**HIGHLIGHTS of Game# 09-25: Hart 4, West Ranch 2 (Foothill League Game 14)**

Hart still in the running for 3rd place in the Foothill League, beats West Ranch 4-2, Brown stars on Mound

Today was Hart Senior and it was a great ceremony for the 10 graduating seniors. It went off so well without a hitch that it was done by 3:10 and so the Umpires started the game 5 minutes early which is rare for these types of games.

Hart maximized what little offense they had and managed to score 4 runs on 4 hits. The runs scored as a result of a fielder's choice, 2 runs scored on an infield error, and a critical run scored on a squeeze play.

West Ranch had problems making contact against Trevor Brown as he struck out 8 and gave up only 4 singles. Brown only walked 2 and that was key, as in previous games Hart had been giving up too many free passes and in many cases it hurt.

But today Hart had the Pitching and Defense and that will win you a lot of games especially when playing quality teams.

West Ranch just a week ago was #1 in the CIF-SS Division 1 Coaches Poll but dropped 2 games to Valencia to drop to 9th in the CIF-SS Division 1 Coaches Poll.

With their 3rd straight loss today coupled with a Valencia 10-3 win over Saugus today at Valencia, The Valencia Vikings cinched first place in the Foothill League and the West Ranch Wildcats will have to settle for second place.

What Hart needs is another win on Friday at West Ranch and Valencia to knock off Saugus, at Saugus. Both could be "tall orders". For both Valencia & West Ranch their place in the standings will not change, but they will both have a tremendous outcome in the 3rd place battle between Saugus and Hart in the Foothill League on Friday.

In the 1st inning Trevor Brown gave us an indication of what this game was going to be about when he struck out the side.

West Ranch started their #1 pitcher, Trevor Fredricksen who gave up only a hard hit single by Trevor Brown off the 3rd baseman's chest in the first.

Brown got through the 2nd with a little mishap.

The leadoff batter Allen Sarkissian slammed a drive deep to center but C.J. Millar ran it down and made a great over the shoulder catch for the first out.

Casey Watkins struck out but reached first on a wild pitch 3rd. strike. Watkins was wild pitched to 2nd. Brown then picked Watkins off second but then gave up a walk. Trevor ended the inning with a strikeout. So Brown had 5 strikeouts thru the 1st 2 innings.

In the 3rd Spenser Souza slammed a hard double down the left field line that one hopped the wall. Souza then stole 3rd. C.J. Millar was hit by pitch and then stole 2nd so Hart had men on 2nd & 3rd with no outs.

One out later the runners were still there but J.T. Barnes scored Souza with a grounder to first.

Daniel Dietz walked but the inning ended on a sharply hit ball that the shortstop Cal Vogelsang made a nice play off the bat of by Pat Valaika and forced Dietz.

But Hart was finally of the board as they were shut out in their first meeting vs. the Wildcats 8-0.

Brown got through the 3rd giving up only a looping single to right by Fredricksen.

In the bottom of the 3rd, Nolan Simons walked but was picked off. Trevor Brown walked and Devin Rodriguez lined a hard single to right sending Brown to 3rd. D-Rod took 2nd on a wild pitch.

After a foul infield pop up, C.J. Millar hit a nice easy grounder to 2nd but miracles do sometimes happen as the ball was muffed. Brown and Rodriguez both scored on the gift and Hart led 3-0.

In the 4th, Trevor Brown walked the leadoff batter Jake Bernards. Not a good idea. Allen Sarkissian forced Bernards but Casey Watkins singled hard to left sending Sarkissian to 3rd.

Cody Howard then lofted a sacrifice fly to right and the Wildcats were on the score board with a run.

In the 4th with 2 out Pat Valaika was hit by pitch and stole 2nd. Nolan Simons struck out but reached on a dropped 3rd strike wild pitch and runners were on 1st & 3rd, but Fredricksen got a strikeout to end the inning.

Brown and Fredricksen both got easy 3 up and 3 down innings in the 5th.

Brown got a groundout and strikeout to start the 5th but Sarkissian reached second on a 2 base infield error.

Casey Watkins then singled in Sarkissian.

That was it for Brown as he was tiring.

C.J. Millar then came in relief to face Cody Howard. Trevor Brown then took over at catcher from Kevin Bailey. On the 2nd pitch to Howard the ball was in the dirt and Watkins took off for 2nd. Trevor Brown's throw was a bit high to Pat Valaika as he swiped tagged Watkins who over slid the bag at 2nd by at least 4 feet. At first Valaika started to show the ump that he had the ball and had made the tag, but the ump was not saying anything because the runner was still off the bag and Valaika was actually on it.

The runner Watkins then without a base, decided to break for 3rd. Valaika easily got Watkins in a "pickle play" which went 2-6-5-4.

Hart was out of the inning with a very tenuous 3-2 lead.

In the bottom of the 6th, Adam Bouyer pinch hit for Kyle Henningfield and slammed a booming double down the right field line.

Henningfield then re-entered as a pinch runner for Bouyer.

J.T. Barnes got a great bunt down towards first and almost beat it out, but did his job as Henningfield was at 3rd.

Daniel Dietz walked and Pat Valaika tried a squeeze bunt but it was foul.

But Valaika got the squeeze down on the next pitch and Hart had an all important run making it 4-2.

In the top of the 7th, C.J. Millar got an easy grounder to 2nd and a strikeout but the 8th place batter Jared Ortiz hitting .429, kept the inning alive with a sharp ground single between 1st and 2nd.

West Ranch then sent up Ryan Keller to pinch hit for Fredricksen. Keller went to a 3-0 count then fought off several pitches foul and finally struck out and Hart came away with a real hard won victory.

Both teams will be back at it on Friday at West Ranch.
