HIGHLIGHTS of Game# 09-26: Hart 9, West Ranch 11 (Foothill League Game 15)

Souza hits for the Cycle but Hart blows 9-0 lead to lose 11-9 to West Ranch

Today on May 15, 2009, Spenser Souza had the first Cycle for Hart since 1989.

Ray Gardocki did it on May 19, 1989 in the first game of the playoffs against tiny little La Salle as Hart slaughtered them 23-4. Ray was 5 for 6 that day...

So just 4 days short of 20 years ago that feat was again accomplished by Spenser Souza.

Spenser was the Quarterback for Hart last fall and is quite the Scholar besides being a great Athlete.

Spenser has an Academic Scholarship to the prestigious Cornell University, an Ivy League school located in Ithaca New York.

Spenser plans to "walk on" for Football as a wide receiver.

At this point, Cornell is expecting him as a walk on but has discouraged him from trying out for Baseball. So his baseball future is uncertain.

The Loss by Hart today was tempered by the fact that Saugus "upset" 1st place Valencia 14-10 today. Thus Saugus with a 9-6 record is 3rd and Hart with an 8-7 record is 4th.

So Hart could not attain the automatic playoff berth of a 3rd place team in the Foothill League.

Instead Hart will go to the playoffs as a 4th Place "AT LARGE" team in the Wild Card Round.

The new Rule is found on the CIF-SS Playoff Bulletin for Baseball.

Basically: The Southern Section has put in the Rule starting this year.

The CIF-SS has allowed a Wild Card place for 4th place teams in a 6 team league (5th. in 7 or 8 team Leagues) that have a .500 or better Overall Record and who played Quality competition in their Non League games.

Hart came in 4th with a 14-11-1 record (8-7) in the Foothill League so qualifies on all accounts.

The Wild Card game will be played on Tuesday May 19, 2009, so we have once again made the playoffs.

The Game UGG.

Wow, losses don't get any easier, but this one today takes the cake.

It will be long remembered by every Hart fan there, as one that really got away, big time.

Hart was sailing along with a 9-0 lead going into the bottom of the 5th.

How did they get there?.

Spenser Souza was the main catalyst.

In the 1st inning Pat Valaika singled to left and was bunted to 2nd by Nolan Simons, took 3rd on a fielder's choice.

With 2 out the Wildcats wanted nothing to do with Devin Rodriguez, so they walked him intentionally.

Turned out to be a bad idea for the Cats.

Spenser Souza hit an absolute Bomb on into a bit of a wind. The ball would have gone out of any park including Yellow Stone. Amazing!!! Hart had a 3-0 lead.

In the 3rd. Nolan Simons led off with a walk but 2 outs later was still on first and up came Spenser Souza who hit a deep drive to right that had a chance to go out, but not quite. It hit the wall and the right fielder Mitchell Thompson crashed hard into the fence and went down and when the dust cleared Simons had scored on the triple by Souza. C.J. Millar walked and stole 2nd and the throw to get him went into center and Souza scored, Millar taking 3rd. So the extra gift run put Hart ahead 5-0.

In the 4th, The Cats starting pitcher Allen Sarkissian got 2 quick outs, but Pat Valaika then hit a line shot down the right field line that just cleared the foul poll only 300 feet down that line. Simons walked and that was it for Sarkissian.

In came their Ace Reliever Ryan Keller but Hart bats were hot now.

Trevor Brown singled. Devin Rodriguez hit his 13th double of the season bringing in 2 more runs.

The Spenser Souza slammed a double down the left field line scoring Rodriguez.

The Wildcats replaced Keller with J.C. Cloney and C.J. Millar got an infield single, but the rally ended on a fielder's choice.

No problem the 4 additional runs brought the score to 9-0.

Meantime C.J. Millar put down the first 6 batters. The Cats got the bases loaded in the 3rd on 2 singles and a hit batter but C.J. worked his way out of it. 2 more batters were left in the 4th.

In the Hart 5th J.C. Cloney put them down 1-2-3.

In the Cats 5th Trevor Fredrickson pinch hit and got a double in the gap.

After a fly out to left a pop fly on the infield was dropped, putting runners on 1st and 2nd.

A single by Sarkissian made it 9-1. Then Jake Bernards walked to load the bases. Casey Watkins then hit a Grand Slam homer to the short porch in right making it 9-6.

After a ground out, Cody Howard hit another homer to the right field short porch. Score now 9-6. Millar got the final out via strikeout.

West Ranch brought in Cody Howard to pitch the 6th down 9-6.

With 2 out Devin Rodriguez walked and up came Spenser Souza, a Single short of the Cycle.

After fouling off several pitches Souza hit a shot just foul down the left field line. Then he hit a nubber towards 3rd that the 3rd baseman had no chance on and just ate the ball.

So Spenser had his Cycle. He did it in perfect Reverse Order. (Homer, Triple, Double, Single). Hart was leading 9-6, but that 5th inning for West Ranch needed an answer back.

C.J. Millar hit a single to short center field and Devin Rodriguez attempted to score from second, but was cut down at the plate.

With Hart only ahead 9-6 now, that was a crucial play for West Ranch and with the inning ending on that play they seemed energized.

Josh Wagner took the mound in the 6th to hold the 9-6 lead.

After an opening strikeout, leadoff batter Jared Ortiz grounded a single to center.

Cal Vogelsang hit a hit shot toward the shortstop side of 2nd that Pat Valaika got his glove on but it skipped away, in fact all the way to the left center field wall scoring Ortiz making it 9-7 and Vogelsang was on 3rd. Sarkissian scored him with a sacrifice fly making it 9-8.

A single, Hit by pitch and a triple by Nico Rusconi turned the game around as the Wildcats now led 10-9. After another walk Wagner was replaced by Kyle Cook who gave up 2 more singles for another run making it 11-9.

That was it, Cody Howard put Hart down in the 7th, getting a double play after Adam Bouyer reached on an error by the shortstop.

A strike out ended the regular season and Hart must now wait on their petition to the Southern Section for the "At Large" Berth.

Check below for further content about our wild card opponent we will play next Tuesday.

The Southern Section will not release the Playoff Brackets on Division 1 until between 12 Noon and 1pm on Monday, but

you can bet on traveling to the game. The Marmonte League Teams are the nearest to Hart.

Next is the 6 team Pacific View League.

But it's possible we could travel to Orange County or even way out to the Inland Empire, at this point I haven't a clue.

Hart plays at Camarillo Tuesday 5/19/2009 at 3:15pm

Hart will open the Playoffs in the Wild Card round on Tuesday May 19 at 3:15pm against Camarillo.

Hart plays Camarillo almost every year in the Scrimmage games but this is the first game that counts since 2007. Hart has played Camy 5 times winning 4.

Hart got into the playoffs due to the new "At Large" Rule that allows 4th place teams in a 6 team league an "At Large" berth in the playoffs if they had an "Overall Record" of .500 or better.

6 Teams made it as "At Large" selections in the Wild Card Round.

Those teams are listed with an "at" ("@") sign after their League Placement # in the Brackets.

If Hart gets by Camarillo they have to travel way down to South Orange County to play JSerra the # 2 Seed out of the Trinity League.

Saugus who got the Foothill League Automatic 3rd place bid fared no better and in fact may be in worse shape.

They have to play Oxnard in the Wild Card Round.

Oxnard was the Class of the Pacific View League but 5 of their players were found to have played in a Sunday Beer League and had to forfeit 5 League victories. They still had better than a .500 record so made it as the 4th place "At Large" Team from the Pacific League.

What I'm wondering is whether those 5 players are still qualified to play or are done for the season.
