A lot of Hart players chose the most important game of the season to have their best games of the season.
Alex Tenorio pitched a 3 hitter, 7 strikeouts. The only run off him was unearned.
Hart had only 1 homer all season but today they hit 3 and none were cheap.
Dallas Bacon only 3 games removed from the JV squad slammed a 2 run shot in the 5 th. when the game was still close to make a 4-1 game into a 6-1 game.

Pat Valaika who has been pitched around all season finally got a pitch to his liking and hit an absolute ("No Doubt About It") Bomb to left and then in the 7 th Josh Brown who has been having problems making contact finally slammed a 2 run shot to left and put the capper on a 12-1 outburst.

CANYON COUNTRY - Needing a win in the season finale Friday to avoid missing the baseball playoffs for the first time since 1986, Hart High of Newhall responded, scoring four runs in the first inning in a 12-1 Foothill League victory at Golden Valley to seal a Southern Section Div. I playoff berth for the 25 th consecutive year.
"We take a lot of pride in the streak," said Patrick Valaika, who hit his first home run of the season and added a triple, three runs and two RBIs.

Combined with Saugus' 12-7 loss to West Ranch that slipped the Centurions into fourth place, Hart (13-13, 7-8)
finished third to secure the league's final automatic berth.
So fired up were the Indians that they hit three home runs after coming in with a total of just one in 25 games. Even Josh Brown, batting . 219 with 16 strikeouts in 32 at-bats, got into the act, hitting a pinch-hit home run in the seventh, as Hart scored eight runs over the final three innings.

Hart left-hander Alex Tenorio (2-4), who had not won a game since March 16, came through with his best pitching performance of the season, going seven innings for the first time while limited Golden Valley (11-14, 6-9) to three hits and striking out seven.

Tenorio (2-4), a junior, retired eight of the final nine batters, four on strikes.
"We knew we had to win to make the playoffs, and I trusted my defense," Tenorio said. "They helped me out, and I just went inning by inning and tried to make my pitches."

Obviously, the win was a big relief for coach Jim Ozella, who posted occasional inspirational memos this past week asking if this was the year Hart wanted to see the playoff streak end.
"We come from a program that has a lot of tradition and a lot of pride," Ozella said. "It's a big deal, and I think the kids know that. They take pride in continuing the Hart tradition. I reminded them, but if you play for Hart, you know about the tradition."

Hart put itself in this position with four consecutive losses heading into the Golden Valley series. The pressure to win was equally important Wednesday when Hart prevailed 5-3 in the series opener.
"The whole week has been like the playoffs because we knew if we lost a game, it was one and done," Ozella said.
Ozella suspects Hart will open on the road against a league champion, but he and his players are not complaining one bit.
"I definitely think we're good enough to beat anyone," Valaika said. "This is a really good team."
