Hart Beats Thousand Oaks 3-1, to Play Chaminade at HOME Tuesday 3/9/10
As the game started there was an occasional drizzle but the sun peeked through the mean looking clouds in the 2 nd . The day was cold however and I was glad the T.O. score keeper invited me up to the scorers booth up in a 2 story loft with a great view of the game.

As the Hart faithful walked to the parking lot at Thousand Oaks today they all had the same feeling: This was a great game, well played, you just don't see games like this very often at the high school level.

Left Fielder Luke Persico made a dazzling catch in foul territory in the 1st.
Right Fielder Nolan Simons made great plays on difficult slicing fly balls toward the line.
Pat Valaika made his usual slick fielding shortstop plays with his quick hands.
Catcher Kevin Bailey made a sensational catch of a short foul pop up behind the plate and other great plays by
errorless Hart fielders made the game a pleasure for the many Hart parents who made the trek to Thousand Oaks on a day that looked threatening throughout.

There were at least 3 Rainouts of the 16 games played in the Easton Tournament and thus many teams still do not know their Tuesday Opponent, due to the Make Up games that must be played on Monday.
But Hart knows its Opponent will be Chaminade at the Hart Diamond on Tuesday at 3PM.
THE GAME!!!
Hart scored in the top of the 3rd when Daniel Dietz walked and stole $2 n d$ \& 3rd then scored on a Sacrifice Fly by Pat Valaika. Reminds me of Maury Wills when he played for the LA Dodgers in the early 1960's.

James Scott Started for Hart and pitched a very good game during his 4 innings. He got in trouble in the 3rd when after 1 out, he hit a batter then gave up 2 singles to load the bases.
He almost got out of the inning unscathed but Hart just missed converting a double play and the only run for T.O. scored, tying up the game 1-1. That was his only tough inning, but the T.0. pitchers were keeping the Hart batters at bay and Scott was relieved by Josh Wagner in the 5th.

Josh Wagner was the winner, pitching a scoreless 5 th \& 6th, giving up only 1 hit, walked 2 struck out 2.
Hart took the lead in the 6th., 2-1 on a clutch single by Daniel Dietz.
It was a bit of an odd situation:
Alex Tenorio walked and stole 2nd., then was Balked to 3rd.
T.O. Coach then pulled the pitcher Lange and brought in Ginther.

James Scott hit a fly to short center, Tenorio had to hold 3rd.
Luke Persico was intentionally walked, then stole second.
Kyle Cook hit for J.T. Barnes and grounded to the drawn in 2nd baseman who threw out Tenorio trying to score from 3rd, Persico took 3rd.
Then Dietz got the clutch line single to right, scoring Persico.
The odd situation was trying to figure out who the run belonged to:

1. The pitcher who put Tenorio on base to start the inning or:
2. The 2nd Pitcher who put Persico on, who not only scored the run but made one of the 2 pitchers in the inning the losing pitcher.
At the time I felt the run and loss belonged to the 1st pitcher, but the runner he put on that was out was not out via a force out so perhaps I should have made the 2 nd pitcher responsible for the Run and the Loss. Not my worry, I believe T.O. will give the Loss and run to the 2 nd Pitcher Ginther. Then I'll change it.

Back to the game:
With a slim 2-1 lead Hart got a mini rally going in the top to the 7 th., with 2 out.
Kevin Bailey singled to left center and stole 2nd.
Wagner then doubled in what proved to be an Insurance run to make it 3-1.
Theo Stafford made his varsity debut for Hart, as he picked up the save in the 7th. He gave up an inning opening single to Cortes then got a snappy force play at 2nd on a good play by Pat Valaika.
Then as it started to drizzle, Stafford struck out the final 2 batters for the first victory of the season for Hart which is now 1-1.
T.O. dropped to 0-2.

That's the first victory by Hart over T.O. since I've been doing stats. Since 1981 T .0 . leads the series now at 4-1-1. T.O. out-hit Hart 6-5. The Hart Offense is lagging as they are hitting only .196 after 2 games.

But the Hart Pitching staff has a 2.50 ERA and is holding opponents to a .186 Batting Average.
The \#9 hitter for T.O., Bobby Cortes who was 3 for 3 vs Ventura on Friday, went 2 for 2 with a walk vs Hart, so is 5 for 5 and a walk on the season so far.
T.O. Leadoff hitter James Brady was the only other player in the game to have more than 1 hit going 2 for 4.
