It was a "must win" for Hart today. Hart needed this win to tie Saugus for 3rd. By winning the first 2 they had the tie breaker, but that loss after the Spring Break to Golden Valley needed to be negated.

It didn't happen and the first 2 innings was a telling point.
Hart had the bases loaded in the first 3 innings and had 2 men on in the 3rd and they got nothing out of any of those runners.
In all, Hart had 11 men left on base.
To make matters worse Hart has lost its 2 nd right fielder of the season.
Senior Jon Barrett fractured his wrist colliding with Saugus first baseman Aaron Hooper in the 5th.
Spenser Souza got a 2 out hit in the 5th, and stole 2nd. Jon Barrett hit an absolute bullet that the first baseman made a marvelous play on the short hop. He started to run to first but saw he might not beat Jon to the bag so tossed to the pitcher who stepped on the bag for the out...

But the first baseman Aaron Hooper couldn't stop his momentum and crossed in front of Jon Barrett as Barrett and the pitcher crossed the first base bag.
Jon jammed his hand into Hooper's chest and that's when the break happened.
Hart Senior Cade Kreuter dislocated his shoulder in the opening tie against Harvard Westlake and has been out for the season.

On paper this looked like it was going to be a cake walk for Hart, but they don't play the game on paper.
Saugus has only basically only 2 pitchers on their staff as Darren Schweitzer is no longer on the team.
The 2 pitchers Aaron Hooper and Tommy Kister worked 7 and 4 innings against Hart on Wednesday, so they started Kister to see how far he could go.

Well as said, Hart had base runners all over the place but they couldn't get their hits in "sync" and then in the 4 th and 5th Kister put the Hart batters down.

Kyle Hooper who pitched 7 full innings on Wednesday came in the 6 th and walked a batter but got out unscathed.
In the 7 th with a 3 run lead Hooper gave up a 2 out double to Devin Rodriguez and hit Spenser Souza but got a game ending strikeout and Hart could only walk off the field with their heads down.

Trevor Brown started for Hart and was perfect for 2 innings, getting 2 strikeouts.
In the 3rd he walked the leadoff batter Aaron Hooper.
James Threw bounced a single over the infield and both runners were sacrificed to $2 n d$ \& $3 r d$.
Things went from bad to worse when a grounder right at 3rd was thrown high to the plate, Hart catcher Kevin Bailey had to leap for the throw and came down on the runner Hooper, who had slid across the plate. A grounder to 2nd which would have been the inning ender scored Threw and Saugus led 2-0.

Brown got through the 4th but opened the 5th walking Threw.
After a sacrifice and another walk he gave up a hard line single by Stefan Cordes hit very sharply loading the bases. Hart got a force out at the plate and then a hard liner to center ended the inning but Brown looked done.

Brown was relieved by Kyle Cook in the 6th. Once again a leadoff walk put Hart in jeopardy, but Cook wiggled out of trouble despite another error in the inning.

Josh Wagner pitched the 7th as a slight drizzle started on a day that was threatening rain entire time.
After an out he walked Stefan Cordes. Zach Vincej who had hit the game tying homer on Wednesday got his first hit of the day. Another single by Brett Piper scored Cordes, and the Centurion dagger went deeper into Hart's heart as that boosted the lead to 3-0.

Wagner got a pop up and an inning ending strikeout. But 3-0 was too much to over come.
The Hart batters started out like something big was going to happen but it never materialized. 3 singles by Nolan Simons, Trevor Brown and Spenser Souza in the first loaded the bases, but 2 strikeouts foiled their chance to score.

In the 2nd with 1 out C.J. Millar was safe on an error, Kyle Henningfield singled to center and Pat Valaika was hit by pitch so Hart again had the bases loaded with only 1 out. A fielders choice grounder nailed Millar at the plate and then Trevor Brown hit a screaming liner to left and the left fielder James Threw made the biggest fielding gem of the day as he grabbed it before it could clear the bases.

In the 3rd with 1 out Spenser Souza was on via an error and stole 2 nd and 3rd. Adam Bouyer walked but Hart again couldn't score and had left 8 men on at that point.

Hart had 6 hits to only 4 for Saugus but Saugus got them when runners were in scoring position and Saugus was the beneficiary of 6 walks to only 2 for Hart. Saugus also executed better as a well placed sacrifice by Justin Sheehan, the \# 9 hitter moved the runners into scoring position and both paid off with the help of an error.

Now Hart will have to hope that Golden Valley can knock off Saugus next week at least 1 time.
Hart will play 2 against Canyon next week starting Wednesday at Canyon at 3:15PM. Then Friday at Hart
The following and last regular season week Saugus will have their hands full with Valencia while Hart takes on West
Ranch which will not be a walk in the Park for them either.
West Ranch is now rated the \# 2 Team in Division 1 and that is a great feat for a team that has played Varsity
baseball for only for 3 years.
So we will see how the schedule plays out. Hart still has the Tie breaker on Saugus as the result of winning 2 out of the 3 games the teams played.
