Hart makes 6 Errors: loses 8-0 to Riverside Poly: Out of the playoffs.

It was not a pretty sight. Hart Varsity played their worst game of the season today. They made 6 errors, and Riverside Poly the \# 4 seed in Division 1, took advantage of every one of them and scored 5 unearned runs. Most of the errors were trying to get runners out on the bases. Hart "botched" all the rundown plays, dropping balls and allowing RP runners to get extra bases from which they scored when they wouldn't have otherwise.

Hart matched Poly in Hits with 5, but gave them the 6 errors plus 2 hit batsmen, 4 walks. Poly converted 3 Sacrifice flys, including 2 in the 7th.

The star of the game was Riverside Poly Pitcher Kyle O'Campo who threw a complete game shutout, giving up 5 singles, walking 2, strikeing out 3.

Mike Montgomery started and got a 1-2-3 first inning but in the 2 nd he got himself into trouble by walking the leadoff batter LaCurtis Mayes who was being scouted at the game by a Chicago Cubs scout. Then hit the next batter Matt Jenkins. A sacrifice moved the runners up and Mayes scored on a bouncer to short, but a bad throw to first enabled the hit batter, Jenkins to score from 2nd.
Score Riverside Poly 2-0
Poly Scored 2 more in the 3rd. After 1 out Montgomery hit another batter, Jake Marisnick, then walked Hector Rebago (Signed to attend USC). Jenkins singled to left scoring Marisnick and Hart fielders miss-played the relay badly allowing Rebago to score all the way from first.
RP Led 4-0.
Montgomery settled down somewhat in the 4 th giving up only a walk, but in the 5 th Rabago singled and with 1 out was singled to 2nd by Jenkins. A potential double play ball to 3rd was botched putting runners at $2 n d$ and $3 r d$ where Rabago was able to score on a sacrific Fly which would have been the 3rd out. RP Led 5-0.

Montgomery got a 3 up 3 down inning in the 6th, and Casey McCarthy came on to get playoff experience in the 7 th. He started by walking Rabago and giving up a single to Lacurtis Mayes. Before the inning was over Hart had committed 3 errors, Poly scored 3 runs, 2 coming on Sacrifice Flys. When Mayes singled he tried to take 2 nd. Hart had him out dead to rights going into second, and some how the runner (Mayes) danced around the tag, and then the runner who was on 3 rd (Rabago) tried to score and was out by a mile but the throw was low in the dirt getting away from the catcher and Rabago scored. Mayes then scored on a Sacrifice fly.
Poly Catcher, Sharif Othman hit a ball well out of the park but foul, then hit what seemed like a homer, but it died at the wall and the left fielder dropped it. A pinch runner was put in for Othman, who was promptly picked off, but Hart Botched the rundown and the runner made it to $3 r d$, where he scored on the 2nd sacrifice fly in the inning. RP Led 8-0.

Hart had almost no offence in this game, getting only 5 singles. Because they didn't score, Hart set Low Team Marks in Runs, Runs Batted in, Homers and several other Team Batting Categories.
