Hart Varsity gets Tied by Harvard-Westlake 6-6, Cade Kreuter Injured

Hart failed to hold a 6-3 lead going into the bottom of the 7th and Harvard-Westlake tied it with 3 runs in a dramatic inning.

Neither team scored in the 8th.

Starting the 9th, The Umpires called it when it was obvious that darkness would not allow the teams to complete a full inning.

I was hoping we would get past this first game without this tie situation because this year Daylight Savings Time begins this Sunday and tomorrow's game starts at 11AM.
So the only real chance this year for a tie happened.

Since I have been doing the Hart Stats in 1987 this is the 6th tie game.

The worst news for Hart is that Cade Kreuter was badly injured in the top of the 7th, when he was picked off and got into a rundown.

As he tried to dive back to first he jammed his shoulder it was possibly dislocated and shortly afterwards an ambulance came to take him to an emergency room.
Were all hoping Cade will get well and be able to play soon.

In the bottom of the 5th inning Cade made one of the fielding gems of the day. H-W had the bases loaded and No outs with C.J. Millar on the mound.
He got a line out to 2nd, but when the #8 hitter Sam Katz lifted a fly ball to right it looked deep enough to score a run.

Kreuter made the catch and then threw a 1 bounce strike to Hart catcher Trevor Brown to catch the sliding Andrew Shanfeld for the double play and the 3rd out.

Hart started the game well as Spenser Souza opened with a walk moved to 2nd on a wild pitch and scored on a C.J. Millar double.

After a groundout Devin Rodriguez (D-Rod) lined a single to right scoring Millar.
It was the 22nd straight game for D-Rod to get a hit and extends his Hart record in the Hit Streak Category.

Josh Wagner took the mound for Hart and didn't look as sharp as he was last Saturday in the Scrimmage against Camarillo.
He walked the first batter Oliver Lowry who was erased at 2nd of a fielder's choice by Austin Wilson a 6-4, 215 pound athlete and future high draft choice who is only a high school junior.

Wilson was singled to 3rd and scored on a sacrifice fly as Hart led 2-1.
In the Top of the 2nd, Hart missed a chance. Nolan Simons and Kreuter flied deep and Kyle Henningfield walked.
"Henny" then had 2nd stolen easily however the umpire ruled that Spenser Sousa had interfered with the catcher, and Sousa was ruled out on Catchers interference, ending the inning.

Hart got to the H-W Starter Jack Lazebnik in the 3rd when he walked the bases loaded. 2 runs were driven in on a sharp 2 out single by Nolan Simons. After 2 more walks scored another run, H-W brought in a left hand pitcher Sam Epstein who got a quick pop up to end the inning.
Hart had 3 runs in and led 5-1 going to the bottom of the 3rd.

Meanwhile Wagner was having trouble getting the first out in everyone of his 3 innings pitched as he gave up leadoff walks each innings.

It really cost him in the 3rd when he walked Lowry again and gave up a double to Wilson, both of whom scored on a single and a play at the plate that failed to get the runner.

He wasn't hit that hard, giving up only 3 hits and even the double was a bit of a flare, but he was done after 3 full innings having given up 3 runs all earned.
Wagner threw 59 pitches, only 32 for strikes, walked 3.

Epstein got Hart 3 up 3 down in the 4th.

Kyle Cook came in relief of Wagner to start the 4th and gave up a ringing double to Sam Katz. He was sacrificed to 3rd and then Cook hit Lowry with a pitch.

But Cook pitched his way out of the jam getting a foul popup to 1st and fly to right.
Epstein walked a batter in the 5th but got 3 outs.

In the bottom of the 5th, Cook gave up a leadoff walk and a single.

That brought in C.J. Millar who gave up a bunt single to load the bases with NO out but he got a line out and the fly ball double play by Kreuter to escape the jam as Hart still led 5-3.

Hart finally got to Epstein in the 6th.

Henningfield walked for the 3rd time, Sousa beat out a bunt. After 1 out, Trevor Brown walked. Devin Rodriguez hit a sacrifice fly to center and Hart had an insurance run with a 6-3 lead.

C.J. Millar got through the bottom of the 6th when Jeremy Villalovos now playing left made a great catch. C.J. finally struck out Lowry but that man, Wilson singled to right but C.J. got a fly out to Kreuter to end the 6th with a 6-3 Hart lead.

Hart couldn't score in the top of the 7th and as said above may have lost Kreuter for a while.

C.J. needed 3 outs to win it, but started out by giving up 4 straight hits and 1 run to make it 6-4.

He got a line out to 2nd but gave up a single to the # 9 hitter to make it 6-5.

With the infield playing in they got the grounder they needed to shortstop Pat Valaika who threw to the plate to get the runner but the throw to 1st just failed to get the speedy Lowry, so the bases were loaded and the dangerous Austin Wilson up.

C.J. didn't come close with a pitch and walked Wilson to force in the tying run at 6-6.

C.J. got a strikeout to end the inning but the damage was done.

Kyle Henningfield opened the 8th off Epstein with a single but Spenser Sousa hit a bullet that the short stop snagged and turned it into a double play.

C.J. took the mound in the 8th. Got a strikeout, gave up a walk with 1 out then got 2 easy groundouts to end the inning and that's when the umpires called it.

Hart plays its home opener tomorrow (Saturday March 7,2009) at Hart at 11:00AM vs Kennedy of the City Section.
