Hart wins Exciting game 5-4: Torres hits 3 run homer, Trevor Brown stars.

Hart will play Saugus "at" Hart on Friday, May 4 at $3: 15 \mathrm{pm}$.
Oh my!! This game was one everyone who was there will remember for a long time.
Shawn Smith started for Saugus. 2 weeks ago he shutout 1st place Valencia 7-0 so you knew Hart was in tough. There were several unusual circumstances in this game, including a very odd play you don't often see, and it nearly cost Hart the game.

The play came with Hart leading 1-0. In the bottom of the 5th, Mike Montgomery was on the mound and had pitched a 1 hitter. With 1 out, Nick Kopaka of Saugus beat out a chopper to short. Then the next batter Brandon Young hit a perfect double play ball to the right of 2 nd base, but unfortunately the umpire was not very "agile" and didn't get out of the way. The ball hit the Ump and it was ruled a dead ball and Saugus had 2 on 1 out.
A walk to Zachary Vincej loaded the bases. Montgomery struck out the \# 3 hitter Tyler Brubaker, for the 2nd out but John Everroad doubled to left for 2 runs.
Then a squibber toward 1st base was misplayed and both base runners scored and Hart catcher Bryan Lucas trying to get the tag on the 2nd runner was slightly spiked on the hand but was able to stay in the game.
After a fly out ended the inning Hart was now behind 4-1.
The run Hart got was also the result of a bit of luck.
In fact Saugus just missed turning a TRIPLE PLAY to get out of the inning without giving up a run.
In the top of the 5 th Taylor Maddox led off with a single and Tyler Eyrich singled him to $2 n d$. Up came Jenzen Torres. With the runners going Torres hit a line shot that the shortstop snagged and easily doubled Maddox off $2 n d$. Eyrich trying to get back to 1st was a "dead duck" but the throw to 1st was wild and Eyrich was safe.

With 2 out, Mike Montgomery got his 2nd double of the game and Bryan Lucas walked to load the bases.
That brought up Danny Susdorf. I don't count pitches but Danny must have fouled off at least 10 pitches and then on a 3-2 count, drew a walk to force in Eyrich.
With the bases still loaded, pinch hitter Jake Hovis fly to left ended the inning but Hart lead 1-0 although 7 players batted in the inning.

So how did Hart win this when they were behind 4-1 after 5 innings??
In the top of the 6th the first 2 Hart batters were easy outs. Then Taylor Maddox bunted and beat it out easily. The $3 r d$ baseman trying a desperation throw sent the ball sailing down the right field line. Maddox took $2 n d$, and $3 r d$ on a passed balls. Tyler Eyrich then walked.

In to pitch in relief for Saugus was Michael Hebert, who also had shutout Valencia 2 weeks ago $3-0$.
For Hart the next batter was Jenzen Torres who was playing 1st base today. He made the critical error in the 5 th allowing the 2 unearned runs, and almost hit into the Triple Play in the 5th.
But Jenzen came through by pounding his 1st career homer to left center tying the game at 4-4.
Montgomery took the mound in the bottom of the 6th and got a strikeout and a long flyout to center. The \# 9 hitter, Kopaka the hit a sharp single to right center. Brandon Young then hit a ball up the middle, and Hart pitching coach Roland de la Maza came to the mound and they relieved a tireing Montgomery with Trevor Bauer.

Bauer had started against Valencia last Friday in his Varsity debut and pitched very well for 3.1 innings. Even though he lost, he showed enough that they brought him into this critical situation. He came through getting an easy bounce out, catcher to first.

Up came Hart in the top of the 7th tied 4-4. After a lineout and a strikeout things looked grim for Hart.
Up stepped Trevor Brown who just came up from the JV team and made his Varsity debut starting at $3 r d$.
Brown had made an error in the first inning, but with 2 on and 2 out snagged a hard shot and turned it into a force out to end the first.
He popped out to 2 nd in his first at bat, but had a sharp line drive single to left center in the 4 th which had double written all over it, but a great play by the Saugus center fielder held Brown to a single.
In the bottom of the 7 th with 2 out, Brown worked Saugus pitcher Hebert for a walk.
Mattie Hernandez pinch hit for Trevor Matern and was immediately hit by pitch.
Matern then Re-Entered the game to run for Hernandez.
Taylor Maddox lined a hard single to left scoring Brown for the lead run, but Matern went too far around 3rd and was cut down. But Hart now had a 5-4 lead.

But nothing is safe when playing at/against Saugus.
Trevor Bauer took the mound in the bottom ofthe 7 th and got an easy grounder to 2 nd by $\# 3$ batter Brubaker. John Everroad the cleanup hitter struck out.
2 out none on the Saugus catcher Cody Chew was up. Chew hit and easy bouncer to 3rd baseman Brown who threw wide to first pulling Torres off the bag.
Then Troy Ajer hit a little nubber between short and 3rd. Third baseman Brown tried to glove it but dropped it and kicked it and Ajer was safe and things at that point looked really bad, but the play wasn't over!!!.

With Brown far from the bag at 3rd, Chew rounded 2nd and thought he had 3rd made easily but pitcher Trevor Bauer had smartly backed up $3 r d$ and Chew realized too late he was going to be caught in a rundown. Trevor Brown held the ball
and ran "at" Chew who decided to commit and break towards 3rd where a throw to Trevor Bauer easly had him tagged out and Hart had the victory.

What a game. As said when I started this recap there was too many critical plays to give the game the normal wrap up. Trevor Brown in the 7th inning had gone from Hero, to Goat, to Goat, to Hero.

Hart had 12 Hits to only 6 for Saugus. But Hart had 5 errors!!
Hart left 11 men on base despite having a man picked off $2 n d$, and 2 men cut down at the plate after base hits.
Mike Montgomery was 3 for 3 , with 2 doubles and a walk. Taylor Maddox was 3 for 5 and drove in the winning run. Tyler Eyrick was 2 for 3 with a walk, Danny Susdorf was 1 for 3 with a RBI walk and Jenzen Torres had the big 3 run hommer.
Trevor Brown scored the winning run.
Mike Montgomery pitched 5.2 innings giving up 4 runs, 2 earned, 6 hits struck out 4 . Trevor Bauer got the win and is now (1-1). He gave up NO hits in 1.1 innings and struck out 1.

Hart is now 12-11 on the season (7-5 in the Foothill League).
Saugus is now 15-8 (7-5 in the Foothill League).
Checking the LA Times for April 29-May 5, I see that Valencia beat Golden Valley 10-0.
Canyon Beat West Ranch 9-3.
So Canyon moves into 2nd place in the Foothill League.
On Monday Golden Valley won its first Foothill League game against West Ranch 6-4.
