HIGHLIGHTS of Game# 11-01: Hart 2 - Dos Pueblos 1 (Easton Tourney Game # 1)

Hart opens 2011 season with 2-1 victory over Dos Pueblos:

The first thing I noticed when I entered Murray Field at the Hart diamond was the fantastic look of the Hart 2011 Uniforms.

All the players were wearing the uniforms like they are supposed to be worn. Bloused just below the knee and looking like the Boston Red Sox (Or St Louis Cardinals), with the Black Red and White Sox stripes and even Stirrups which I haven't seen teams wearing in a while. (For all I know every team wears them but who can see them).

Compared to the Dos Pueblos team they were extra classy. The Dos Pueblos team was in the usual pajamas looking pants dragging on the ground looking like their back spike was caught in the pants.

I hope someone will send me a .JPG of the player's uniforms so I can include it in tomorrows Newsletter which will come after our game at Moorpark at 11AM Saturday 3/5/2011. Of course Hart is on the road so I'm expecting to be surprised now.

This was a terrific, fast and well played game at Hart.
The game lasted less than 2 hours, it was over around 4:50PM.

Tyler Glasnow 6'7" right hander started for Hart and gave up a Season Opening single to leadoff batter Steven Reveles. He was sacrificed to 2nd by Ben York, and stole 3rd. Joe Huthsing then hit a hard shot to 3rd baseman Dallas Bacon who made sure Reveles would stay at 3rd and fired a strike to 1st baseman Cole Gasper. But Reveles took off as Bacon threw and 1st baseman Gasper fired a strike to Hart catcher Steve Rosso who put a great tag on the runner Reveles. It was as pretty a play of this type, you will ever see in high school ball.

The double play ended the inning and Hart was coming to bat in their half of the 1st inning. Daniel Dietz opened the season as expected laying down a perfect bunt toward 3rd base and beat the throw easily. Dietz moved to 2nd on a fielder's choice grounder to the right side by Thomas Bilbo. Luke Persico then flared a blooper to right field down the line, Dietz scored and before the DP right fielder could get the ball back Persico was on 3rd with a triple. Dallas Bacon slammed a hard line drive double down the left field line, easily cruising into 2nd, with Persico scoring. Despite a walk to Kevin Bailey, an easy ground out and fly out ended the inning with 2 runners on base, but Hart had a 2-0 lead.

Glasnow struck out the side in the 2nd inning, giving up a single up the middle by John Corazza.

Meanwhile the DP pitcher Gabe Speier settled down and started snuffing out mini rallies through the next 3 innings, and getting lots of pop ups off the Hart bats. In fact he got 6 Pop ups in the 2nd thru 5th innings.

Glasnow ran into trouble in the 3rd. An inning opening error on a grounder to 2nd put Perferio Avila on first. After a strikeout Reveles hit a shot towards Glasnow that was very hard, hitting Glasnow in the back and when the dust settled, runners were on 1st and 2nd. A walk to Ben York loaded the bases with only 1 out. Glasnow got another strikeout and looked like he could get out of the inning but while pitching to Mike Spritosanto there was a Passed Ball allowing the runner Avila to score. Glasnow then struck out Spritosanto, so he struck out the side in consecutive innings but the run was in and Hart led only 2-1.

In the 4th, after a single and 2 strikeouts, Glasnow faced Avila again and what at first appeared to be an easy inning ending grounder to short wasn't... I turns out Hart catcher Steve Rosso tipped Avila's bat. In fact Rosso's glove went half way to the pitchers mound. A very high fly to right ended the inning as the New deadened bats are doing what they are supposed to do. (cut down on the home runs).

In the 5th, Alex Tenorio was brought in to play first base. Immediately he was tested on a terrific play. A slow grounder to 3rd was fielded by charging Dallas Bacon throwing across the body, but the throw was low and in the dirt. The sun was in Tenorio's eyes but he made a great scoop of the throw save the chance of the fast runner Reveles from getting all the way to 3rd.

In the bottom of the 5th, Dietz walked but was cut down stealing on a strike 'em out-throw 'em out double play. Persico beat out slow nubber toward 3rd and the 3rd baseman instead of eating the ball tried to throw it with all his might and threw it into the DP bull pen and Persico made it all the way to 3rd on the throwing error. Speier smartly gave a free pass to Bacon who had added a very hard 2 out single in the 3rd that followed his 1st inning RBI double.

Only 2 stolen bases in 5 attempts by Hart was with Bacon on first and Persico on 3rd Hart tried to induce a "pickle play" but DP wouldn't fall for it and Bacon was able to walk into 2nd base with a steal. But Speier got one of his 6 pop outs, this one to the catcher in foul territory. On another Jason Brown stole 2nd in the second, but then was immediately picked off 2nd and finally caught in a long rundown.

In the top of the 6th with Glasnow at the 90 pitch mark Hart brought Eric Vogel in to relieve and Eric struck out 2 and got a lazy fly to right.

In the bottom of the 6th, Baggio Saldivar was hit square in the helmet with a pitch. After a short Pop to right, Saldivar was cut down stealing on a strike out. The Dos Pueblos catcher Kyle Richardson was terrific behind the plate. He caught 3 men stealing, 2 of them on Strike Out, Caught stealing Double plays. He caught 3 of 4 base stealers and the only steal against him was a "give up" on a Pickle play, but it wasn't defensive indifference as the throw was made but cut off by the shortstop in a 2-1 game.

Eric Vogel took the mound in the top of the 7th and got an easy fly to right. Then a slow grounder to shortstop Persico making a difficult throw that was in the dirt, but another great scoop by Tenorio saved the day. The game ended on a routine grounder to short and Hart made the 2 runs in the first stand up for a 2-1 win.

Tyler Glasnow struck out 9 in his 5 innings, gave up 1 unearned run, 4 hits walked 2. Eric Vogel got all 6 of his men, striking out 2. Dallas Bacon was 2 for 2 with a Double, 1 RBI and was also Intentionally walked. Luke Persico was 2 for 3 with a triple and an RBI:

Hart High pitcher Tyler Glasnow's bender opened up the 2011 prep baseball season.

It also closed down Dos Pueblos of Goleta.

The senior right-handed pitcher baffled the Chargers for five innings in a 2-1 season-opening victory for the Indians at Bud Murray Field on Friday.

"Part of the deal is making adjustments. He has good stuff. He just needs to learn how to harness it," said Hart head coach Jim Ozella. "He's getting there. He's got a lot of talent."

Glasnow went five innings, allowing just three hits and a walk. He struck out nine batters, including the side in the second and third innings. The first five strikeouts were called third strikes.

"That pitcher, I give all the credit in the world. He was consistent," said Dos Pueblos head coach Nate Mendoza. "Our guys acted like they hadn't seen a curve ball before."

Glasnow said he felt some early jitters, allowing a single to open up the game to Steven Reveles. Reveles found his way to third base after a sacrifice bunt and a stolen base.

The Chargers (0-1) continued the aggressiveness on the basepaths as first baseman Joe Huthsing grounded to third with one out.

Hart third baseman Dallas Bacon looked Reveles back to the bag, then threw to first for the second out. As soon as Bacon released the ball, Reveles raced home.

Hart first baseman Cole Gasper threw to catcher Steve Rosso at the plate, who caught Reveles with a sweep tag, ending the threat.

The Indians (1-0) then scored all they needed in the bottom of the first.

Hart's Daniel Dietz led off with a bunt single. He later came around on a bloop triple by sophomore Luke Persico.

Bacon, who was 2-for-2 and reached base in all three plate appearances, followed with an RBI-double to give the Indians a 2-0 lead.

With the 6-foot-7-inch Glasnow on the hill, Hart was on its way.

Though the Chargers had a baserunner in every inning against the pitcher, they only managed a run in the third inning Dos Pueblos' Porti Avila reached safely to open the inning on an error by Dietz at second base. He later came in to score on a passed ball.

But Glasnow wiggled his way out of the inning with runners on second and third with consecutive strikeouts.

"I felt really confident from the start," Glasnow said. "(After the first batter), I started getting into it. I thought about it being just me and the catcher. I felt in a rhythm beginning to end."

Hart senior pitcher Erik Vogel retired all six batters he faced to close out the game.

The Indians managed only six hits against the Dos Pueblos combination of Gabe Speier and Huthsing.

But a win's a win.

This Hart team isn't big on power at the plate.

The combo of Glasnow and Garrett Gooding, who at times was the best relief pitcher in the Foothill League last year, are expected to carry the pitching load.

Games like this might be the games Hart wins this season.

Going in, the Indians aren't favorites to win the Foothill this season, not with the likes of Valencia's bats and West Ranch's arms.

But Ozella gives some hope.

"We're capable of playing with anyone in league," Ozella said. "We're capable of pitching. We're capable of playing defense. We're capable of swinging the bat. ... Talentwise, we have to play our game. We have to hit line drives and get on base. If we do that, things will be good."
