HIGHLIGHTS of Game# 11-20: Hart 5, Saugus 9 (Foothill League Game # 9)

Hart can't overcome 9-0 deficit: Takes 9-5 Loss to Saugus

Erik Vogel started for/at Hart against Saugus and the first batter Connor Wilson slammed a homer to left. Andru Cardenas then doubled. With Nick Lombardi up Cardenas was stealing 3rd as the ball got away from Hart catcher Steve Rosso. Cardenas decided he could make it home on the wild pitch however Rosso's throw to Vogel at the plate was well ahead of Cardenas but Vogel dropped the ball and Hart was starting out bad and losing 2-0.

In the top of the 2nd with 2 out Vogel walked Saugus catcher Nick Warren. Connor Wilson who homered in the first doubled to right center.

Cardenas then singled in both runners and Hart was down 4-0.

In the top of the 3rd, Hart replaced Vogle with Bobby Stafford who was greeted by a long homer to Justin Sheehan. After a strikeout, Justin Donatella singled. Kyle Mark singled Donatella to 3rd and Mark took 2nd on the throw. A sacrifice fly by Roy Verdejo scored Donatella as Mark was taking 3rd and on a bad throw to the plate Mark was also able to score, making it Saugus 7-0.

It wasn't over. In the top of the 4th, Connor Wilson opened with his 3rd hit a single putting him a triple short of the cycle and a shot to get possibly 2 chances for the cycle.

After 2 outs, Singles by Sheehan, Austin Rodriguez and Donatella plated 2 more runs and Saugus led 9-0.

I commented at the time that when Spenser Souza hit for the Cycle in 2009 he helped put Hart ahead 9-0.

Then West Ranch rallied for 11 runs in the last 2 innings to beat Hart 11-9

Brad Buchignani started for Saugus and gave up only 2 hits and a walk through the first 3 innings.

In the 4th, Hart was down 9-0. Dallas Bacon doubled to the right center field gap. See note Below on most doubles in a season.

Alex Tenorio then unloaded a 2 run homer to straight away left. Hart was on the board 9-2.

Hey if WR could do it to us in 2009, no reason we couldn't do it here.

With 1 out Kevin Bailey bunted for a single and stole 2nd.

With 2 out Cole Gasper singled to left scoring Bailey.

Gasper took 2nd on a wild pitch.

Daniel Dietz singled hard to left scoring Gasper.

At the end of 4 innings, Hart had closed the gap to 9-4.

In the Hart 5th, Saugus brought in Dylan Freyre to relieve Brad Buchignani.

He immediately hit Luke Persico who stole 2nd.

Dallas Bacon grounded a single to center scoring Persico.

Alex Tenorio singled to left sending Bacon to 2nd.

So the score was 9-5, Hart had 2 on, NO out and the tying run was in the On Deck Circle.

Saugus then brought in their Ace Closer Nick Lombardi from 3rd base to pitch and try and get a 9 out save.

Lombardi immediately got out of the inning on a minimum number of pitches getting a strike out, Pop to 3rd and a fielder's choice.

In the 6th Lombardi gave up a line drive single to Garrett Gooding with 2 out.

He had a little problem in the bottom of the 7th, after getting an inning opening strikeout, he gave up consecutive singles to Alex Tenorio and Baggio Saldivar but got the next 2 batters to seal up the win.

So how did Hart stifle the Saugus batters after the 4th inning?.

Ricky Torres came in to pitch in the 5th and got all 9 batters he faced including getting 6 infield groundouts.

One of those ground outs was by Connor Wilson who was up in the 6th needing a triple for the cycle but grounded to short.

That double by Dallas Bacons in the 4th was his 9th double of the season, putting him in a tie with 7 others for 18th place for most doubles in a season. The record is held by Billy Susdorf with 19 doubles in 2001. Chris Valaika in 2003 and Jenzen Torres in 2007 had 15.

The Saugus baseball team entered its game against Hart tied for last place in the Foothill League standings.

That fact wasn't evident Friday.

Center fielder Connor Wilson led off the game with a solo home run to left field as the Centurions jumped out to a nine-run lead that the Indians couldn't overcome in a 9-5 win at Hart High School.

"We are 3-6 (in league), and three of those losses were by one run," said Saugus head coach John Maggiora. "We could easily be 6-3 and talking about first place or a game out. It shows it's a game of inches, and when the inches are there, you have to take them."

That's exactly what the Centurions (8-12, 3-6) did Friday, scoring at least two runs in each of the first four innings as starter Brad Buchignani cruised to open a 9-0 lead.

Both teams finished with 12 hits, and before long, it appeared as if Hart (15-5, 6-3) was on pace for a dramatic comeback.

But Saugus' Nick Lombardi threw three strong innings to close out the game.

"I don't think we played as bad as the score indicates. We hit the ball well," said Indians head coach Jim Ozella, who blamed himself for the loss. "It's not been a good week for us in a lot of ways. I'll take the (blame) for this."

Indians starter Erik Vogel entered the game with a 1.55 ERA, but was knocked out after the second inning down 4-0. Wilson's leadoff shot essentially opened the floodgates.

"It set a big tone," Wilson said. "For us to get off to a big start (was important). Not having a good history of coming from behind, it was big getting nine runs. I didn't think there was any way we'd lose that."

Andru Cardenas tacked on the second run by attempting to steal third on a wild pitch. Cardenas rounded the base for home, and the throw back to the plate was dropped, allowing the Centurion to slide in for a 2-0 lead. Cardenas added a two-run double to left-center field in the second inning, before a Justin Sheehan solo homer and a Roy Verdejo sacrifice fly ball to right put the Centurions up 7-0. On the sac fly, Justin Donatella scored from third, and Kyle Mark followed suit after a throwing error sent the ball to the backstop.

Saugus' final two runs came off RBI singles from Sheehan and Donatella in the fourth inning.

Then the Indians started to respond, scoring four runs in the bottom of the fourth thanks to a two-run home run by Alex Tenorio and RBI singles from Cole Gasper and Daniel Dietz.

"Hits are contagious," Tenorio said. "I just thought, 'Get on (base) for the team.' And I had Dallas (Bacon) in front of me with a nice double. Having a runner on second with no outs gives you confidence."

Buchignani left the game after the four-run frame, and was replaced by Dylan Freyre. Freyre allowed two hits, including an RBI single to Bacon that cut the lead to 9-5.

With no one out and two runners, Lombardi took over.

The senior got out of the inning unscathed on five pitches, including a three-pitch strikeout of Tyler Glasnow. "I just had the mind-set to come out there and strike out the next three guys," Lombardi said. "Hopefully, get out of the inning and get some momentum." Lombardi struck out three and allowed three hits. Buchignani earned the win, pitching four innings with two strikeouts and four earned runs on seven hits.

Wilson finished 3-for-4 with a double, stolen base and three runs, while four other Centurions finished 2-for-4.

Hart pitcher Ricky Torres took over for Bobby Stafford after the fourth inning, and proceeded to retire the next nine batters in order.

Vogel took the loss, allowing four runs on five hits with two strikeouts.

Bacon and Tenorio each batted 3-for-4.

"From every negative, a positive always occurs if you take the right steps," Ozella said. "We've got to take the right steps. And we will."
