Hart Season ends on a Sacrifice Fly: Camarillo wins 7-6

Hart played the same team in the last game of the season as we did in the first game.
That first game was a scrimmage game and the same pitchers started for both teams, but the results were entirely different.
In the Scrimmage game, Hart knocked around the starter Taylor Hansen as they scored 14 runs in the first 5 innings. But today Hanson, a sophomore held Hart in check for 5 innings.

At first it looked like this was going to be Hart's day.
Pat Valaika opened the game by beating out a "nubber" to 3rd, and was sacrificed to $2 n d$. Trevor Brown walked and Devin Rodriguez blooped a single to left loading the bases with only 1 out for Spenser Souza.

Spenser who hit for the Cycle in his last game on Friday vs West Ranch blasted a drive way over the left field fence but FOUL.
Then he hit a hot shot towards short and it was turned into an inning ending double play. Not a good omen.
Wagner gave up 2 singles to Steven Catalano and Andy Yingling the bottom of the 1st for a run.
Hart answered back in the $2 n d$.
C.J. Millar opened up with a single to center. 2 outs later he had reached 3rd on a passed ball and fielders choice.

Daniel Dietz showed what he did best before he came up from the JV's by getting plunked in the helmet.
Pat Valaika then doubled in Millar making it 1-1, sending Dietz to 3rd, but the rally ended on a fly to left.
Wagner put Camy down 1-2-3 in the bottom of the $2 n d$.
Hart then took the lead in the top of the 3rd.
With 1 out Devin (D-Rod) Rodriguez slammed his 8th homer of the season to left and Hart led 2-1.
The lead didn't last. In the bottom of the 3rd, with 1 out Wagner walked the leadoff batter Kevin Minjares, gave up a single to Steven Catalano and Parker Hindle scored Minjares with a sacrifice fly.

Both teams went down 1-2-3 in the 4 th.
Josh Wagner seemed on his game for the first 4.2 innings. But the 5 th inning turned the game.
With the score tied 2-2, the opening batter in the 5 th Hunter Virant (the \# 9 hitter), popped up foul at first and the ball was dropped.
Wagner then got him swinging on strikes, but the Camarillo coach protested that the ball was foul tipped and trapped by catcher Trevor Brown.
The plate umpire conferred with first base umpire who agreed with the Camarillo coach and Virant had another life and finally popped up.
Then Wagner got another Pop up and things looked fine, but perhaps not.
Wagner then gave up a controversial walk as the Hart faithful booed the umpire.
The number 3 hitter Andy Hindle lined a single to left.
Then the unthinkable....
Andy Yingling the best Camy hitter smashed a 3 run homer to left and the score was suddenly 5-2 in Camy's favor.
But Hart answered back in the 6th. Hansen was tiring and walked C.J. Millar and Adam Bouyer. J.T. Barnes ran for Bouyer.
Hansen was relieved by the Camarillo ace closer Justin Chamberlain a freshman.
Dallas Bacon a freshman up from the JV team made his Hart Debut and moved the runners to 2 nd and $3 r d$.
After a strikeout, things looked dire for Hart but leadoff hitter Pat Valaika bounced a single over the 3rd baseman's head driving in 2 runs.
With Valaika stealing, Nolan Simons hit a ball to the vacated shortstops original position.
The shortstop got to the ball and then made an ill advised throw toward first that was down into the bullpen and Valaika scored all the way from 1st to tie it up at 5-5.
Simons took 3rd on a wild pitch but the inning ended on a grounder to 1st.
C.J. Millar then relieved Wagner in the bottom of the 6 th but after an opening deep fly to left he gave up a pinch bloop double to Marco Guttierrez. After a ground out to short a ringing double by Virant gave Camarillo the lead back 6

But Hart would not go away quietly in the top of the 7 th.
With 1 out Spenser Souza singled to short, took 2nd on a single to left by C.J. Millar. Souza and Millar pulled a double steal to put runners and 2 nd and 3 rd with only 1 out.

Adam Bouyer re-entered and fought off several pitches and finally grounded to 3rd. scoring Souza on the fielder's choice to tie up the game at 6-6.
A strike out then left Millar on 3rd.
In the bottom of the 7th., Millar got a fly out but Hindle slammed a double to left. Millar then walked Yingling intentionally.
The strategy backfired as Millar uncorked a wild pitch putting runners on 2nd and 3rd.
They tried to get Hanson to bite on some bad pitches but he didn't go for it and the bases were loaded for Mike Erb with 1 out.

Mike Erb had sent 3 flies to the outfield in his first 3 trips to the plate and he sent a fourth fly to center, and it was deep enough.
Daniel Dietz throw was no where near getting Hindle as he crossed the plate with the winning run on the Sacrifice Fly.
