### HIGHLIGHTS of Game# 11-02: Hart 12 - Moorpark 2 (Easton Tourney Game # 2)

Hart beats Moorpark 12-2: Gooding flirts with No Hitter, Tenorio homers.

It was tough parking at Moorpark today. A track meet at the football stadium drew huge crowds, fortunately we could park in the nearby neighborhood, but it was a long walk from/to our cars.

The Moorpark Musketeers were ranked very high by the Times and Daily News and Hart in the same Easton Pool with them didn't look good for Hart.

Hart jumped on the MP starting pitcher Jordan Guererro for a run in the 1st.

Daniel Dietz bunted for a single to open the game. Dancing around at first he forced the pitcher Guerrero to commit a balk. Thomas Bilbo sacrificed Dietz to 3rd. and with Dallas Bacon up Dietz scored on a wild pitch.

Senior Garrett Gooding started for Hart and walked the leadoff batter Blake Barnes on 4 pitches.

The # 2 batter Spencer Dubois hit into a fielders choice 2nd to short on a very close play at 2nd.

The # 3 batter Jake Wooley hit a ball in the 5-6 hole. Hart shortstop Luck Persico got to it and made an off balance throw to 2nd and had just enough on the throw to get another very close play at 2nd.

Gooding got out of the 1st inning inducing the best MP hitter a fine lad named Sean Houlihan to fly deep to right.

Thereafter Gooding complete throttled down the Musketeers. He got the side out 3 up 3 down from the 2nd thru the 5th. He got 2 strike outs in the 3rd and 4th.

Meantime Hart came to bat in the 2nd and leadoff batter Alex Tenorio hit an absolute BOMB to straight away Left. There was NO DOUBT ABOUT IT.

The Hart players were really jubilant and I don't blame them.

With the bats being "deadened" further this year I was wondering if Hart would hit any homers this year since we only had 1 homer going into the last game of the season last year when we then hit 2 more.

In the 3rd, Hart tacked another run on the board. Luke Persico lined an easy single to left but the left fielder couldn't pick it up and the ball went under his glove all the way to the wall and Persico made it all the way to 3rd. Dallas Bacon who walked in the 1st and was stranded, slammed a hard single to right scoring Persico.

In the 4th, MP decided Guerrero had enough despite having 6 strikeouts in the first 3 innings, they were down 3-0 and he was going to be facing batters for the 3rd time, so was relieved by Kevin West who got the first 2 men easily.

But Hart was at it again. With 2 out Josh Brown walked and stole 2nd & 3rd. Dietz walked. Then with Thomas Bilbo at bat in a 3-0 game, Dietz was supposed to get picked off and get in a pickle play. Instead of running half way he ran hard to within 10 feet of second and then suddenly stopped. It so startled the shortstop Blake Barnes that he took his eye off the ball coming to him, it hit him square on the knee & bounded away. Brown scored and Dietz was safe on 2nd. Bilbo then rifled a hard single to left, Dietz scored and the Hart picket fence of single runs in the 1st 3 innings was broken by a crooked number as Hart now had 2 runs in and a 5-0 lead.

The 5th was one of the bigger innings for Hart in recent years.

Dallas Bacon remained perfect on the 2011 season getting hit by pitch.

Kevin Bailey sacrificed Bacon to 2nd.

Alex Tenorio slammed a hard single to left scoring Bacon, Tenorio took 2nd on the left fielder's bobble.

Baggio Saldivar singled to left scoring Tenorio.

Steven Rosso singled to left Saldivar took 2nd.

Adam Parr making his varsity debut ran for Rosso

Connor O'Brien made his varsity debut batting for Josh Brown and singled to right loading the bases.

Brown re-entered at 1st base.

Daniel Dietz blooped a single to left scoring Saldivar & Parr, Brow took 2nd.

Thomas Bilbo lined hard to center the CF making a good catch.

Luke Persico doubled to left scoring Brown and Dietz.

They finally relieved Kevin West for Blake Chiaramonte:

Kevin Bacon kept his 1,000 batting average on the season alive by doubling to center scoring Persico.

Kevin Bailey singled to center but they stopped Bacon at 3rd.

The inning finally ended on a deep drive to center by Alex Tenorio.

Hart had scored 7 runs on 8 hits and now led 12-0.

But it still wasn't a laugher because going into the bottom of the 6th, Garrett Gooding had a no hitter going. He immediately walked the # 8 hitter Jeremy Sworzyn, but popped up the # 9 hitter Gunnar Mazur. Blake Barnes and Spencer Dubois worked walks against the tiring Gooding and the bases were loaded on Walks. Gooding reached back and got the # 3 hitter on a strike out, but now he had to face a top class clean up hitter Sean Houlihan who slammed Gooding's first pitch down the left field line for a 2 run double. Gooding got his final batter on an easy grounder to 2nd.

Bobby Stafford made his Hart varsity debut in the bottom of the 7th and got a fly to right but gave up a single to center by pinch hitter Mike Ketring. He then got Sworzyn to hit into a 5-4-3 around the horn double play and Hart had the win in the books.

Dallas Bacon finally made an out when he flew out to right in the 7th. He's hitting .800 (4 for 5), 2 walks and a HBP.
