HIGHLIGHTS of Game# 09-15: Hart 10 - La Quinta\Westminster 4 (OC Nissan G# 3)

Hart beats La Quinta\Westminster 10-4 Next Opponent a big problem:

Kyle Cook who had the Hart team best ERA of 1.11 entering the game started and put LQ down easily in the first. La Quinta started their # 1 pitcher Mike Hill who was 4-0. Mike Hill is the older brother of 2 of his teammates, twins David (his catcher) and first baseman Jacob.

Hill got the first 2 batters easily but then Pat Valaika beat out a hit to short and stole 2nd. Devin Rodriguez (D-Rod) battled Hill for about 12 pitches, fouling off 1 after another then slammed a hard double to right to plate Valaika.

Jon Barrett and Spenser Souza walked to load the bases. Rodriguez scored on a passed ball and Barrett scored on a wild pitch.

Then Adam Bouyer slammed a long double to left center scoring Souza.

In the 4th Hart muscled up with 3 straight doubles. Spenser Souza hit a deep drive to center that bounced over the wall for a ground rule double.

Adam Bouyer lined his 2nd double a hard drive down the left field line and Kyle Henningfield hit a hard double down the right field line and Hart had 2 more runs. Nolan Simons pinch hit for J.T. Barnes and singled. Trevor Brown singled and Hart had 2 more and led 8-2.

Hart scored another in the 5th on a single by Devin Rodriguez followed by a hard single to right by Jon Barrett that got away from the right fielder enabling D-Rod to score all the way from first.

Hart had 6 doubles as Trevor Brown closed out the doubles parade by doubling in the 6th, taking 3rd on a wild pitch and scoring on a sacrifice fly by Pat Valaika.

Kyle Cook pitched 5 innings gave up 2 runs, 1 earned. C.J. Millar finished up pitching the 6th and 7th innings.

Tomorrow (Wednesday 4/8/2009) who will Hart play??

When the various tournament directors set up the brackets for a tournament, they are always conscious to keep same League Opponents on the opposite brackets to prevent them from playing each other.

Usually it's set up so if they both make the finals they will play each other for the tourney title, but otherwise playing a League Opponent in a Non League game or Tournament is a No-No.

So in this OC Nissan Select Tourney Hart was set up in the opposite Bracket from Valencia of Valencia its Foothill League opponent.

Both teams lost the opening game and thus both fell into the consolation Brackets. Hart and Valencia both won their 2nd games and Hart just won its game # 3 beating La Quinta\Westminster 10-4 so if Valencia beats Hemet tonight in a game at 6:30pm the Winning teams would ordinarily meet at 2PM tomorrow afternoon.

But those 2 teams would be Hart & Valencia. I believe they will set it up for Hart to play Hemet and Valencia would play La Quinta\Westminster.
