Hart loses to Burroughs 4-2, but Billy's back

Well we got good news \& bad news, I will give you the good news first.
Billy Susdorf (Hart-2001) who was released by the Texas Rangers right at the end of Spring training, was picked up by the San Diego Pirates. He will spend next week in Arizona and then be assigned to possibly to Lake Elsinore in the Single "A" California League.

Hart played the Last Foothill League Game at Burroughs today. Burroughs moves with Burbank to the Pacific League in 2007. The Pacific League will then be an 8 team League and will be moved down to Division 2 Next year. But there is a chance Hart could play Burroughs in the Future in the Pre League Easton Southern California Showdown tourney.

Burroughs made several changes to their field, all of them good. The Visitor dugout was moved about 50 feet further down, enabling all the stands behind the old dugout to view the game. New Poles similar to the new ones at Burbank holding up the foul ball nets completely around the ball field were up. The Home Run Piping around the entire outfield was now uniform at about 25 feet, so homers are no longer cheap. The game can now be viewed from behind the New Backstop, and the "old" City Section type of backstop is now gone. All in all, the place looked very nice.

The bad news is that although Hart was all over Ian Disiere of Burroughs today they could not get in sync with all their hits to get anything going against Disiere.

Getting a lot of hits was unlike the last time Hart saw him on March 24 at Hart. Then Disiere went 10 full innings giving up only 1 run and 4 hits. Hart won that game in the 11 th, $2-1$ once Disiere had used up his 10 inning per week maximum.

Today:
Hart had at least 1 hit in every inning. Unfortunately Hart could only capitalize in the 5 th on all the chances they had to put this game away.
Hart out hit the Burroughs Indians $9-5$ but found themselves on the wrong end of a $4-2$ score. Disiere went all the way and gave up hits in every inning but Hart left 11 men on.

Mike Montgomery started for Hart and was the victim of his own fielding mistake in the 3rd inning. He walked the leadoff batter, Nick Bozeman who entered hitting only . 182 in only 11 at bats. A groundout moved him to 3rd. Bozman then made a rookie mistake trying to take 3rd on a grounder to short and was cut down at 3rd, leaving the speedy leadoff batter Terrell Wong on first. With 2 out Ben Kasper bunted, Montgomery was on it right away, but his throw sailed high pulling Pat Sarkissian off the bag at first. Wong running on the bunt rounded 2 nd and was heading to third. Sarkissian attempting the throw to 3rd, sailed it into the left field bull pen and wong came all the way around to score.

Finally in the top of the 5 th, Hart got things going. Matt Valaika led off with his 3rd hit of the game a double. After a strikeout, Pat Sarkissian walked. The runners moved up to 2nd \& 3rd on a fielder's choice.
Jason Rehhaut then hit a grounder up the middle which the 2 nd baseman was able to flag down and made the mistake of trying to throw Rehhaut out even though he had no chance. Valaika scored easily from 3rd and Sarkissian never stopped running and easily scored on a nice slide.

So Hart led 2-1. Montgommery made another mistake walking the . 182 Nick Bozeman leading off who was sacrificed to 2 nd. A single by Wong scored Bozeman tying up the game at 2-2.

Steve Burton was brought in the relieve Montgomery.
Ben Kasper grounded out sending the speedy Wong to 2nd. A ground single between short \& third by A. J. Dupre scored Wong making it 3-2 in Burroughs favor.

Burroughs basically manufactured a run in the 6 th against Hart reliever Nick Streit. With 1 out Nick hit the DH Mike Camianica. The man he was DH'ing for, 2nd baseman Russ Walbert ran for him. Nick Bozeman singled Walbert to 3rd. On a hit and run play, Corey Howard hit a perfect double play ball to Matt Valaika, but because Bozeman was running, Valaika could only get the out at 1st with Walbert scoring, making it 4-2 Burroughs.

In the Hart 6th and 7th they had 2 on but Disiere got key strikeouts, the last to end the game.
Hart had the leadoff batter on via hits in 4 of the 7 innings. Matt Valaika doubled to lead off but 2 strikeouts and a fly out stranded him. Jason Rehhaut singled in the $2 n d$, worked his way to 3rd but was stranded. Matt Valaika had a bunt single in the 3rd and Jake Supowit singled him to 2nd. Valaika stole 3rd and Pat Sarkissian was hit by pitch, loading the bases. But a popout and flyout ended a big threat.
In the 4th Trevor Matern had a 2 out double, but a flyout ended the inning.
Hart scored the 2 runs in the 5 th as mentioned above.
In the 6th Jake Hovis led off with a single, and was sacrificed to 2 nd by Matern. Matt Valaika was intentionally walked, but Disiere got a key strikeout.

In the 7 th with 2 out, Jason Rehhaut walked. Bryan Lucan singled to center to put the tying runs on, but Disiere got a strikeout to end the game.
Matt Valaika had a great game going 3 for 3 with a walk, scored 1 run, stole a base, and had to great fielding plays at short.
Left fielder Jake Hovis made a super catch in left center with his back to home plate that looked like one that willie Mays made in the World Series at the Polo Grounds in New York. Later in the game Hovis made another great play on a drive to left center.
Jason Rehhaut was 2 for 3 with a walk and drove in both runs.

Hart will try and get a victory against Burroughs on Friday (5/5/06) at Hart at 3:15PM.
