Hart played a Chaminade team that has had good pitching but their vaunted hitting attack has yet to surface. They were 3-1 entering the game after beating Rio Mesa 2-1, Agoura 3-2, & Westlake 1-0, and then losing 2-0 to Valencia they had not scored more than 3 runs in a game on the season. After today, they still haven't scored more than 3 as Hart beat them 4-2.

Chaminade only had 1 regular player Mathew Troupe hitting over .300 coming into the game at .385 and he hit well today going 3-4.

In the bottom of the first Dalton Brown pitching for Chaminade, with 1 out Tommy Bilbo put down a perfect bunt, beating it easily and went to 2nd on an errant throw.

Luke Persico singled to deep short sending Bilbo to 3rd, then Persico stole 2nd with only 1 out.

Dallas Bacon hit a hot shot to 3rd, and was thrown out, runners had to hold, and it looked like Hart was going to get nothing out of a good situation.

However Alex Tenorio on a 3-2 pitch "tommy hawked" a face high pitch to left driving in Bilbo & Persico. Hart Led 2-0.

In the 3rd, with 1 out, Persico singled, stole 2nd and took 3rd when the right fielder dropped a fly ball of the bat of Dallas Bacon.

A strike out and pop up got Dalton Brown out of that trouble.

Chaminade head coach Frank Mutz decided to bring in a new pitcher, Chad Gubicza, son of Ex-Major League pitcher Mark Gubicza.

He was immediately greeted by a single to deep short by Baggio Saldivar. Kevin Bailey sacrificed Baggio to 2nd. Josh Brown sacrificed to the pitcher who threw it away down into the Chaminade bull pen and Baggio Saldivar scored, Brown taking 2nd.

Daniel Dietz then also sacrificed brown to 3rd. The 3rd sacrifice bunt of the inning.

Then what looked like and easy fly out off the bat of Tommy Bilbo, the left fielder, just dropped the ball and Josh Brown easily scored the 2nd run of the inning making it Hart 4, Chaminade 0.

Hart threatened in the 6th, with 2 out, Josh Brown batting, the 1st baseman dropped an easy throw on a grounder to 3rd. Brown then stole 2nd.

Daniel Dietz then hit a high chopper to 3rd and they had no play as Dietz beat it out easily, Brown taking 3rd. But the inning ended on a bunt attempt.

Meanwhile Garrett Gooding was having a 2nd straight great game.

He struck out 2 batters to end the 1st inning. 2 batters to start the 2nd, Struck out the side giving up 2 hits in the 3rd, and ended the 4th with a strike out. He struck out 2 in the 6th, and left the game with 10 strike outs after 6 innings, NO walks.

He did give up 8 hits, all singles and none were of the cheap variety.

Bobby Stafford came in to pitch the top of the 7th in a non save situation with a 4-0 lead.

He walked the first batter Cole Rutherford, never a good sign because now if he doesn't get a double play he would have to face the dangerous Mathew Troupe.

Stafford struck out pinch hitter Nick Goshgarian in the 9 spot, but gave up a line drive single to leadoff batter Tanner Reibenspies.

Now he faced Mathew Troupe who was 3 for 3 and all very hard hit singles. Everyone breathed easier when Troupe hit a lazy fly to right.

Then a good hitter Michael Dingilian got his first hit of the season, a 2 run double.

Hart coach Kyle Boggio went out to talk to Stafford as the Chaminade shortstop & clean-up hitter Dylan Delaney dug in. Delaney hit the first pitch foul and I believe it went over the left field wall, but very foul.

A few pitches later Delaney swung and missed at a high hard one and Hart had a nice 4-2 victory.

There were some unusual stats in this game:

There were no infield put outs via grounders in this game.

Hart first baseman Alex Tenorio had only 1 put out, that was on the first batter of the game who popped up to first. There was only 1 assist in the game for Hart. That was by catcher Steve Rosso who threw out base runner Matt Willmore trying to steal 2nd, to end the 2nd inning.

Hart had 3 Sacrifice bunts in the 4th inning. All moved up runners and Jason Brown was able to make it all the way to 2nd when the pitcher threw his sacrifice bunt away.

The game became a scorekeeper's nightmare when Chaminade Coach Mutz tried to get in his entire roster of 22 players he brought to the game either as pinch hitters or pinch runners.

Hart next plays its annual Split Venue Double Header vs West Torrance.
