Hart Sweeps Canyon 9-4: Matern & Valaika Star

It was sun shining at the start of game time for once, still slightly cool. A bit windy, and blowing out.

This was a great game especially if you were rooting for Hart. You would think it's hard to find much to say about a 9-4 game but there were several intriguing facets to this game that made this game very much closer than the score indicates.

Trevor Matern entered yesterday's 11-6 game with a .087 batting average (2 hits in 23 at bats. He went 3 for 3 and drove in 4 big runs.

Today he was 2 for 3 with a double and drove in 5 BIG Runs!!!
In the last 2 games Trevor is 5 for 6 with a double and 9 RBI!!!, scored 3 runs and stole a base.

In the Hart first: Jake Supowit lined a single to right center and was sacrificed to second. Matt Valaika then crushed his first Hart Career Homer, an absolute no doubt about it BOMB to left field and Hart led immediately 2-0.

Sophomore Hart pitcher Mike Montgomery started for Hart and got a 3 up 3 down inning in the first, although John Hay hit one 700 feet. However it was 350 feet up and 350 feet down and in the windy conditions Matt Valaika had to make a nice catch.

Montgomery had problems in the 2nd giving up 3 singles and a walk to load the bases, but a double play and skillful pitching helped him escape the inning unscathed.
He left 2 men on in the 3rd and 1 in the 4th, but sailed into the 5th with a 5-0 lead.

The reason he was able to get a 5-0 lead was because of Trevor Matern.
After Hart got the 2 runs on Valaika's homer in the 1st, Canyon pitcher Colby Hyatt settled down and got 8 of the next 9 Hart batters giving up only a single to Jenzen Torres.

In the Hart 4th inning Pat Sarkissian led off getting hit by pitch. After 1 out, Torres and Bryan Lucas singled to load the bases. A popup for the second out dimmed the Hart chances. However Trevor Matern then lined a ball over the left fielders head clearing the bases. Matern was out trying to stretch his double into a triple, but the umpire signaled 3 runs had scored before Matern was cut down at 3rd, and thus Hart had the 5-0 lead.

Hart went 3 up and 3 down in the 5th and Canyon came to bat in the bottom of the 5th. Chris Kingsbury is a very tough out, and true to character he opened the 5th with a hard line single to right. Up came that man John Hay, and this time he only hit the ball 400 feet, but instead of up in the air at was a laser shot to straight away center for a 2 run homer. This was Hay's 8th homer of the season, 3rd in 3 games against Hart. Montgomery then got 2 easy ground outs but Brandon Crow lifted one to center. It looked like Hart center fielder Jake Supowit had a bead on it but the wind help carry it just beyond Supowits reach and over the wall for a homer for a 5-3 game.

The first 2 Hart batters in the 6th went out easily. The Hart crowd was stirring nervously because it was looking dim that Hart could hold the 5-3 lead with the wind definitely picking up and a nice day was turning into another very cold day. With 2 outs Jenzen Torres hit a lazy fly to center, but with the outfielders now playing deep, the ball fell in for Torres 3rd single. Bryan Lucas coaxed a walk. Hart DH Jake Hovis then lined a clutch single to left scoring Brian Klocko who was running for Torres. On the throw to the plate the runners, Lucas and Hovis moved up a base. Trevor Matern then grounded a single between short and 3rd scoring the 2 runners for his 5th RBI of the game. Matern then stole 2nd and was able to score on a single by Jake Supowit.
So Hart had answered Canyons 3 runs in the 5th with 4 runs in the 6th all after 2 out!!!!.

With a 9-3 lead Hart then brought in Nick Streit to finish the game up. Nick got a nice ground ball to short for the first out, but then Mike Loth hit a ball over Hart the center fielders head, 1 hopping the wall for a double. He was wild pitched to 3rd. A "squib" single held the runner but there were now men on 1st and 3rd. Kingsbury then singled in Loth to make it 9-4. "That Man": John Hay was up and Streit uncorked another wild pitch and Streit didn't look right. He sorta "shook" his hand and pitching coach Ruben Escobar went to the mound. After a short conversation it was decided to "Waive" John Hay to first with an intentional Base on Balls and relieve Streit with Tim Plante.

In yesterday's game, Tim Plant had pitched 2 innings against Canyon and was in trouble in both games but with the big lead he was allowed to work his way out of it. He did, and got through that game, but this was now a different situation. The bases were loaded 1 out and the tying run was in the on deck circle and the "ever dangerous" Matt Warr batting .450 with 3 homers was coming to bat. Situation was definitely not looking good for Hart.

But wait a minute!!! That wasn't Matt Warr coming to bat. Instead it was a pinch hitter, David Matthews hitting .250 in only 4 at bats on the season. Oh my, but there's only 1 out and the man has a bat in his hand, anything can happen. And it DID. Matthews bounced a shot to Jenzen Torres at 3rd, who stepped on 3rd for the 2nd out and fired across the infield to first to complete the double play and just like that Hart was out of the frying pan fire with only 1 run scored. The Hart crowd was stunned!!! But in a Good way!!!!.

Valaika singled to open the Hart 7th but after Pat Sarkissian lined out to center, Valaika was erased on a double play.

Tim Plante then took the mound and got a very quick 1-2-3 inning including a strikeout of Brandon Crow.

Hart is a little short on Pitching. With Donny Williams out, Steve Burton has a bit of stiffness in his back, but expects to pitch by Tuesday. Streit is day to day now. He was to see Dr. Bowne (Hart Team Doctor), immediately after the game.
