## There is a Lot to read after this 10-8 Loss and a great History of Homers especially especially Grand Slam Homers:

Hart players hit 5 homers but fall to Valencia 10-8.
For Box Score of game \# 20, for 2009 scroll to the Top of this .PDF File:
There was a nice brisk wind blowing straight out to left field, but it wasn't as cold as I was expecting.
After Hart went down 1-2-3 in the first and Valencia went Homer, Walk, Homer, Walk, Single, then a disastrous error on a possible double play ball for 2 more unearned runs, Hart was suddenly down 5-0.

You had to figure this was going to be another slaughter with Hart's head on the chopping block.
The Valencia homers in the first were by Christian Lopes, his 9th of the year. Lopes is only a Sophomore and had 10 last year as a Freshman.
Dylan Jones hit his 3rd homer to deep right center.
Josh Wagner started for Hart and again did not seem in command anytime in his 3.2 innings.
He walked the leadoff batter in 3 of the 4 innings and technically walked all 4 "first up" batters since he gave up a leadoff homer to Christian Lopes in the first; he then walked the next batter.
4 of his 5 walks scored. 4 of the 9 runs he gave up were unearned due to 2 costly errors. Mainly he was behind on almost every batter and just did not look like he did when he had early the season shutout against $D-1$ champion Simi Valley and they way he pitched against Hemet.

So Hart came to bat in the 2nd down 5-0. Devin Rodriguez led off with long fly down the right field line, and the wind kept it in fair territory for his 6 th homer of the year.
After a single by Spenser Souza and a walk by Jon Barrett, J. T. Barnes came to the plate with 2 out and stroked a ball into the right center field gap.

It looked like both the right and center fielders both had a chance to get to it and that was the problem as both players with their eyes on the ball slammed head on, the ball bounding to the wall. The right fielder was down and out, the center fielder was hopping around on 1 foot like he had a had a "hot foot" and had his glove in the air like he had caught the ball.

But every fan on the Hart side of the field saw the ball rolling towards the wall and encouraged the runners to keep going and they finally made it across the plate as J.T. Barns had hit his first Varsity homer a 3 run inside the park shot and suddenly the score was Valencia 5, Hart 4.

The right fielder Alex Pittman fortunately was $O K$ but an inning later he could not continue in the game.
Pat Valaika "scalded" a ball to left but directly at the right fielder for the 3rd. out.
Lopes led off the 2nd with a walk and worked his way around on 2 singles making it Valencia 6 Hart 4.
Devin Rodriguez singled with 2 out in the Hart 3 rd but was stranded.
Wagner walked the leadoff batter in the $3 r d$ and was in serious trouble the whole inning but escaped with out giving up a run leaving runners on $2 n d$ \& 3 rd.

In the top of the 4 th, Spenser Souza led off with a monster homer to dead center. With 2 out J.T. Barnes singled and Valencia starting pitcher David Hausman was removed 1 out short of being the pitcher of record for the win.
Kyle Eaton came in to pitch. Pat Valaika singled but both runners were stranded. Hart was now behind only $6-5$.
In the bottom of the 4 th, once again Wagner walked the leadoff batter, Dylan Jones.
Then he got a pop up and a fly out but couldn't close it out as he gave up a double to freshman Trey Williams scoring
Jones to make it 7-5 and a single by Alex Bishop putting men on 1st \& 3rd with 2 out.
Wagner was relieved by C.J. Millar who wild pitched Bishop to 2nd.
Then disaster struck as an infield grounder was thrown in the dirt at first and both runners scored. Millar then
struck out the superstar Christian Lopes but the damage was done. 3 more runs had scored in the inning making it
Valencia 9-5.
But Hart was not done:
With 1 out in the 5th, and Eaton on the mound, Devin Rodriguez hit a "no doubt about it" homer to dead center, his 2 nd of the game and 7th of the year. Nolan Simons lined out hard to center but then Spenser Souza "crushed" a long homer to the same spot that $D$-Rods homer went for his 2 nd of the game and 5 th of the year.
It was now 9-7. Jon Barrett walked and Adam Bouyer pinch hitting for Kyle Henningfield singled toward 2nd but a grounder to short ended it.
Hart had 5 homers, but 4 were solo shots but still had 2 more at bats to catch the Vikings.
C.J. Millar pitched a great bottom of the 5 th getting 2 strikeouts and a pop up but Hart batters went down easily in the top of the 6th.

In the bottom of the 6th, with 1 out Trey Williams the freshman hit a high fly right down the left field line. It was hooking foul and Williams stayed at the plate. The umpire was looking for his partner for the call but the Base umpire couldn't determine if it had hooked foul before or after it passed the foul pole so the plate umpire "flipped a coin in his mind" and decided to call it a fair ball and Williams had his 2nd homer of the season making it $10-7$ Valencia. Millar easily got the next 2 batters.

In the Hart 7th, and down 10-7.
Devin Rodriguez slammed a double down the left field line his 4 th hit of the game. Nolan Simons singled $D-R o d$ to 3 rd.
Spenser Souza slammed his 4th hit of the game to left center scoring D-Rod making it 10-8.

## PAGE 4:

Jon Barrett walked for the 3rd time in the game loading the bases with NO OUTS.
Valencia brought Dylan Jones in to pitch.
Jones struck out the first batter, then got a tailor made grounder right at him and just like that the Vikings turned a 1-2-3 double play, the game was over and Hart lost 10-8.

Then on Friday 5/1/2009 Saugus will play at Hart at 3:15pm.

* Note *: Both games were against Burbank and "at" Burbank which at the time was like a Pony or Little League team compared to Hart.
Also at the time the Burbank field ground rules allowed all balls hit over the right and right center field fence to be homers.
That has since been changed to be ground rule doubles, and I believe the fence is a little higher now but the short dimensions haven't changed.

So the 5 homers by Hart on Friday 4/24/2009 at/against Valencia are much more impressive.
The 5 Homer parade has been done 4 times now.
The other 5 homer games for Hart since 1987:
1.) 5/05/1995 G\# 24 Against Burbank at Burbank (same rules as above at Burbank)

This was the only game in the 5 \& 6 homer category that was accomplished at Hart. It could have easily been a record but the Mercy rule was in effect at the time and after Hart had a 16-0 lead after 3, Hart coach Bud Murray started subbing, so they only got 1 more inning to bat in the 4 th and went scoreless.
Matt Friedrichsen hit 2 homers and Jamie Shields hit 1 to tie the season at 11 apiece which is still the high player season record.
Ryan Haag and Justin Wiley hit the other homers.
Better yet, it was the Semi Final game Playoff victory over Don Lugo at Hart giving Hart the right to go and win the Championship vs Righetti at Anaheim Stadium.

More on Grand Slam Homers \& SLAMS in Playoff Games
Pat Valaikas Grand Slam Homer in the 2nd inning against Valencia was the first in almost 6 years for a Hart Player: http://www.hartbaseballstats.com/HARTBS06.pdf

Grand Slams were much more common in the 1990's.
Casey Burrill (Hart-1999) now the West Ranch Coach hit the only Grand Slam in 1988 when Hart went $26-0$ before losing in the 2nd game of the playoffs.

There were no SLAMS in 1989 when Hart went all the way to Dodger Stadium only to lost to Cerritos $4-1$.
4 SLAMS in 1990 but none in 1991 and 1993.
Thereafter lots of Slams
Kevin Bell hit a Slam in a playoff game in 1996 against Mayfair High.
1997 and 1998 were banner years with 6 each.
Chris Wright hit 2 GS homers in a single game against Saugus in 1997
Eric Horvat hit 2 Slams in 1997.
Bob Potruch hit a Slam in the Quarter Final game (Loss) at West Torrance in 1997.
Matt Friedrichsen hit 2 Slams in 1998.
Matt hit another in 2000 and stands alone with the most Hart Slams with 3.
Only 2 were hit in the Championship year of 1999 (Jamie Shields Hart-2000) and his cousin Tim Hutting Hart-1999)
Thereafter Hart hit 2 or 3 per year through 2003.
Chris Valaika (Hart-2003) Pat's brother hit his first homer of his career against/at Valencia in 2001.
Craig Cohen hit 2 Grand Slams in 2002
Danny Williams had the 3rd Hart Slam in the playoff first round game against Westlake, and suddenly none for almost 6
