Hart beat Valencia 1-0: Glasnow strikes out 12, Gooding gets Win, Dietz gets big RBI:

Prior to the start of the game, Jim Bonds (Hart-1987), accepted his Hart wall of fame plaque. Jim Bonds was the star quarterback of the Hart Football team and was the star hitter and pitcher of the Hart 1987 team which made it to the playoffs after missing in 1986.

Hart finally got a victory against Valencia. Valencia is Ranked # 2 in the CIF-SS Division 1 Coaches Poll this week (Hart is 6th, dropping 1 place from the prior week: http://www.hartbaseballstats.com/STAND111.pdf

With the Win, Hart regains the lead in the Foothill League with a 5-1 record. Valencia is 4-1. Valencia still had to make up a rain out game vs West Ranch which will be played at West Ranch next week on Tuesday 4/19/2011. Hart lost 2 to the Vikings last year and in the opening game of 2011 at Valencia they were down 5-0 but rallied and finally took the lead in the top of the 7th 8-7. But with 1 out a player reached on a 3rd strike that got past the catcher and the tying run reached base. After a walk and a strike out the tying run scored on a single and then in the 9th, Shane Zeile hit a walkoff homer to give Valencia a 9-8 victory.

Today, the whole game basically took place in the 7th inning:

Tyler Glasnow started but did NOT get the win. he struck out 12 gave up only 1 hit, no runs. He got into the 7th and struck out his 12th batter and got an easy grounder to 1st. But with 2 out in a 0-0 tie in top of 7th he walked pinch hitter Jason Spigner That was his 124th pitch so Hart coach Jim Ozella went out to get him. Erik Vogel came in an gave up a single to Alex Bishop. 2 on, 2 out. Hart brought Garrett Gooding to pitch and he got a lazy fly to left.

Hart in the bottom of 7th: Baggio Saldivar Walked. Tommy Bilbo ran for Saldivar. Kevin Bailey Sacrificed Bilbo to 2nd. Connor O'Brien pinch hit for Steve Rosso and grounded to short almost hitting the runner Bilbo and the only play the SS had was to get the out at 1st with Bilbo taking 3rd. Cole Gasper was up and they tried to make him bite on a couple of bad pitches then decided top intentionally walk him and face Daniel Dietz who at that point was 0 for 3 with 2 strikeouts.

Dietz then hit a hard ground single over 3rd that was just fair after it passed the bag scoring Bilbo for the winning Run. All the Hart players were out of the dugout and surrounding Dietz between 1st and 2nd base.

Hart lost a golden opportunity to score in the 3rd. Kevin Bailey hit a nubber toward the pitcher Nick Rivas who threw it into the Viking bull pen and made it to 2nd base. A 3rd strike bunt went foul thus Bailey was not able to advance. Cole Gasper singled to left but Bailey was held at 3rd with only 1 out. A strike out and a pop up ended the inning and until the bottom of the 7th, Hart only had one other small chance in the 4th, with 2 outs Alex Tenorio singled and Baggio Saldivar was hit by pitch to have 2 men on but Rivas got an easy ground out to 3rd.

Nick Rivas went all the way for Valencia and absorbed his 1st loss of the season against 4 wins. The 2 Valencia Hits were by catcher Alex Bishop.

Garrett Gooding who got the last out in the top of the 7th, gets the Win, he is now 4-1 on the season.

As you can see Hart had shutouts against West Torrance, Golden Valley, Canyon, West Ranch, Anaheim\Canyon and now Valencia: The 3 Complete Game Shutouts were pitched by Tyler Glasnow against West Torrance, Garrett Gooding against Golden Valley and Eric Vogel against West Ranch. There were several scouts out to see Tyler Glasnow and they were pretty impressed. Eric Sondheimer of the LA Times is in Bali sunning himself at them moment, but I sent him a quick mention of the game, and see he already posted it up on his Blog from Bali:

Baseball: Hart beats Valencia, 1-0 by Eric Sondheimer Tyler Glasnow didn't get the victory on Wednesday, but the Newhall Hart senior sure pitched well in a 1-0 victory over Valencia. He struck out 12 against a terrific Valencia lineup and was pulled in the seventh and ended up with a no decision.

Hart won it in the bottom of the seventh on an RBI single by Daniel Dietz.

It was the sixth shutout in 17 games for Hart's pitching staff, an accomplishment that makes the Indians a team to watch for the Southern Section Division 1 playoffs. Hart is 14-3 and 5-1 in the Foothill League. Valencia is 12-2 and 4-1.

Cary Osborne Of The-Signal was there reporting on the game: Because the Signal Link won't be there forwever, I'm reproducing it here below:

Hart and Valencia baseball might have to start charging people for watching the two teams play.

For the second time in as many meetings, the game was decided by a walk-off hit.

On Wednesday, Hart second baseman Daniel Dietz's chop single in the bottom of the seventh inning ended the best pitchers' duel of the 2011 Foothill League season and gave the Indians a 1-0 victory over Valencia at Hart High.

"It's just two teams going after each other - two good teams," Dietz said. "You feel the intensity when we play each other."

And because of that, two teams raised the bar - more specifically, two pitchers raised the bar.

In front of a group of Major League scouts, Hart's Tyler Glasnow and Valencia's Nick Rivas solidified their star status. Glasnow was nearly untouchable, taking a no-hitter into the fifth inning.

He relied on a fastball and a cut fastball early and a curve ball late to keep the Vikings a step behind.

Despite walking six batters and surrendering one hit - a fifth-inning single to senior Alex Bishop - Glasnow gave a tremendous performance. He struck out 12 batters in 6 2/3 innings and threw 124 pitches.

"I slowed down early and wanted to throw strikes. I just really wanted to hit spots and keep it low," Glasnow said.

Those were keys.

He worked both sides of the strike zone with a fastball that read 91 MPH on one radar gun. But he got deep into counts all day, resulting in the free passes.

He exited the game in the seventh inning after a final walk to pinch hitter Jason Spigner.

Hart's Erik Vogel came in to relieve Glasnow, but allowed a single to Bishop, whose two singles accounted for Valencia's only hits in the game.

The Indians (14-3, 5-1) then turned to Garrett Gooding to face A.J. Balta. On the second pitch, Balta popped out to first base.

Prior to that, Valencia (12-2, 4-1) threatened Glasnow in the fifth with runners on first and second.

Reigning Foothill League Player of the Year Trey Williams then took a Glasnow pitch to the wall in right field where it fell into the glove of Kevin Bailey.

Hart, meanwhile, had little offense against Rivas, whose hard fastball and moving breaking stuff kept the Indians off base. They managed just two hits in the game.

Rivas - who was nearly as impressive as Glasnow, if not more - started the seventh inning by walking Baggio Saldivar, who reached base three times in the game with the first two times coming on hit by pitches, Tommy Bilbo pinch ran and was sacrificed over to second base. Rivas then got pinch hitter Connor O'Brien to ground out, but Bilbo moved over to third base. He got to 3-0 on Cole Gasper and Valencia decided to intentionally walk him.

"We get the force out at second, so ..." said Valencia head coach Jared Snyder on the thinking of giving Gasper the final ball for free. "If we don't walk the leadoff guy, it's a moot point."

But Dietz, the peskiest guy in the Foothill League because of his ability to get on base via his speed, the sharp hit, the ugly hit or the walk, was ready for his shot.

"I went up there confident," Dietz said. "Teams usually play me in. It's rare to not see an infield in. I thought, Go up there and swing it.'"

The first pitch he saw from Rivas, he chopped the ball hard past Valencia third baseman Parker Greenberg, bringing in the winning run.

"We matched them pitch for pitch," Snyder said. "It was unfortunate someone had to lose."

So after a walk-off home run by Shane Zeile in the bottom of the ninth in the 9-8 Valencia victory on March 30 and Wednesday's Hart win, what's next?

Maybe the most significant game of the Foothill League season. The league's top two teams finish their season series on Friday at Valencia.

Fortunately for everyone, there's no charge.
