Valencia jumps on Hart for 8-2 Foothill League win at Hart. Montgomery to pitch A+ Opener:

Hart gets knocked out in first inning with 5 run burst:

There's nothing like a quick five-run lead to boost a pitcher's confidence.

So when Valencia High scored five runs in the top of the first inning today at Hart, Valencia's Brennan Bernardino pitched like he did not have a care in the world. The 6-foot-4 left-hander didn't try to overpower anyone, settling for throwing strikes and letting his infielders do most of the work in an 8-2 Foothill League victory.

"When we scored those five runs, it was like a big weight was lifted off my shoulders," Bernardino said. "I still had to go out and pitch, and I feel like I did all right. I just really love my team. They work hard on their hitting, and they were rewarded today."

Bernardino (3-1) pitched five innings, giving up two earned runs on eight hits with three strikeouts.

Valencia (7-2, 4-0) added two runs in the top of the seventh to remove any drama.

"I thought Brennan pitched really well and did a good job getting out of jams," Valencia coach Jared Snyder said.
"It's huge mentally when you get that early lead, and Brennan did a good job pitching with a lead. He gave up hits but he didn't give up runs."

Valencia's Quincy Quintero sliced an opposite-field two-run home run off the scoreboard above the right-field wall in the first inning, and Shane Zeile added a solo home run in the fourth. Kyle Eaton added an RBI-double and two runs, and Adam Tapia singled, scored and had a walk.

Valencia won its fifth in a row, as the Vikings have outscored opponents 66-16 during the streak. Snyder Said:

"The thing I like about this team everyone in the lineup believes in the guy behind him, so no one takes selfish at-bat

Zeile is the nephew of Todd Zeile, who hit 253 home runs in 14 major league seasons, two with the Los Angeles Dodgers. "I thought we played with a lot of intensity. We just need to keep that going," Zeile said. "Brennan really stepped up for us, especially against our rivals. It's great to be on top in this one because every game against Hart is intense. We worked hard and we did what we wanted to do."

Because of a quirk in the schedule, it was only Hart's second home game of the season. The Indians (7-4, 2-2) have lacked power - no one has a home run - but has won most games because of good pitching, tight fielding and scrappy base running.

But Hart hasn't seen many opponents like Valencia, and a five-run hole was too big to crawl out of.

"We've got to come out and compete better. Everyone needs to do their jobs and execute," Hart's Daniel Dietz said. "We talked before the game about not giving up a big inning. Power is not our game this year, so we need to do what we need to do to pull out some wins."

Dietz hit a long triple to left center in the fifth inning and scored on Nolan Simons' single. Simons was 2 for 4 with two RBIs, and freshman Luke Persico scored Hart's other run by leading off the third with a leadoff walk, advancing on J.T. Barnes' single and eventually scoring on Simons' grounder to second.

What I want to add to Gerry Gittelson's article is that the best pitching of the day was turned in by Tyler Glasnow. Entering the game Tyler had pitched in 2 games and had faced 6 batters and walked 5.

With 2 on and 1 out in the 2nd, and Hart down 5-0, Tyler Glasnow entered the game and struck out 2 batters, although both runs on base scored due to a wild pitch, passed ball and an error.

In the 3rd Tyler Glasnow struck out 2 more men and got a strikeout in the 4th., giving up a homer to Shane Zeile. He had a 3 up 3 down inning in the 5th.

In his 3.2 inning stint, Tyler didn't walk anyone and all his pitches looked sharp. His ERA improved from 63.64 to 7.00. The batting average against him is only .188.

Garrett Gooding pitched the 6th and struck out 2, giving up only a walk.

Garrett has pitched 16 innings in 2010 and has an ERA of .088

Theo Stafford walked James Bonds with 2 out in the 7th. but got the final batter.

So after the 1st inning, Hart played a very good game.

For Hart, Nolan Simons, Pat Valaika and Kevin Bailey each had 2 hits and Hart actually out-hit the Vikings 10-8. Simons drove in both Hart runs.

There was a definite Hart connection to the Valencia Lineup.

Shane Zeile is the nephew of Todd Zeile (Hart-1983) and the son of Mike Zeile (Hart-1982).

Todd and Mike played baseball for Hart in 1980 thru 1982.
