HIGH SCHOOL BASEBALL: Hart squeeks past Golden Valley 10-9

CANYON COUNTRY - It was not artistic, but Hart High of Newhall will take its 10-9 victory today at Golden Valley in the Foothill League baseball opener.

The game lasted more than three hours and included 10 errors (six by Hart), 17 walks, four hit batters, three passed balls and numerous mental mistakes by both teams.

It was only fitting that an inexcusable mistake ended the game when a Golden Valley pinch-runner was caught sleeping and was picked off third base for the final out.

Hart's Josh Wagner (4-0) pitched four relief innings to earn the win, Kevin Bailey's two-run single in the sixth gave Hart (6-2, 1-0) the lead for good, and Theo Stafford pitched the last inning for his third save in three opportunities.

"It wasn't pretty, but it was nice to get the win, especially in the league opener," Wagner said. "We're a lot more mature than this, and next game we're going to play the game the way it's supposed to be played. I just think we were a little nervous and excited at the same time. Now that we've got our first (league) win, we'll be better." Added teammate Patrick Valaika: "We didn't play our game but we were glad to get the win."

Golden Valley upset Hart on the same field last year in what was probably the young program's most significant win ever. This time, the Grizzlies (3-4, 0-1) have just two seniors in the lineup, and it showed under pressure.

"We got bit by the young-guys bug and just made too many mental mistakes," Golden Valley coach Scott Drootin. "The play at the end, the pinch-runner was a sophomore. Too many critical mistakes. Just a sloppy game."

Down 4-2 in the third, Golden Valley rallied for three runs and batted around without the benefit of a hit, parlaying three walks, two hit batters and a two-run outfield error.

Then Hart came right back with a two-run rally highlighted by Nolan Simons' RBI double to regain the lead 6-5, only to fall behind again when Golden Valley pushed two more runs across in the bottom of the fourth to go up 7-6.

"I've got to give my kids credit because they kept coming back," Drootin said. "I would love to say I'm still happy after a 10-9 loss, but I'm not. I think we had a chance in this one."

In the top of sixth, Hart scored three runs, including Bailey's two-run single that scored Valaika and Tyler Glasnow for an 8-7 lead that the Indians never relinquished.

Yet the bottom of seventh was scary, even with Hart's top closer Stafford on the mound. Golden Valley's Josh Granado got aboard on a fielder's choice, advanced on a wild pitch and scored on an error. With runners on first and third and Josh Smith at the plate, Stafford picked off a pinch-runner at third as Rocky Sherwood was running from first to second on a catcher's indecision.

"I definitely like being in situations like that," Stafford said.

Hart's Danny Dietz was 2 for 3 with two RBIs, Simons was 2 for 4 with a double and an RBI, and Wagner was 1 for 3 with an RBI-double, two runs, a walk and a stolen base.

Brandon Smith singled and scored twice for Golden Valley, and Tanner Swine added a double and two RBIs. Scott Barlow, who entered with 25 strikeouts in 11 2/3 innings, took the loss, giving up six runs in 3 2/3 innings.

I decided against a Play by Play of the game, instead will give a few observations and links to other stories on the game.

Observations on the Golden Valley game:

The Golden Valley lead off batter Kamran Young almost ended the Hart season in the bottom of the second when Pat Valaika took an easy throw from 2nd baseman J.T. Barnes and ran across the 2nd base bag to complete the force out on a grounder by Billy Fredrick.

It wasn't a double play attempt, and that was the 3rd out, but Young came sliding into the bag with both spikes up like the pros do!!!!....

This type of slide is ILLEGAL in high school ball. The umpire gave the big out sign and I assumed he had given Young the "Your Kicked Out Of The Game" sign which is the usual penalty for this type of play and could also result in suspension from the following game.

The Golden Valley fans and his team mates gave Young a standing Ovation as he returned to the dugout as Pat Valaika lay injured on the ground. I'm told Pat had a spike wound on the knee and thigh.

Valaika limped to the dugout: The BIG Surprise, Kamran Young took his place in left field. Pat Valaika, the first batter in the 3rd. was called out on strikes. He singled to right his next appearance, so hopefully is OK from the injury.

The question is why was Young allowed to stay in the game??
I've seen other players kicked out of games for much less of an infraction on plays around second base.

Sitting at the game it was 100% different from a year ago when the wind was howling and it was freezing cold. It was T-Shirt weather, and there was no wind at ground level to speak of.
However!!!!

There was numerous very high pop-ups to the infield and a few to the outfield and all were basically miss judged. One time in the 4th., Riley Sherwood hit a mile high pop up that was either going to be caught by Hart pitcher Garrett Gooding or catcher Kevin Bailey, but then landed in the outstretched glove of Hart 3rd baseman Josh Brown.

That was possibly the only high pop-up that was caught the whole game.
So even though there is no wind at ground level, the field is about 80 feet from the edge of the cliff that surrounds the field from left field around to right to right so the air currents that blow against the mountain must be very turbulent high up over the infield and at the areas along the left or right field lines.

The Golden Valley players should be used to it, but they were having the same problems as the Hart players who will only play 1 or 2 games a year at this field.

Hart will play the last game of the Regular Season at Golden Valley on Friday May 14, 2010 at 3:15pm.
Golden Valley Pitcher Scott Barlow:

The Golden Valley pitcher Scott Barlow came into the game with glowing stats having struck out 25 men in 11 innings, including 17 against Eastside of Palmdale.

The Hart record for strikeouts in a game was 16. Done 2 times by Bobby Graves in 1997 and 1 time by Trevor Bauer against West Torrance in 2008:

Barlow pitched very well against Hart last year in all 3 games getting the Save when GV beat Hart in their only victory against Hart 4-2. In the game in the 6th inning his team made 3 errors behind him as Hart got a run to pull to 4-2. They made another error in the 7th, but he shut the door.

He pitched runless ball in 2 innings of relief in the first game at Hart.

In the 3rd game at Hart he started well getting 3 strikeouts in the 1st 2 innings but faltered in the 3rd, gave up 3 runs. 1 run in the 4th and a leadoff walk in the 5th and was gone.

However he had a nice Pitching line against Hart in 2009: Here is the record of the Foothill League pitchers vs Hart in 2009:

Note he had a nice 2.63 ERA in 3 games (8 Innings) vs Hart.

In Friday's game he was wild giving up 3 runs as he walked 3 in the 2nd inning. Hart scored another in the 4th and 2 more in the 5th. So he gave up 6 runs, 5 Earned, struck out 5 but walked 6.
