" single to 3rd, but Lyon got an easy force to the 2nd baseman, Kevin Baker unassisted.

Hart got another "gift run" in the 3rd: Steve Sanchez struck out but reached first on a wild pitch. Sanchez was sacrificed to 2nd by Matt Valaika, and took 3rd on a wild pitch. Steve Susdorf hit what looked like a double over the left fielders head, but it was ruled a catch by the umpire. Sanchez trotted home after the "supposed catch" which became a Sacrifice Fly. Hart now led 3-0.

In the MV 3rd: Lyon walked the leadoff batter. 1 out later he gave up a single to Blake Coddington, then got a force out at 3rd for the 2nd out. He walked Jim Brunner to load the bases. He got 2 quick strikes on Chad Richardson, but Richardson eventually lined a single to left scoring 2, putting runners on 1st and 3rd. Justin Fore then lined a double to left center scoring 2 more runs, and MV now had taken a 4-3 lead.

In the Hart 4th: With 1 out Nate Maddox walked, 2nd and took 3rd on a wild pitch. Robert Van Scoyoc singled to left scoring Maddox. Van Scoyoc was balked to 2nd. Matt Sreden pinch hit for Kevin Baker and walked. Baker re-entered as a pinch runner for Sreden. Valancius grounded to short and it looked like a double play, but the 2nd baseman totally missed the throw from short. Van Scoyoc scored from 2nd and Baker took 3rd. Sanchez sacrificed Valencius to 2nd, Baker held at 3rd. Valaika walked to load the bases. Susdorf was hit by pitch scoring Baker. Jeff Ibarra relieved Mike Evola and promptly hit Ben Edwards scoring Valancius, and Hart had answered back with 4 runs, 3 of them of the "gift" variety, but we'll take 'em. Hart now led 7-4.

In the bottom of the 4th for MV. Lyon got an easy grounder to short then gave up a single to Jim McGehee and walked Mike Allen. With the tying run at the plate only 1 out and the 2-3-4 batters coming up Hart relieved Tyler Lyon with Tyler Fick. Fick got an easy un-assisted grounder to first for the 2nd out but the runners moved up to 2nd and 3rd. Fick then got an inning ending strike out. So no runs scored and Hart still led 7-4.

Hart picked up another run in the 5th. With 2 out Kevin Baker was hit by pitch and Cole Valancius doubled to center scoring Baker. Steve Sanchez then singled to left, but Valancius trying to score from 2nd was cut down at the plate ending the inning. Hart now led 8-4.

In the MV 5th: Fick gave up 2 walks, but struck out the side.

Hart 6th. Brian Wininger relieved. With 2 out, Ben Edwards struck out but was safe on a wild pitch. Shane Carlson ran for Edwards and stole 2nd. Tyler Fick walked. The inning ended on a force out at 3rd un-assisted, leaving 2 runners stranded.

In the MV 6th. Fick struck out the side giving up a walk.

In the Hart 7th: Baker and Sanchez walked but were stranded.

In the MV 7th: Fick wasted no time striking out the side as he "mowed down" the # 4-5-6 batters.

So Fick got an easy ground out on his first batter in the 4th, then an inning ending strikeout. He struck out the side in the next 3 innings for 10 consecutive outs via strike out.

Since Tyler Lyon didn't go the required 4 full innings Tyler Fick was the winning pitcher, to go 7-2 on the season.

Steve Sanchez had 2 sacrifices in the game, tying a record held by 11 others.

After the game it was discovered that several people including the Susdorf family had their cars broken into during the game.

Hart's next opponent will be Canyon of Anaheim in the 2nd. Round. Hart lost to Anaheim Canyon at Canyon during the Easter Caliber Motors Tournament on April 7. Steve Sanchez is due to start, and they haven't seen him yet.
