I didn't think this game was going to be played. I live nearby in Van Nuys and it was poring rain at 11am in Tarzana when I finished my 3 times a week at the Cardiac Rehab workout at the Tarzana Regional Medical Center Hospital at 11:30 then went to Woodland Hills where I stopped for lunch and back home at Van Nuys by $2: 15 \mathrm{pm}$ it had finally stopped. I didn't get a call that the game was postponed so set out for Burbank.

It didn't look good heading there, I couldn't see the mountain, but when I got there it didn't even look like it had rained at all. An ugly dark rain cloud covered the top of the nearby mountain but no real rain the entire game.
In fact it was rather nice.
As usual there is always something interesting that happens at every game that Hart plays at Burbank. Mostly because of the unusual configuration of their field, and partly because unfortunately Burbank hasn't had a decent team since 1993 when the beat Hart in 2 out of 3 games (Both AT HART), and won the Foothill League Championship.
In those days they played their Home games at Foy Park on Victory and Hollywood Way.
Anyway among the new features at the Burbank field. Gone is that City Section Backstop so catchers can catch pop fouls, but the back wall is still close to home plate. Homers are no longer cheap. A new 30 foot high Net is above the left field wall, and they added an additional 10 foot net is above the already high right field wall from the Foul Pole to deep right center. So the only low wall remaining is in Deep Left Center and you deserve a homer if you can hit one there. I can still see a homer going that was hit by Cody Joyce in 1997 that hit the church across 3 rd street. So more balls will hit the screens, meaning players will have to run them out instead of getting a ground Rule Double over the shorter walls they previously had.

The most interesting thing that happened today was that Hart pitchers struck out 10 Burbank Batters, but Hart catcher Bryan Lucas got credit for only 3 putouts. Burbank Batters swung at 7 balls that were in the dirt and got away from the catcher. With a short backstop, Lucas was able to throw out 4 men at first but 3 batters reached first after a 3rd strike. Each one was costly.

In the 2nd Hart starting pitcher Steve Burton struck out the first 3 batters. Each batter swung at pitches in the dirt and the $3 r d$ batter Alex Paredes reached first safely. A stolen base and a single by Matt Kutka scored Paredes.

In the 5th with Hart leading 14-1, Burton again struck out 3 batters but all 3 were on pitches in the dirt that got away and 2 of those batters reached first safely. With 3 singles and a double mixed in Burbank scored 3 runs.

Tim Plante pitched the 6th, stranding 2 runners after giving up a double and a walk.
Nick Streit Struck out all 3 batters he faced in the 7 th and fittingly the last batter (Alex Peredes), swung at a ball in the dirt and Lucas threw him out. Peredes ran out ALL 3 of his strikeouts and was safe at First on 2 of them.

In the 1st inning the \# 3 Burbank batter, Chris Montgomery popped up a foul ball near the Hart 1st base dugout. No Hart rooter could see the play but Hart first baseman Pat Sarkissian made the catch. The Plate Umpire who was right in front of me watching the play told me it was one of the better catches he had ever seen.

As usual Hart batters facing Burbank, at Burbank were anxious to get in their "Hacks" at the Burbank pitching staff. As usual, things were happening so fast I could hardly keep up with all that was happening.
Hart went 3 up 3 down in the first. Leadoff batter, Jake Supowit was hit by pitch, but the umpire ruled he leaned into the pitch and called him out for a strikeout.

In the 2nd Hart got going. Singles by Pat Sarkissian and Jason Rehhaut was followed by a Hit by Pitch by Jenzen Torres to load the bases with nobody out. They almost got nothing out of it because there was a quick hopper to the 3rd baseman who converted it to a Home to 1st double play. Jake Hovis then got a ground Rule Double, a smash over the Right Center Field High Screen. After a walk to Trevor Matern, Jake Supowit lined a single to center scoring Hovis.

Hart had their biggest inning of the year in the 3 rd, as they sent 11 batters to the plate scoring 7 runs. Pat Sarkissian and Jenzen Torres had doubles, and there were singles by Matt Valaika, Bryan Lucas, Jake Hovis, Jake Supowit, and Taylor Maddox. Jason Rehhaut was hit by pitch, Matt Valaika walked and Trevor Matern drove in a run hitting one to the right side. Lucas's single drove in 2 runs.

Hart scored a run in the 4 th on singles by Rehhaut and Hovis.
Hart scored its last 3 runs in the 5 th on singles by Supowit and Maddox. Valaika drove both of them home with a double to Left that would have cleared the wall for a homer in previous years. Valaika scored on a sacrifice fly by Rehhaut.

Hart had 18 Hits in the game. 4 Hart Batters had 3 hits.
Hart next plays at Saugus on Wednesday (March 22, 2006) at $3: 15 \mathrm{pm}$.
