## PAGE 3: 04/05/2010 @ El Modena HIGHLIGHTS of Game\# 10-14: Hart 3 - Torrance 4 (OC Nissan Tournament Game \# 2)

Hart Blows 3rd straight game in last inning 4-3 to Torrance
Hart is in the loser's bracket in the OC Nissan tourney, but that doesn't mean the opponents are going to be any easier.
Torrance is a Division 4 team in the Pioneer League, but faced Hart with a 9-3 record and has not played any league games yet.

As everyone left from Santa Clarita for this game it was poring rain, but the coach at El Modena assured coach Ozella that there was no rain in Orange County, so everyone started out on the long trek for this baseball Mecca for Easter tournament games.

On the way, everyone had the same thoughts
How are we going to play this game against Torrance when its raining on the freeway so hard your wind shield wipers can't keep up.
I arrived extra early to check into a hotel just off the 91 Freeway at the Imperial Ave off ramp, near Canyon As I passed Cal State Fullerton on the 57 Freeway, it was poring, but I could see off to the left and ahead, it looked pretty good in the El Modena area.

When I arrived at the Imperial off ramp which is only $1 / 4$ mile from Canyon of Anaheim, it started to drizzle and was raining pretty good when I checked in.

The rain didn't last too long and when I arrived at El Modena, the El Modena coaches and players were furiously working on the skin part of the infield, shoveling off the mud and replacing it with the dry dirt.

The game started about a half hour late because the infield was pretty soaked.
There was a big black cloud that was hanging over the El Modena however, but it only drizzled a little and then the cloud left, the sun came out and it was nice the rest of the day, except for the outcome of the game!!!

There was a ton of scouts at the game because due to the rain, the National Classic, Anaheim Lions, Beach Pit Barbecue and even the OC Nissan game at the Anaheim Canyon Venue were canceling the first Morning games, so this was basically the only game in town at the 12 Noon hour \& scouts were there to see Angelo Gumbs the Torrance Super Star in action.

Josh Wagner started for Hart.
He got 2 quick outs. Up came Angelo Gumbs and the scouts all had video cameras on him. But Wagner pitched Gumbs carefully and walked him. Then a wild pitch put him in scoring position. An errant pickoff play at $2 n d$ sent him to 3rd. He scored on a single by Marvin Flores.

Torrance got another run in the 3rd. Leadoff batter Tyrone Taylor was hit by pitch. After 1 out Taylor was forced out on a dropped fly to center hit by Gumbs. Gumbs took 3rd on an error and then scored on a double by Trent Gilbert.

Meanwhile Hart batters could not solve the slow curve of Torrance pitcher Josh Mingura. He had Hart batters beating the ball down into the dirt killing lots of worms. His fielders were making the tough plays. With all the ground balls however Hart was getting a lot of hits but couldn't put 2 of them together to get anything going.

Finally in the top of the 6th., the Torrance fielders started to fail to make the plays and Hart pushed across a run. James Scott was safe on an error. Thomas Bilbo ran for Scott. Garrett Gooding hit for Steve Rosso and moved Bilbo to 2nd. Josh Brown was safe on the 2nd baseman's error and Bilbo scored all the way from 2nd. Luke Persico and Nolan Simons walked to load the bases with 2 out, but a strikeout left Hart still down with the score 2-1.

Kyle Cook relieved Wagner in the bottom of the 6 th and gave up a single with 1 out but Kevin Bailey now catching threw the runner out stealing.

Torrance left Mingura in the game to start the 7 th, but with 1 out his defense failed him again.
Bailey was safe when the catcher threw away his bunt, Bailey making it to 2nd. James Scott was safe on an error Bailey took 3rd. Alex Tenorio pinch hit in the DH spot and got an infield single scoring Bailey to tie the game at $2-2$. Torrance replaced Minguera with Tyrone Taylor. Taylor immediately threw a wild pitch moving the runners to 2nd \& 3rd with only 1 out. A squeeze bunt was popped up for the second out.
Luke Persico then lined a hard single to left scoring Scott but Tenorio tried to score from 2nd and was cut down easily at the plate for the 3rd out but Hart had the lead 3-2.

Theo Stafford came in to pitch to close out the win, but once again it was not in the cards for Hart. Stafford got the first batter on a long fly to center. Leadoff batter Taylor lined a single to left. Ivan Dominguez lined a single to right. Angelo Gumbs hit a soft flyball single to left load the bases.
Stafford then got a called 3rd strike on the cleanup hitter Flores for the 2nd out.
Stafford battled Trent Gilbert but eventually walked him forcing in the tying run. With the bases still loaded, up came the starting pitcher Minguera who promptly slammed a long drive to left center that eluded the diving Nolan Simons.

The winning run scored as Simons lay prone on the ground. He eventually was able to walk off and the Hart team walked off the field with another devastating loss.
Hart is supposed to play the loser of the 12 Noon game between Los Alamitos and Corona, that was supposed to be at Anaheim\Canyon but because of the wet field, the game was apparently played elsewhere. Since it's right next to my hotel, I checked to see who it would be, but the lady in charge didn't even know where or if the game was played.

All I know is we will play at Tomorrow (Tuesday) at 12 against Los Alamitos or Corona.
One of the parents noted Hart has been leaving a lot of men on base and wondered if $I$ had info on that.
