Hart loses 2007 Foolhill League opener to Saugus 8-1.

I'll give you some good news first. Yesterday Steve Susdorf (Hart-2004), playing for Fresno State hit 2 homers and a double, driving in 5 runs in a 9-5 victory over Dallas Baptist.

Matt Valaika hit his 2nd homer recently for UC Santa Barbara.
As for a quick wrap on the game.
Hart was in this game for 2 innings. Donny Williams gave up a run in the 1st but struck out the side and gave up a ground rule double to Tyler Brubaker in the 2 nd . Hart got a run in the 1st when Taylor Maddox hit a grounder toward 2nd and beat it out for a hit, stole second, took 3rd on a deep fly to right by Mattie Hernandez then scored on a fielders choice grounder to short by Jake Hovis.
That was the only score Hart had for the day.
It was $1-1$ going into the 3rd when disaster struck as Saugus scored 5 runs. It opened with a booming double by Cody Chew to left center. Troy Ajer then hit a shot up the middle deflected by Williams to 2nd but the play at first could not be converted. With Runners in 1st and 3rd, Williams threw away a pickoff throw at first and as the ball went all the way down to the bull pen in Right, Chew scored easily from 3rd and Ajer cruised into 3rd. From then on, there was lots of throwing errors and miss communications by Hart fielders.
Tim Plante relieved Donny Williams and had problems when the first batter executed a suicide squeeze to bring in the 5 th run of the inning.

Plante was victimized in the 4th when the leadoff batter hit an easy pop-up along the 3rd base line in foul territory. It was dropped by Bryan Lucas as Jenzen Torres who probably should have made the call and catch, bumped into him. The batter (Cody Chew) given a second chance, then singled and later scored the 7 th run.

Tyler Eyrich relieved Plante and he pitched a very good game into the 7 th when he gave up a 2 out single and followed by a triple by Nick Gauthier for the 8th Saugus run.

Tyler Brubaker was three for four with a double and two runs scored, Cody Chew was three for five with a double, an RBI and two runs scored and Troy Ajer went three for four with a run scored for visiting Saugus (4-2, 1-0). Saugus pitcher Michael Herbert pitched $42 / 3$ innings, giving up four hits and one run for the win, and Jonathan Boresma finished up the game and gave up one hit. Jenzen Torres hit a double and Jake Hovis had an RBI for Hart (3-5, 0-1).

Hart had 4 errors and a passed ball. Saugus played an errorless game. Everything Saugus executed, such as 2 sacrifices including a suicide squeeze and sacrifice fly worked perfectly.

Hart had 1 out and the bases loaded in the bottom of the 5th, but Jonathan Boersma relieved Michael Hebert and got a strikeout and a line out to end the inning and then shut Hart down for the next 2 innings.

Saugus had 13 hits and stole 4 bases.
Hart had only 5 hits by Taylor Maddox, Jenzen Torres, Bryan Lucas, Jason Rehhaut and Trevor Mattern
Torres and Rehhaut had doubles.
The Hart overall batting average is down to . 258.
Hart has now gone a record 23 games without a homer.
Hart will play Canyon at Hart on Wednesday March 21 at 3:15PM.
