HIGHLIGHTS of Game# 10-18: Hart 8 - Valencia 3 (Foothill League Game # 7)

Hart beats league leader Valencia 8-3: Wagner pitches complete game, Valaika has 4 RBI's

On Monday the CIF-SS Coaches had voted Valencia 5th best team in Division 1. Then they knocked off Hart on Wednesday 7-5.

Hart finally put it all together today at Bud Murray Field as Josh Wagner pitched a complete game and Pat Valaika had a great day going 2 for 3 with a double, 4 RBI's and a walk.

Josh Wagner looked like he was in command right from the start.

In the first inning with 1 out, he gave up a hard line single to right to James Bonds.

He got 3 up 3 down innings in the 2nd. & 3rd.

A 2 out looper on the line to right in the 4th fell for a single. Otherwise he was sharp and mainly was not walking anyone.

For the Vikings, Quincy Quintero led off the 5th, with a high fly to right that carried and cleared the wall for a homer to make it 6-1 at the time.

So what got us to this 6-1 lead.

In came Jake Roberge who last year shut Hart down cold after they took an 8-0 lead in a game which Hart eventually lost 17-10.

This time Daniel Dietz immediately singled hard up the middle scoring Barnes, & sending Simons to 3rd., Hart led 4-0. Up came Pat Valaika. Dietz stole 2nd, then Valaika lined a sharp single to center easily scoring Simons and the speedy Dietz scored from 2nd, making it 6-0.

James Scott popped to short but Valaika stole 2nd., and took 3rd on a wild pitch. Kevin Bailey walked and stole 2nd. Hart was looking for more, but the inning finally came to and end as 10 men had come to bat with 5 scoring.

From that point for the next 3 innings Hart was unable to score. J.T. Barnes and Thomas Bilbo had infield singles but the game had settled into a pitchers duel with Hart holding a 6-0 lead until Quintero broke Wagner's shutout with his homer in the 5th..

In the top of the 6th., Shane Zeile singled up the middle. Hart then had Zeile picked off but a bad throw and Zeile was safe at 2nd. James Bonds then singled in Zeile to cut the lead to 6-2 with no outs.

A line drive to right by Trey Williams had extra bases written all over it but Thomas Bilbo made a circus catch for the first out. Then Wagner got what he needed most, the pitchers best friend, a Round the Horn double play as J.T. Barnes made a great pickup of the shot to the "hot corner" at 3rd and Daniel Dietz turned it at 2nd., making a perfect throw to first and Hart was still holding the lead at 6-2.

However, that feeling that Hart was now "hanging on", was creeping in, as Hart was completely shut down for the last 3 innings and the Vikings were threatening.

J.T. Barnes opened the 6th. and was hit by pitch, and stole 2nd. After a strikeout, Daniel Dietz hit a routine grounder to short but nothing is routine when Dietz puts a ball in play. The throw to first was clean but the first baseman simply dropped the ball in his haste to make sure Barnes wouldn't round third.

With men on 1st & 3rd, Pat Valaika hit a flare over 3rd and it landed just fair and scored Barnes easily and the speedy Dietz scored all the way from first and Hart had the 2 runs they lost in the 5th & 6th back and again had their 6 run lead at 8-2.
