Hart Beats Thousand Oaks 5-3: Persico 3 for 3 HR, 2B, 3-RBI. Hart makes 5 errors in 1st 3 Innings:

Chatsworth beat Oaks Christian and will play at Hart vs Chatsworth on Thursday.
The other 2 Semi Finalists in the Championship bracket are Valencia at Chaminade.
I'm giving almost a full play by play because at the time of this writing at 9:45pm, I didn't put up the Box score yet.

Well this was a nice surprise.
Last year in this tournament Hart beat Thousand Oaks for the first time since 1981, Could they do it again?
They started out with a 1-0 lead in the first inning when Luke Persico belted a 2 out solo homer to left to put Hart in front 1-0.

In the bottom of the first it didn't look like Hart wanted this game the way their infielders were handling ground balls, They made 3 errors and yet didn't give up a run.

Erik Vogel started for Hart facing the very fast leadoff runner Avondre Bollar (who reportedly has stolen a lot of bases already in the first 2 games), reached on an error but Hart catcher Steve Rosso threw him out stealing. After a fly out and then a single by Daniel Delaney another error had runners on 1st \& 2nd. On the 3rd error of the inning, Delaney thought he could score all the way from 2 nd and rounded 3 rd too far, Hart shortstop Luke Persico threw behind him to Dallas Bacon at 3rd and Delaney was cut down.
Hart was out of the inning giving up a single and making 3 errors but T.O didn't score.
In the Hart 2nd, Alex Tenorio singled, stole 2nd, but was caught stealing 3rd.
In the T.O. 2nd inning the leadoff batter was again on due to an error. This time a single, sacrifice, fielder's choice and a 2 out single accounted for 2 unearned runs as the defense was letting Vogel down, as T.0. led $2-1$.

After Hart went down 1, 2, 3 in the 3 rd, T.0 was again given a gift as the leadoff batter reached on a 5 th error!! After a single, Fielders choice and a walk, T.O. had the bases loaded with only 1 out, but Vogel got a strikeout and a fly to right and was out of the inning, with the score still showing T.0. leading $2-1$.

Interesting *NOTE* that the score board showed 0 (Zero) errors, and recorded all 5 errors as hits.

In the Hart 4th, Tommy Bilbo walked. T.O. starting pitcher Ray Lambert tried to pick him off but the throw went down to the T.O. Bull Pen and Bilbo made it all the way to 3rd.
"That Man" Luke Persico then slammed a long drive to right center that looked like it could go over the wall but it hit the wall $1 / 2$ way up, Persico cruised into $2 n d$, as Bilbo trotted home with the tying run.
Persico took 3rd on a wild pitch, then scored the lead run on a passed ball. Hart now led 3-2.
In the bottom of the 4 th, Vogel looked like he was in command as the fielders were starting to play catch better and he got a 3 up 3 down inning with his 2nd strikeout.

In the Hart 5th, T.O. brought in a new pitcher named Lucas Steagall. The Hart players said we were not done. Steve Rosso led off with a walk. Adam Parr ran for Rosso.
Josh Brown fouled off a sacrifice attempt and then took another strike. Then Brown completely fooled the T. O. defense as he "pushed a 2 strike bunt" towards the 2nd baseman playing deep and beat it out without a play. The runners were moved to 2 nd \& 3rd on a nice sacrifice bunt by Daniel Dietz who almost beat that bunt out
Tommy Bilbo then hit a sacrifice fly to right, scoring pinch runner Adam Parr.
Up came "That Man" Persico who lined a sharp single to left scoring Brown, Persico took 2 nd on the throw to the plate.
The score board now showed Hart Leading 5-2 and it was now noted that they took the hits and errors off the scoreboard. Some one must have told them they had the hits/errors wrong, but the runs were correct and that's what counted.

In the bottom of the 5th, Vogel got a fly out to center almost lost in the sun by Josh Brown, grounder to 2 nd and a short fly to center handled by 2nd baseman Daniel Dietz. Vogel got a standing ovation from the Hart crowd as his day was done.

In the Hart 6th, Alex Tenorio bounced a single over the first 1st baseman's head into right, but was erased on a double play.

Cole Gasper came in to play 1st, as Alex Tenorio then took over the pitching duties in the 6th. Tenorio up a leadoff single to left by Peter McAfee. After a failed double play, ruled safe at 2nd and out at 1st, a ground out moved McAfee to 3rd, where he scored on a ground single in the 5-6 hole by Brison Croenbold. Tenorio ended the inning with a Pop Up by the speedy Avondre Bollar. Hart led 5-3.

Hart went 3 up 3 down in the top of the 7 th. Now it was up to Tenorio to close it out in the bottom of the 7 . He started by striking out \# 2 batter Trevor 0 'Shea. However \# 3 batter Daniel Delaney blooped a single to right and clean up hitter Zac Portnoy was the tying run at the plate. All he could do was move up Delany to 2 nd as he grounded to Persico at short.
Tenorio then ended it getting \# 5 batter Jeff Pemberton to pop to Cole Gasper.
Hart is now 3-0 on the season.
Luke Persico is now hitting . 727 (8 for 11), with 2 doubles, 1 triple and a homer.
