Hart beats Golden Valley 6-0, Gooding 1 pitches hitter.

Garrett Gooding (Hart-2011) pitched his best game of the year. He no hit Moorpark for 5.2 innings 2 weeks ago and MP is ranked # 4 in the CIF-SS in Division 1. He threw the 62nd shutout since 1988. He struck out 12, walked 3.

He gave up 1 controversial hit. At the time it didn't seem to matter. However, I quickly asked for help in the booth and 2 major league scouts who were there specifically to see Gooding with their radar guns, called it a hit and so did everyone in the scoring and announcer booth area.

The hit in question came in only the 2nd inning. With 1 out Anthony San Miguel hit a slow roller towards short. Hart shortstop Luke Persico was playing at a normal position at short stop and wouldn't have a chance, but Hart 3rd baseman Dallas Bacon playing level with the 3rd base bag flashed across and tried to make a basic "do or die" pick up and it "clanked" off his glove and San Miguel was safe at first. After a strikeout, San Miguel was caught stealing to end the 2nd.

As the game progressed into the 6th and Gooding had retired the next 9 batters, I went out and talked to Garrett's dad Gordon, who video tapes every game and naturally was video taping this one. I told him that the ball by San Miguel back in the 2nd was ruled a hit and he agreed, and I felt better.

Gooding walked the leadoff batter in the 6th but got a foul pop to 1st and 2 strikeouts.

In the top of the 7th, he walked the leadoff batter Billy Fredrick. After a strike out, Josh Smith hit a hard smash towards 3rd that Dallas Bacon caught just before it hit the ground. In his attempt to get the double play on Fredrick at 1st, Bacon threw the ball over first baseman Tenorio's head and Fredrick not only was safe at 1st but was able to scamper to 2nd on the error.

Gooding then reared back and struck out San Miguel for his 12th strikeout to end the game.

Golden Valley ace pitcher Scott Barlow started.

The Hart offense was getting men on base in every inning but they kept stymieing their efforts by getting caught stealing at inopportune moments or this would have been a real blowout.

In the 1st after Daniel Dietz lined out, Tommy Bilbo walked and stole 2nd. Luke Persico singled scoring Bilbo, Persico took 2nd when the left fielder kicked around the ball.

Persico was then caught stealing 3rd.

Dallas Bacon hit a long double and scored on a 2 out bloop single by Alex Tenorio. The inning ended when Tenorio was caught stealing.

In the 3rd. Dietz singled and was sacrificed to 2nd by Bilbo who was safe when the 2nd baseman dropped the throw to 1st base. Luke Persico sacrificed the runners to 2nd & 3rd.

Bacon walked on a ball in the dirt, Dietz was hung up between 3rd & home. Dietz thrives on these types of plays, about 4 different fielders where throwing the ball back & forth, chasing him here and there, and sure enough the ball was dropped at the plate by the pitcher and Dietz scored so Hart led 3-0.

In the 4th, Steve Rosso walked and Renton Pexa ran for him. Pexa was sacrificed to 3rd. With Dietz up, a passed ball moved Pexa to 3rd. Dietz walked and with Bilbo batting Barlow unleashed a wild pitch scoring Pexa.

In the 5th, Dallas Bacon singled hard to left but was caught stealing. Alex Tenorio walked and that was it for Barlow, who was replaced by Joey Anderson. A wild pitch moved Tenorio to 2nd. O'Brien walked and a passed ball moved the runners to 2nd & 3rd.

Baggio Saldivar then hit a sacrifice fly to right scoring Tenorio, sending O'Brien to 3rd.

Steve Rosso singled to left scoring O'Brien. Josh Brown singled to left but there was no further scoring.

Hart led by its final score of 6-0

Further information regarding the controversial hit by San Miguel in the 2nd.

After the game I asked the plate umpire Nick Buncik and he immediately told me that ball in the 2nd inning was a hit.

I also got confirmation from Hart coach Bob Keown and Hart Head coach Jim Ozella.

Gooding's dad Gordon also agreed earlier.

The players of course wanted an error called but that was a do or die play.

The Signal reporter at the game Paul Putignano had a good look at the play from the stands and he also called the play a hit.

Afterwards I met the 3 Golden Valley coaches in the parking lot and they said San Miguel would have beat the throw even if Bacon had fielded the ball cleanly.

In the moment, Golden Valley third baseman Anthony San Miguel's slow roller toward the shortstop seemed innocuous enough.

San Miguel's ground ball was the only hit Indians starting pitcher Garrett Gooding allowed in a 12-strikeout 6-0 shutout of the Grizzlies on Friday at Hart High School in both teams' Foothill League opener.

"My off-speed (pitches) were coming in, and my fastball was hitting the corners," Gooding said. "And I had a good defense behind me."

The ball bounced through the infield, and even though Hart third baseman Dallas Bacon wasn't able to field the ball cleanly, San Miguel was in position to beat out the throw.

Gooding cruised the rest of the way, retiring the next 10 batters in a row and yielding only three walks.

The senior left-hander also took a no-hitter in the sixth inning against Moorpark on March 5 before allowing a two-out double. Hart went on to win 12-2.

"He's really been pitching well for us," said Indians head coach Jim Ozella said of Gooding. "He's been locked in and been ahead in the count."

And on Friday, he got some early run support.

Hart (7-1, 1-0) jumped on Golden Valley starter Scott Barlow for two runs in the bottom of the first.

Indians shortstop Luke Persico opened the scoring with an RBI double to center field that scored Thomas Bilbo, who reached on a walk and stole second.

First baseman Alex Tenorio added the second run with an RBI single that plated Bacon, who doubled in the previous atbat.

The Indians finished with eight hits in the game and drew eight total walks.

"We were pretty patient with Barlow and made him get in deep as much as we could," Ozella said. "Stretch out the at-

Hart tacked on one run in the third when Daniel Dietz was caught in a rundown, but as he was sprinting home, Barlow dropped the throw at the plate as Dietz slid by.

Then in the fourth, Indians catcher Steve Rosso's pinch runner Renton Pexa scored on a wild pitch and pushed the lead to 4-0.

"You have to execute," said Grizzlies head coach Scott Drootin. "We were prepared, but you've got to bring your 'A' game to the field. ... They put a little pressure on us, and we couldn't handle it."

Hart added its final two runs in the fifth when Baggio Saldivar's sacrifice fly scored Tenorio from third, and Rosso's RBI single drove home Connor O'Brien.

The second run was charged to Golden Valley pitcher Joey Anderson, who relieved Barlow with one out. Barlow finished with three strikeouts, giving up four hits, six walks and five runs - three earned - over 5 1/3 innings. Anderson walked one batter and allowed three hits in 1 2/3 innings of work.

Billy Fredrick walked twice for the Grizzlies (4-2, 0-1), and catcher Rocky Sherwood caught three runners stealing. But the day belonged to Gooding, who recorded at least one strikeout in every inning.
