Hart beats Harvard-Westlake 8-2: Trevor Bauer K's 15 in 8 Inn. for UCLA:

Trevor Bauer (Hart-2008-9), strikes out 15 in 8 innings for UCLA vs Mississippi State in Corpus Christi Texas: Part of the fun today was keeping track on Game Tracker on how Trevor was doing as the UCLA game started in Texas at the same time as the Hart vs Harvard-Westlake game. Trevor struck out 15 batters through 8. He had a 5-0 shutout into the 9th but gave up a walk and a double for a run and he was relieved by Klein who gave up the inherited run so Trevor was charged with 2 runs, but got the win to go 3-0 as UCLA is still undefeated at 12-0.

Jamie Shields (Hart-2000): will start opening day for Tampa Bay for 3rd Year in a Row. I'm told that Jamie and his wife are expecting their 2nd child around opening day.

Hart beats Harvard-Westlake 8-2 at Birmingham High:

The new \$800K renovated Harvard-Westlake Diamond will be getting their new turf next week in nearby Franklin Field, but had to play against Hart at Birmingham. The Warriors beat Valencia 4-0 on Thursday so it figured to be a tough game for Hart. The game was scheduled for 3pm instead of 11am to allow several players from both teams to take the SAT Tests and several Hart players trickled in as game time approached. One of the SAT taking players penciled in to start at first base was Steven Russo, who was still not there as Hart was preparing to take their Infield Warm-ups. Then we were informed that while going from the SAT Test to his home, Steven was rear ended by another car in Santa Clarita and would be late. Alex Tenorio took Steve's place at 1st base.

In the first, Daniel Dietz reached first on a shortstop error, sacrificed to 2nd and stole 3rd, but with only 1 out Hart failed to get him home.

In the bottom of the first, James Scott was on the mound for Hart. Warrior star, 6'5" Austin Wilson who many scouts were there to see, led off taking a inside curve on the shoulder and was aboard with a HBP. Wilson took 3rd on a single by Oliver Lowry. A bunt only got Lowry to 2nd as Wilson had to hold but a fielders choice scored Wilson and a triple to right by Jordan Orringer scored Lowry and Hart was behind 2-0.

Hart had 3 singles by Kevin Bailey, James Scott & Luke Persico in the 2nd to get 1 run back. Scott settled down and started getting batters out for the next 4 innings.

Meanwhile Hart playing "small ball" finally got it going in the 4th. Scott was hit by pitch, Persico bunted for a hit, J.T. Barnes singled to short and when the shortstop tried to get him at first anyway he threw the ball away, scoring Scott. Dietz hit an easy grounder to short but the first baseman muffed a perfect throw and Persico scored. Harvard-Westlake then brought in Austin Kamel to pitch. Dietz then stole 2nd. A wild pitch scored Barnes and Dietz took 3rd. With 1 out Pat Valaika hit a sacrifice fly to deep center scoring Dietz for the 4th run in the inning. Hart now led 5-2.

Hart had 4 hard hit singles in the 5th., by Bailey, Scott, Persico and J.T. Barnes but only got 1 run as Bailey was caught stealing.

Hart scored another run in the 6th. when Thomas Bilbo led off with a double. Harvard-Westlake brought in another pitcher, Connor Dillman. With 1 out Bilbo stole 2rd and continued home on a throwing error by the catcher.

In the 7th. Garrett Gooding led off with a flyball double down the left field line. Scott reached on another shortstop error and Daniel Dietz lined a sharp single to right scoring Gooding for Hart's 8th run.

From the 2nd thru the 5th James Scott pitched a great game as H-W never got another hit off him after the 2 hits in the first inning.

Garrett Gooding Relieved Scott in the 6th and gave up a single but got a nifty 6-4-3 double play. In the 7th, with 1 out Joe Corrigan tripled down the right field line. Gooding then struck out the next 2 batters, including Austin Wilson for the final out.

Harvard-Westlake only had 4 hits and the formerly silent Hart bats racked up 13 hits, their high for the year. Luke Persico was 3 for 4. Kevin Bailey, James Scott & J.T. Barnes each had 2 hits. Daniel Dietz had 2 RBI's and stole 2 more bases as did Pat Valaika. Hart again ran the bases stealing 7 more sacks. James Scott got his first win. He gave up only 2 runs (both earned), 2 hits, struck out 3, walked 2 and hit 2 batters. Garrett Gooding is unscored upon in 7 innings (3 appearances), in 2010. Hart raised the Team Batting Average up to .279 with the 13 hits. The Warriors helped out making 5 errors and all of them were crucial as only 4 of the Hart 8 runs were earned. The scoreboard operators were HW players and they were calling many of the Hart hits as errors, and gave the only Hart error a hit to the Warrior batter.

Single Game Individual Pitching Record set against Moorpark

After our game against Moorpark, I mentioned that the 6 doubles by Moorpark Batters was a Team Record against Hart. What I failed to mention was that the 5 doubles hit against Hart pitcher Alex Tenorio was also a record. The previous Single game Pitcher record was 4 Doubles. Brian Hernandez (Hart-1997), had 4 doubles hit against him by Santa Margarita in 1997. 2 Games later, Bobby Graves (Hart-1997) gave up 4 doubles to Fountain Valley in 1997. Then in 2002, Chad Smith (Hart-2003), gave up 4 doubles to El Modena.
