Hart 2 Murrieta Valley 0: Garrett Gooding throws 2 hit shutout

Hart Sophomore pitcher Garrett Gooding threw the 60th shutout for Hart since 1988:

This was a great game for a score keeper, the game lasted only 1 hour 46 minutes. Compiling up the Box score was nice and easy.

Garrett Gooding struck out the first batter of the game and it looked right away like he had good stuff, but after that rather than "noodleing around" the plate he came at every hitter and dared them to hit it out of the very expansive "airport" of Canyon of Anaheim baseball field.

The Murrieta Valley Nighthawks then saw pitch after pitch that they couldn't resist and although they were hitting the ball hard and far they were always within range of the very capable Hart fielders who today were errorless, unlike their 2 previous games where errors were the deciding factor.

Garrett induced 8 fly balls to the 3 outfielders, Jeremy Vallalovos, C.J. Millar and Jon Barrett. He had stellar defense from his infielders J.T. Barns, Pat Valaika, Spenser Souza and Devin (D-Rod) Rodriguez.

J.T. Barnes at 3rd saved an extra base hit in the 1st., Jeremy Villalovos made a great catch chasing down a deep liner to left center, and with 1 out in the 7th, Pat Valaika made a super play on a hard liner that hit the dirt right in front of him at short that usually "eats" up most high school shortstops.

Gooding took a perfect no hitter into the 4th with 2 out, when he gave up a clean line drive single to center by Kyle Nielsen.

The next batter Kyle Goldman hit a high chopper to deep short that Pat Valaika with those quick hands almost got him at first. But with 2 out, 2 on Gooding induced a fielders choice grounder, short to second.

That was it in the hit department for the Nighthawks a very nifty 2 hitter. Gooding struck out only 2 and walked 2.

Hart scored the only run they needed in the first.

With 1 out Pat Valaika rammed a triple to right center. Devin Rodriguez hit a grounder that was muffed by the 1st baseman scoring Valaika.

Hart missed an opportunity to score more when Nolan Simons singled to right and Jon Barrett walked to load the bases but the Nighthawks pitcher Scott Marshall got a strikeout and a grounder to first to keep the score at 1-0.

In the 2nd with 1 out J.T. Barnes getting a start at 3rd base was hit by pitch, took 2nd on a single by Trevor Brown. Pat Valaika laid down a perfect bunt between the pitcher & first and easily beat it out to load the bases. Devin (D-Rod) Rodriguez grounded to 2nd scoring Barnes but the inning ended on a strike out. Hart led 2-0.

Thereafter Nighthawk right hander Marshall pitched his way out of various jams in the next 4 innings getting key strikeouts.

Millar & Villalovos singled with 2 out in the 3rd, but a strikeout ended it.

Trevor Brown walked to leadoff the 4th, stole 2nd, took 3rd on a deep flyout by Valaika, but a strikeout and a deep drive to left center saved Marshall from any damage.

With 2 outs in the 5th Millar walked but a strikeout ended it.

In the 6th after a deep liner to left, Brown singled to right, took 2nd on a wild pitch and ran all the way to 3rd when the catcher took his time getting to the ball. But a strikeout and flyout ended it.

Marshall had 8 strikeouts to only 2 for Gooding but Hart played heads up ball. The Nighthawk batters made a lot of "comfortable" outs and would up with a loss.

If I read the Brackets correctly, Hart will play tomorrow (Tuesday, 4/7/2009), at 11:00 AM at Canyon of Anaheim. Our opponent, is from the Consolation first game losers bracket they won the 2nd game at El Modena today. I'm not sure which team, but the El Modena Brackets are between El Modena, La Quinta/Westminster, West Valley and King

High. So when we show up at Canyon of Anaheim tomorrow we will know.

Check on MaxPreps and hope the teams posted their scores. But no matter, someone will show up to play Hart.

Last I heard the Southern California weather could be in for rain and a bit of colder Tuesday night and into Wednesday morning, so that is another factor we all must consider.
