**HIGHLIGHTS of Game# 09-17: Hart 2 - Golden Valley 4 (Foothill League Game 6)**

Hart loses for "FIRST" time to Golden Valley & Nick Rhoades 4-2 on a very windy day.

I woke up this morning with an anxious feeling because it was cold and the weather report said it would be extremely windy especially coming in from the north via Palmdale.

So my worry was that I was going to be cold, but never worried about the outcome of the game.

After all Hart had never lost to the Golden Valley Grizzlies and handled them very well at Hart on March 25 on a near No Hitter by a Trevor Brown.

Of course the score was only 5-0 but the game was never in doubt, so in all honesty I was "Looking Past" them.

Yes I knew the Grizzlies almost tripped up Saugus on the Centurion diamond, losing only 3-2, but again, losing was the last thing on my mind.

The public address announcer started off by saying this was the windiest day they had ever seen at the Grizzly diamond but after all the place is only 2+ years old and was built by cutting off the top of a mountain.

The wind was just howling and blowing the infield dirt and dust from left to right. The shortstop, 2nd basemen and right fielders had almost constant dust and dirt in their eyes.

On occasion the zephyrs quieted down on the field, but you knew anything up in the air was going to be an adventure.

As it turned out the Hart fielders were flawless whereas Golden Valley made 4 errors.

Hart started out like it would do its usual damage at the Grizzly wind factory.

With 1 out Pat Valaika beat out an infield single to short. Devin Rodriguez walked, Nolan Simons hit and easy grounder to short but just as the shortstop picked it up a tremendous gust of wind blew so much dust in the shortstops face it actually knocked him down. The bases were loaded and only 1 out.

But unfortunately for Hart, left hander Nick Rhoades was able to get 2 strikeouts to end the inning.

Josh Wagner started for Hart and blew away the first batter on a nice strikeout, but in a 4 pitch walk to Chris Smith not a single pitch was anywhere close, and half went to the backstop.

When he hit the next batter Jon Granado and they easily pulled a double steal on a very high curve ball it looked like Wagner was not in some sync with his motion or he was having trouble with the mound.

He recovered nicely by getting a strikeout and a pop up.

After both teams went down in the 2nd, 1-2-3 it looked like this was going to be an interesting game. as it was settling in at 0-0.

In the 3rd Hart tried to make some noise, Trevor Brown walked and D-Rod (Devin Rodriguez) looped a single to left getting 2 on. but in between, Pat Valaika ran into his own batted bunt for an automatic out, and a double play closed a promising inning.

Golden Valley got something going in the 3rd with a 4 pitch walk to the # 9 hitter Kamran Young who took 2nd on a wild pitch and scored on a single to center by Jordan Yallen.

Yallen was sacrificed to 2nd but was cut down at 3rd attempting to steal. The inning ended on a grounder to short and a great scoop of a low throw by 1st baseman Adam Bouyer.

So Golden Valley was on the board with a 1-0 lead.

Hart threatened big time in the 4th with 1 out walks to Spenser Souza and C.J. Millar. A double steal put them on 2nd & 3rd with only 1 out but Rhoades again shut Hart down with a strikeout and a soft liner to 2nd.

In the bottom of the 4th Wagner walked the first 2 batters and his pitches were all off by a wide margin.

The runners were sacrificed to 2nd & 3rd.

A sharp grounder back to Wagner resulted in an out at the plate and it looked like Wagner could again "weather the storm".

But Nick Rhoades lifted what looked like a nice easy fly ball to right, but remember the winds were blowing and by the time the ball came down it was on the other side of the right field wall for a 3 run homer.

The Grizzlies led 4-0. After a single and a hit batter that was it for Wagner.

Kyle Cook came in and got a strikeout to end the 4th and pitched a perfect 5th and 6th.

Down 4-0 in the 5th, Trevor Brown opened with a double off the left field wall and Pat Valaika walked. D-Rod moved the runners up with a grounder to the right side. Nolan Simons lofted a foul pop up behind 1st down the line and the 2nd baseman made the catch but was off balance and his throw to the plate was late as Brown scored. Simons was credited with a Sacrifice Fly.

Jeremy Villalobos, batting for Jon Barrett was hit by pitch and Spenser Souza walked to load the bases but Nick Rhoades reared back and got a strikeout to end the inning.

Rhoades had 6 strikeouts but also walked 6 and gave up only 4 hits.

In the 6th, Rhoades was relieved by Scott Barlow and immediately the Grizzly defense let him down as Kyle Henningfield and Trevor Brown got on base via errors. With 2 out Devin Rodriguez lofted a soft liner to center. The sun was in the center fielders eyes but he had it right in his glove and dropped it as Henningfield scored. Barlow got 2 strikeouts in the inning to end it but the score was now 4-2.

In the 7th with Barlow trying to close it out, he opened with a strike out. Souza reached on the pitchers bad throw on a nubber to the mound. With the tying run at the plate Barlow got a soft fly to left and ended it with his 4th strikeout in 2 innings.

Hart batters struck out 10 times, many at inopportune times as Hart had runners in scoring position with less than 2 outs in 5 of the 7 innings leaving an astounding 12 runners on base as the result of 4 hits, 6 walks and 4 batters reaching on errors.

Wagner pitched 3.2 innings, gave up 4 runs, all earned, only 3 hits but walked 4 with his 3 strikeouts. Kyle Cook got all 7 batters he faced with 1 strikeout.

Golden Valley made the most out of their 3 hits, the big one the 3 run homer by Rhoades following 2 walks. The first Grizzly run in the 3rd was the result of an inning opening walk so basically both team seemed to be giving the game away but GV pitchers got key strikeouts when it counted, and Hart went down for the first time in the 3 year History between the 2 teams by a 4-2 score.

When Valencia opened in 1996, Hart won the first 18 games between the 2 teams over the 6 year period thru 2001.

Valencia finally broke the streak in the first meeting in 2002 and has been closing the gap to 23 - 17 thru the 1st game this year.

So Golden Valley has served notice on the Foothill League that teams can no longer figure them as an automatic win on their schedule.
