HIGHLIGHTS of Game# 11-11: Hart 8, Valencia 9 (Foothill League Game # 4)

Hart takes lead in top 7th, gets tied and loses in 9th to Zeile & Valencia 9-8

This was one of those games where it looked like Hart was virtually out of it after 3 innings, down 5-0 and Valencia pitcher Nick Rivas putting Hart down easily. But they fought back to take an 8-7 lead in the top of the 7th, only to have a passed ball on a strikeout, letting the tying run on base where he eventually scored on 2 out single by James Bonds, then 2 innings later Shane Zeile slammed a 2 out solo "walk off homer" in the bottom of the 9th.

All 3 Newspapers, LA Times, LA Daily News and The-Signal were there. Eric Sondheimer of the times has a mention of the game on the Varsity Times Insider Blog

Mike Zeile and Jim Bonds were standout baseball players for Newhall Hart in the 1980s, and their sons, Shane and James, came through for Valencia on Wednesday in a 9-8, nine-inning Foothill League victory over Hart. Shane Zeile hit a 2-and-0 pitch over the right-field fence in the bottom of the ninth for a walk-off home run. Bonds had an RBI single in the bottom of the seventh to send the game into extra innings. Valencia (7-2, 3-0) opened a 5-0 lead over Hart (9-2, 3-1), but the Indians scored three runs in the top of the seventh to take an 8-7 lead. The two schools combined to use eight pitchers. David Hausman threw two shutout innings of relief to pick up the victory. Dallas Bacon had three hits for Hart. Parker Greenberg had three bunt singles for Valencia. Zeile, a UCLA signee, also had two doubles.

Golden Valley defeated West Ranch, 5-4. Ryan Alvarez had two hits and two RBIs. Canyon beat Saugus 4-3

In the Sunset League, top-ranked Huntington Beach Edison (10-1, 4-0) got two hits from Eric Snyder in a 3-2 win over Los Alamitos. Dalton Douty and Jon Torres pitched for the Chargers.

VALENCIA - Shane Zeile says he loves the pressure, and he proved so on Wednesday.

The Valencia High baseball standout hit a home run with two out in the bottom of the ninth inning in a 9-8 win over neighborhood rival Hart in a Foothill League thriller that had lots of twists and turns.

"I do love being in that situation because I like to be the hero, but I can't say I wasn't nervous because I was," said Zeile, the nephew of former Major Leaguer Todd Zeile.

With dusk settling in, the first two Valencia hitters struck out to begin the ninth, setting the stage for Zeile, who drilled a 2-0 pitch from Erik Vogel (2-1) that cleared the wall in right center and set off a huge purple and gold celebration.

Zeile was 3 for 5 with two doubles, three RBIs and two runs, raising his average to .406 with two home runs in 32 at-bats. He hit four home runs as a junior.

"I wanted to do something big for the team, not for me," Zeile said. "I got a good swing on it. I'm ecstatic. This is a great confidence booster. It was a good team effort today."

Valencia's David Hausman (1-0), who had pitched just one-third of an inning because of arm problems, pitched the final two innings without giving up a hit.

Valencia has not won a playoff game in two years, but the Vikings have returned most of its key starters from last season, and they're 7-1, 3-0, the only loss an 8-5 defeat March 12 to high-powered Chatsworth, which overcame a five-run over the final two innings against the Vikings in the Easton tournament championship.

Valencia again blew a five-run lead Wednesday -- but this time the Vikings did not blow the game.

"It was very eerily similar to Chatsworth. The kids got a little complacent once we got the lead," Valencia coach Jared Snyder said. "They did a great job of never quitting. The unity of this team is pretty special. They believe in each other."

Hart took an 8-7 lead in the top of the seventh when Daniel Dietz singled in Baggio Saldivar. The visiting Indians (9-3, 3-1) looked to be in good shape when ace Tyler Glasnow came on to close. Valencia was down to its final out in the seventh when James Bonds drilled an opposite-field single that scored Quincy Quintero to force extra innings.

"It came down to the end, and we didn't want to lose," Bonds said. "We kept it going. We never gave up."

Hart's Connor O'Brien was 3 for 5 with three runs and an RBI, Saldivar was 2 for 4 with two RBIs, and Dallas Bacon added two hits and long fly to the

The Valencia baseball team has made headlines this season with its offense. Hart's done it with pitching.

In the ninth inning on Wednesday, those strengths were pitted directly against each other.  
This time, the hitting won out.

Valencia shortstop Shane Zeile blasted a solo home run in the bottom of the ninth inning and the Vikings beat Hart 9-8 in a matchup of two Foothill League title contenders at Valencia High School.

The home run was the first and only hit given up by Hart reliever Erik Vogel, who was impressive in his own right. Vogel retired the side in the eighth inning and struck out Valencia's third and fourth hitters, Trey Williams and Quincy Quintero, to start the ninth.

Getting through the heart of the Vikings' order, however, proved too much.

"In that at-bat, I was looking for the first fastball I saw," said Zeile, who called it the biggest at-bat of his life. "I wasn't trying to give him anything."

Valencia (7-1, 3-0) got in trouble by giving too much earlier in the game - and Hart took advantage.

The Vikings built a 5-0 lead against Hart left-hander Garrett Gooding thanks to their patient yet powerful offense, but the Indians (9-2, 3-1) answered in the top of the fourth.

Hart's Luke Persico singled and later took third on a dropped flyball that also allowed Dallas Bacon to reach second base. Alex Tenorio singled home Persico, and Connor O'Brien hit into a fielder's choice that plated Bacon.

Valencia, however, failed to get the out on the fielder's choice. After a wild pitch moved Tenorio to third and pinch runner Renton Pexa to second, Tenorio scored on another fielder's choice and Pexa scored on a squeeze bunt by Steve Rosso.

When the dust settled, Valencia's lead had been cut to 5-4.

"I've got to commend our guys," said Hart head coach Jim Ozella. "We were down 5-0 and we battled back. We had great at-bats."

By the same token, Valencia head coach Jared Snyder was disappointed in his defense.  
"We didn't execute defensively what we practiced," Snyder said. "We gave them a lot and they earned a lot with the way they pressured us."

Valencia scored again in the bottom of the fifth, and the two teams traded runs in the sixth, giving the Vikings a 7-5 lead heading into the seventh inning.

That's when Hart staged its biggest rally.  
Tenorio scored on an RBI single by Baggio Saldivar and pinch runner Josh Brown scored the tying run on a wild pitch. Hart went ahead 8-7 when leadoff hitter Daniel Dietz smacked a high bouncer that scored Saldivar.

Valencia responded in the bottom of the seventh, with Quintero scoring the tying run on an RBI single to left field by James Bonds.

Zeile praised Bonds' clutch hit.

"I wouldn't have done what I did if he didn't do what he did," Zeile said.

He also couldn't have done it without Valencia reliever David Hausman, who earned the win after allowing no runs and no hits through the eighth and ninth innings.

Hausman hadn't pitched since March 8 against Quartz Hill due to injury.

"I went to him yesterday and asked him, 'Are you healthy?'" Snyder said. "And he said, 'Yes I am.'"

Nick Rivas pitched the first five innings for Valencia and struck out eight batters.

Zeile went 3-for-4 with three RBIs, two doubles and two runs to pace Valencia's offense, while Quintero scored three times.

Bacon, O'Brien and Saldivar each collected multiple hits for Hart.  
A total of 31 players participated in Wednesday's game between the two squads, who meet again on April 13 at Hart High.

"We're not hanging our heads," Ozella said. "We came here to battle and we battled."

They didn't mention the Key play that I think blew to game for Hart.
In the bottom of the 7th, after Hart had scored 3 runs to take a remarkable lead, Tyler Glasnow got the dangerous Trey Williams to ground to short. Glasnow then struck out Quincy Quintero, but the ball got away from catcher Steve Rosso and Quintero was safe at first as the tying run.
Glasnow then walked Shane Zeile who was 2 for 3 at that point drew a walk moving Quintero to 2nd.
Glasnow then struck out Brian Mundell which would have ended the game.
James Bonds then fouled off several pitches and then hit a grounder into the 5-6 hole which just eluded a diving Luke Persico and Quintero scored the tying run from 2nd. A easy 4-3 groundout ended the inning and we played for another 1 and 2/3 innings before the game ended on the dramatic homer by Shane Zeile.

There was a steady breeze blowing in from left field and it affected Hart on 1 particular at bat.
In the 4th inning, Dallas Bacon hit what looked like a no doubt about it homer to left but then the wind got it and the left fielder was there to make the catch, but then he dropped the ball as he seemed to bump into the wall and Bacon cruised into 2nd. I later checked with the Hart coaches who said that was a double due to crashing into the wall. Just to be sure I checked with the Newspaper guys 2 of 3 said it was an error. As said I later gave him a double.
Mainly Bacon later scored as Hart picked up 4 runs in that 4th inning and pulled up close to Valencia at 5-4.

The Dads of both stars for Valencia (Jim Bonds (Hart-1987) and Mike Zeile (Hart-1981)), were standout Baseball Players at Hart.

This could have been a real upset Wednesday in the Foothill League as if Hart would have pulled off the victory, as Golden Valley defeated West Ranch, 5-4. Canyon beat Saugus 4-3.

This is the 49th extra inning game played by Hart since 1987
