Pat Sarkissian had 15 putouts at 1st base, but the record is 17 by catcher Tom Wolf on $2 / 91990$ in 10 innings against Culver City catching Andrew Lorraine for 9 inings and Kevin Foderaro for an inning.
1 Record I can find that we tied was Most Putouts for the team 33. Done 2 times before: Against Corona Centennial in the playoff game loss in 11 Innings on 5/26/2000, and against Saugus on 4/20/2004.

Back to the Game:

It took Hart 11 INNINGS to finaly beat Burroughs today at Hart as darkness was approaching. Pat Sarkissian got his 4 th hit in 5 At Bats scoring a sliding Taylor Maddox to win 2-1.

Ian Disiere pitched a magnificant game for Burroughs going the Maximum Allowed 10 inning, giving up only 4 hits, striking out 5.
But once he reached the 10 inning Max, Hart only had to avoid the umpires calling the game on account of Darkness and having the game revert to the end of the 10 th inning and having to take a 1-1 Tie.

Hart came to bat in the bottom of the 11th, and the new pitcher Tyler Bussard immediately gave up a sharp single down the left field line to Taylor Maddox. Maddox took 2nd on a wild pitch. Matt Valaika then hit a hard line drive single to center. The center fielder had no chance to catch it but deeked Maddox into holding at second. With darkness approaching, Burroughs took their time replacing Bussard with Clay Williamson. When Williamson finally was ready, Pat Sarkissian then stroked a ground ball singe between 1st and 2nd and Maddox slid face first around the tag and Hart had a victory.

Sarkissian was the hitting star with 4 hits in 5 at bats. His double in the first inning scored Jake Supowit who led off with a walk, stole 2nd and easily rode home on Sarkissian's double.
Little did Hart know at that time, that was going to be all the scoring they would do for the next 10 Innings.
Casey McCarthy started for Hart. He gave up a HBP and a Single in the firstr, but a double play got him out of trouble, ended the inning.
In the 2nd he had trouble again. A single by Shane Murphy and a Double by Ian Didiere put men on $2 n d$ and $3 r d$ with 1 out. A fly to ball to right by Cory Howard and Murphy tried to score as Jason Rehhaut fired a strike to Bryan Lucan right in front of the plate, the ball and the runner came together at the same time, but the runner Murphy seemed to slide into Lucas's glove and the ball was disloged and the run scored. That tied the score at 1-1.
Burroughs never Scored again in the game.
Thereafter McCarthy went through the next 3 innings without trouble. McCarthy left after 5 innings giving up only 1 Run, 4 Hits struck 4 and gave up NO Walks.
A very good pitching performance, but the way Hart was not connecting solidly against the curve balls of Desiere, it looked like it was going to be a never ending game.

Steve Burton came in to pitch for Hart in the 6 th and pitched 4 beautiful innings. He gave up 2 hits struck out out 4 , walked 1 and handed the game over to Nick Streit in the 10 Inning.

Nick pitched 2 innings giving up 1 Hit, striking out 2 and got his first Varsity Win.
Only 3 Hart Batters struck out. 10 Burroughs batters went down via the strikeout roue.
Both teams only got 7 hits. Hart had only 4 hits going into the 11th., and Sarkissian had 3 of them.
Neither team made an error in the 11 innings. That is the 2nd errorless game for Hart in a row. After a poor start with the glove, the boys are starting to use the leather very well.

Bryan Lucas made a stellar play grabbing a foul popup crashing into the backstop behind home plate in the 4 th inning.
Hart had a chance to win in the 8th when Trevor Matern beat out a bunt towards 3rd for a single. Trevor took 2 nd on a fielders choice out by Jake Supowit. Nate Maddox hit a scorching liner to center but the center fielder made a nice play catching the ball for the 2 nd out.
Matern then took 3 rd on a wild pitch when they were trying to pitch around Matt Valaika. Then they walked Valaika Intentionally, bringing up Sarkissian who was 3 for 3 at that time. However Sarkissian flew out to Right ending the inning, but he got his next chance in the 11th, and then he didn't miss.

In attendance at the game was Ex-Hart Coach Bud Murray, and Ex Hart Player Dave Toledo (Hart-1999). Dave played on the 1999 team that went to the Finals at Dodger Stadium in 1999
