Hart wins in 11 innings 4-3 over Saugus as C.J. Millar stars:
For Box Score of game \# 21, for 2009 scroll to the Top of this .PDF File:
In a great game that went 4 hours and ended with a strikeout with the bases loaded Hart survived a "MUST WIN" game at Saugus but throughout the game it seemed Hart was doing everything they could to give this game away.

In the end it was the "gutsy" pitching of C.J. Millar that shined for the last 6 innings but his first 2 innings were nothing to write home about. He almost was the goat in the 6 th and 7 th innings.

Hart had a 3-1 lead with Josh Wagner pitching in relief in the bottom of the 7 th. Josh hit the first batter, his 2 nd hit batter of the game and his seasons 12 hit batter tying the record set by JP Slauenwhite in 2002.
When he walked the next batter, coach Ozella relieved Wagner with C.J. Millar.
The leadoff batter, Soucy sacrificed the runners to 2nd and 3 rd.
Then with Stefan Cordes up, C.J. Balked the runner in from 3rd, to make it 3-2.
In the bottom of the 7th with that 3-2 lead, C.J. struck out the first batter but gave up a long homer to Zach Vincej the All League 4 year Shortstop for Saugus.
I was surprised to see that was the first homer of the year for Vincej.
C.J. Got the next 2 batters but the score was tied and the game went into extra innings.

Saugus relieved starter Kyle Hooper with Tommy Kister and both teams battled scoreless into the top of the 11 th.
That man C.J. Millar doubled with 1 out. They walked Pat Valaika intentionally.
Both runners stole 2nd and 3 rd on a strikeout.
Up came Trevor Brown who drove in the 3rd Hart run in the 3rd inning with a sacrifice fly.
Trevor hit a high bouncer to third that the 3rd baseman had to wait to come down and Trevor just beat the throw to first as Millar scored as Hart now led 4-3.

But this game was far from over.
C.J. Millar took the mound in the bottom of the 11th, his 6 th inning and the game was now his to win.
C.J. walked the leadoff batter Stefan Cordes but got a pop up on the \#3 batter Brett Piper and struck out cleanup
hitter Nick Lombardi.
That brought up Zach Vincej who up to that point had hit the game tying homer and walked 4 times.
Sure enough, he walked for the 5 th time.
Aaron Hooper then was hit by a pitch to load the bases, bringing up James Threw.
C.J. gave it everything he had and struck out Threw and finally Hart had this game in the win column.

Hart didn't start out the game too well. Pat Valaika opened with a double but he was stranded.
In the 2nd singles by Nolan Simons \& Spenser Souza and a walk by Jon Barrett loaded the bases with none out but just like the last inning against Valencia on Friday the pitcher in this case Kyle Hooper got a strikeout and then a double play and Hart didn't score.

Garrett Gooding started for Hart and put Saugus down but they hit the ball hard.
In the 2nd Gooding was in a mess of trouble as he walked 2 and hit a batter to load the bases but escaped without giving up a run.

In the 3rd after a 1 out walk, a 2 out error prolonged the inning. After another walk loaded the bases Gooding was relieved by Kyle Cook who walked the first batter he faced forcing in the first run of the game.
So Saugus led 1-0 after 3 innings and they had NO hits.
Hart answered back in the top of the 4th. With 1 out Nolan Simons walked and Spenser Souza hit an absolute no doubt about it BOMB to left making it Hart 2-1. The Homer was Souza's 6 th of the season and at that point he had 6 straight hits after he went 4 for 4 with 2 homers against Saugus last Friday.

In the 4th, Cook gave up a single, and then got a double play, but after giving up a double, coach Ozella relieved Cook with Josh Wagner.
Wagner got an easy grounder to end the inning.
Hart made it 3-1 in the 5th when Pat Valaika opened with his 2 nd double of the game, was sacrificed to 3rd by Jeremy Villalovos and scored on Trevor Browns sacrifice fly.

Hart out hit Saugus 12-5 but Hart pitchers walked 11 Saugus batters and hit 44 others and Hart players committed 3 errors.

In 2000 Hart lost a Quarter Final game 5-4 against Centennial Corona in 11 innings at Hart.
In 2004 Hart \& Saugus tied after 11 Innings 6-6 at Hart.
In 2006 Hart beat Burroughs 2-1 in 11 innings at Hart.
