The Hart faithful had a long drive to Long Beach Millikan but they outnumbered the Millikan parents by at least 15-1 so it was like a home game for the Hart boys.

As you can expect in the rush hour, it was going to be a tough Bus drive home for the players. Many of the parents went to restaurants in Long Beach to avoid the rush hour traffic back to Santa Clarita.

Millikan pitcher Adam Bemowski was just sailing along. Hart batters were having nice cuts at his offerings but time after time, inning after inning Hart batters were popping balls up or getting nice comfortable fly ball to the outfielders.

Hart starting pitcher Casey McCarthy was also pitching a very good game but didn't have good luck in the 2nd after a hard leadoff single by Millikan catcher Bobby Barrett who was sacrificed to 2nd. A ground ball was muffed by the 3rd baseman and Barrett scored all the way from 2nd.

In the 4th, a 2 out walk to Cody Hazel was followed by a fly ball by Andrew Culver that dropped just fair down the 3rd base line, cashing in Hazel.

McCarthy didn't have any strikeouts but was keeping his pitch count down and also keeping the game close.

As said above, the Hart hitters unfortunately were not solving Bemowski.

Tyler Eyrich singled in the 1st, and Trevor Brown singled in the 3rd and 4th.

Hart had 2 men on in the 4th. With 2 out Garrett Bailey hit a ground rule double down the left field line and Trevor Matern walked but Hart could not cash in.

Then the tide turned in the top of the 7th.

Down 2-0, Trevor Matern led off and Waked.

Bryan Lucas pinch hit for Spenser Souza. Lucas blooped a single to right, Matern took 2nd.

Devin Rodriguez pinch hit for Jon Chiusano. Rodriguez lined a hard single to right loading the bases with no outs.

Spencer Moniz pinch hit for Kyle Henningfield: Moniz hit a sharp grounder at the 3rd baseman who had the ball glance off his glove down the left field line scoring Matern & Lucas and tying up the game at 2-2, still none out, men on 1st and 2nd.

Trevor Brown looped a single to center scoring Rodriguez from 2nd. Hart led 3-2 runners on 1st & 2nd.

Andrew Culver replaced Adam Bemowski at pitcher.

Tyler Eyrich sacrificed to the pitcher moving the runners up to 2nd & 3rd.

Jenzen Torres was hit by pitch loading the bases.

Mike Montgomery hit a Sacrifice fly to left scoring Moniz Hart led 4-2.

Garrett Bailey was hit by pitch loading the bases.

Trevor Matern who started the whole thing flied out to left ending the inning but Hart led 4-2.

Casey McCarthy with only 74 pitches going into the 7th, took the mound to get the complete game.

The leadoff batter Ralph Davis blooped a single to center and the # 9 hitter Danny Hall walked. McCarthy was relieved by Chris Tarello.

With no out and 2 on Tarello faced the leadoff batter Matt Roman who hit a grounder toward 3rd but the ball was misplayed.

This is where strange things happened!!!

The runner coming into 3rd thought the ball had gone way past 3rd, so went sailing around 3rd toward the plate, but Hart shortstop Trevor Matern was backing up 3rd and whipped the Ball to the plate. The runner suddenly stopped and realized he had to get back to 3rd, but the runner originally on 1st thought he would try to get to 3rd, so Hart catcher Garrett Bailey tried to run down the "dead duck" runner coming down from 3rd who dove back to 3rd, at the same time the runner that had made it from 2nd to 3rd tried to go back to 2nd. A throw to 2nd got him.

It first it looked like Hart had a double play but the umpire ruled the runner was safe at 3rd.

So there was 1 out men on 1st and 3rd.

The next batter, Cory Buchheim hit a sacrifice fly to center scoring Davis. Score now Hart 4-3 over Millikan, with a man on 1st, 2 out.

Up came Jonathan Singleton a big (6'3") left handed first baseman that scouts had told me looked like Willie Stargell. {See Note below on Singleton}.

He's only a Junior and just might get bigger, but he certainly looked big enough right now.

However Chris Tarello went right at him and got him on an easy grounder to first and Hart had the victory in hand 4-3.

Casey McCarthy got his first win of the season.. Chris Tarello got his first career save.

The hitting star for Hart was Trevor Brown who was 3 for 4 with the RBI that put Hart in front 3-2

About the 2008 Millikan Team

One of the scouts at the Valencia game told me that Millikan had a player who resembled MLB Hall of famer Willie Stargell (Pittsburgh Pirates 1962-1982), so be looking for him on Tuesday....
The first baseman is named Jonathan Singleton hitting .407 and has the only Millikan homer.

Millikan has a 6-8-1 record coming into this game. They only have 8 of the 15 games posted up on MaxPreps so far. Their field is monster sized so homers are not going to be hit over walls, I heard. Their catcher Bobby Barrett is hitting .536 (15-28). So not sure who is the next Willie Stargell. Their MaxPreps roster doesn't show heights or weights.

Millikan as a Powerhouse Team in the Southern Section.

Millikan plays in the 7 team Moore League. Because there are 7 teams, 4 teams always make the playoffs. Millikan is almost assured of making the playoffs because 3 of the schools in the Moore League are never really any good that I can remember.

From the above Link: We find 5 of the top 9 schools by enrollment are Moore League schools, including the top 3. Long Beach Poly (the Big Football Power) has the highest enrollment of 4,700 students. Millikan is 9th.

Compton has in some years forfeited a number of games because they don't have enough players due to lack of interest or academic ineligibility. You never hear about Long Beach Cabrillo. Some years they don't schedule any tournament games and just play Moore league games, and not very well. Long Beach Jordan might excel in other sports but baseball is not one of them. That Leaves Lakewood, Long Beach Wilson, Long Beach Poly and of course Millikan.

Wilson, Lakewood and Millikan always fight it out for the top spot. Long Beach Poly is there because of their size (4,700 students) and the fact that they get many great athletes because of Football mainly. So Millikan can just throw their gloves on the field and make the playoffs because the 3 bottom feeders may never get ahead of them in baseball

History between Hart and Millikan

Hart has a bit of a history against Millikan. We have played them 4 times since 1987. However Hart has not played them since 1992. Hart has won only 1 of the 4 games.

1987: The first meeting between the 2 teams occurred in the 2nd game of the El Segundo Tournament at Hart: In a close game all the way, the score was tied up 7-7. Millikan scored a run in the top of the 7th and held on to win it 8-7.

1988: The second meeting against Millikan was in the Championship game of the El Segundo Tournament in 1988. Both teams showed up at the El Segundo George Brett (Band Box) stadium at 4-0. It turned into a real slugfest. Early in the game with the bases loaded as Hart catcher Casey Burrill (Hart-1989) was swinging at a pitch, the catcher "tipped" his bat. Casey however did hit the ball and hit it over the left field wall for a home run. Millikan immediately protested that the homer didn't count, and he should only be awarded 1st base and only 1 run should score.

Everyone was checking a copy of the rules to be sure what the rule was. The Batter gets the choice of taking the hit or trotting to first on the Catcher Interference.

Naturally Casey and Hart took the Grand Slam homer. Then an inning or so later one of the Millikan players tried to bowl Casey over at the plate and was out. A mini brawl started with both teams emptying into the infield. Order was finally restored. Hart eventually won the game 14-6.

In that year (1988), Hart went on to win their next 20 games in a row to wind up the regular season at 25-0. They went to the playoffs as the Div 2 (4A in those Days) # 1 Seed. After winning their opener over Arroyo Grande 18-3, they stumbled against Fullerton losing 12-7

Starting in 1991, because Hart was putting up outstanding records in the late '80s, early 90's the Southern Section decided to move the Foothill League up to Division 1 (5A in those days).

PAGE 5:

In 1991, Hart had a "down" year for them, entering the Playoffs with a 16-6 record and Burbank (of all teams) was the Foothill League Champ. Hart was 2nd and had to play 2nd place Millikan (17-5) at Hart.

The game was scoreless into the 3rd and then Millikan started scoring runs in every inning until they built a 14-0 lead. Hart scored a "feeble" 5 spot in the bottom of the 5th, but lost easily to the Millikan 14-5.

Millikan went on to win the Div. 1 Championship that year beating Edison 8-2 in the Final game at Anaheim Stadium.

1992 Hart & Millikan again meet in the Playoffs:

Still in Div. 1 (5A in those days), Hart had a very good year and were 21-2 and entered the Playoffs as the # 2 seed. Hart won their first game against Glendale in a tight 3-2 game and opposed Millikan the # 3 team from the Moore League with an 18-5-1 record. Millikan won their 1st round game on the road against Crespi 2-1 so got the home game.

Millikan scored 4 runs in the bottom of the 2nd and breezed from there, winning 9-1.

Millikan went on to win the Div. 1 Championship that year beating Diamond Bar 5-4 in the Final game at Anaheim Stadium.

In 1993 the Southern Section had a major Re-Leaguings. Div 5A was now called Div 1. The Foothill League was set back to Division 2. Alhambra, Schurr and San Gabriel were moved to the Almont League. Hart, Burroughs and Burbank remained in the Foothill League. The Foothill League was now a 5 team league as Canyon and Saugus came over from the Golden League.

Millikan and the Moore League stayed in Division 1. So unless they were in the same tournament, the 2 teams would not meet for 16 years.

In 2005, Hart and the Foothill League finally were raised to Division 1 status, same as the Moore League and Millikan. So there is a chance to meet again in the Division 1 Playoffs but it has not happened to this point.

However after 16 years, the time has finally come in a Tournament.
