Hart squeaks out 2-1 victory on 2 run single by Steve Rosso:

This game was too close for comfort.

Hart started out like it was going to have an easy game but it changed quickly in the bottom of the first inning. Daniel Dietz singled to right, Garrett Gooding beat out a bunt to first base, Dallas Bacon walked.

Hart had the bases loaded with no out. How did they come out?

A grounder to 3rd resulted in a force out at the plate followed by 2 strikeouts and Hart had zero to show for it.

Thereafter despite a very brisk wind blowing from left to right the game pretty much settled down into a pitchers duel for the first 4 innings.

Garret Gooding started for Hart and gave up a single to the leadoff batter Cole Mears, but picked him off.

In the 2nd a strikeout followed by an error and a single by Kevin Morrice in the second put 2 on and 1 out but Gooding induced a double play ball to short. from that point into the 5th he put down the next 6 batters in order including 3 strikeouts.

In the top of the 5th, Jacob King hit an easy fly ball to right but the wind playing havoc with fielders all game and the ball was dropped for an error. King was sacrificed to 2nd and then scored on a long double to right by Harry Bennett. Gooding ended the inning with 2 strikeouts but Canyon had struck first with an unearned run and led 1-0.

After the disaster in the first when Hart failed to score with the bases loaded and NO outs, Hart seemed thoroughly frustrated by the slow offerings of J.T. Arguellez. From the 2nd thru the 6th they only had 3 hits.

Steve Rosso singled in the 2nd to no avail. With 2 out in the 3rd Alex Tenorio and Luke Persico singled but Baggio Saldivar flied to center.

Until the bottom of the 6th Hart was hitting the first pitch and mostly making easy outs and the game was moving at a fast pace as Garrett Gooding was giving up only 3 hits including the RBI double in the 5th.

When they weren't easy outs, Canyon fielders were making sensational plays on several balls especially by the 3rd baseman Kevin Morrice.

In the 5th, Canyon catcher Patrick Roxbury made a great catch of a foul ball near the Canyon dugout.

Garrett Gooding hit a hot smash that went off the first baseman's glove right to the second baseman who then threw him out on a 3-4-3 play that had a single written all over it.

In the 6th. Alex Tenorio led off with a sharp single to left. Luke Persico sacrificed Tenorio to 2nd. Josh Brown ran for Tenorio. Baggio Saldivar hit a very high pop up on the infield that had all the Canyon infielders chasing around and it wound up dropping untouched near the mound. Kevin Bailey then hit a slow grounder to 3rd and was thrown out but it moved the runners to 2nd and 3rd.

Steve Rosso then hit a bullet that the pitcher somehow got his glove on but it was hit hard enough that it ticked off the second baseman's glove into right center field. Pinch runner Brown and Saldivar both scored, and Hart had an amazing 2-1 lead.

Gooding took the mound in the top of the 7th and quickly struck out the first two batters.

He almost struck out the 3rd batter Kevin Morrice, but he foul tipped it.

Then Morrice lined a single to right. Harry Bennett lined a single to right also, and Canyon had 2 on 2 out.

It was nervous time at the Hart diamond. Gooding then got Grant Westerson to hit a hard ground ball to Luke Persico at short and Hart had the victory in a game that took only 1 hour 45 minutes to complete.

I hear Valencia lost to West Ranch so Hart is tied with Valencia, although Valencia has the Tie Breaker on Hart despite the fact that the MaxPreps standings might show Hart in first tomorrow.

The Hart baseball team has been forced to come up with late runs on many occasions this year.

If the Indians' game against Canyon on Friday is any indication, they are getting good at it.

Garrett Gooding outdueled Cowboys starting pitcher J.T. Arguellez in his first home start in over a month, and Steve Rosso came up with a crucial two-run double in the sixth inning to give Hart a 2-1 win at Hart High School.

"We've shown a habit of being able to come back, and we've shown character and maturity," said Indians head coach Jim Ozella. "I think we did it again today."

Hart (17-5, 8-3) appeared poised to break the scoring open in the first after loading the bases with no outs, but Arguellez retired the next three batters in order, striking out the last two.

Both pitchers threw complete games.

Gooding totaled nine strikeouts and gave up one unearned run on four hits and one walk in his first home start since his one-hit 6-0 shutout of Golden Valley on March 18.

Arguellez struck out four, allowing eight hits, one walk and two earned runs.

With Canyon (9-14, 4-7) ahead 1-0, the Indians led off the sixth inning with a single by Alex Tenorio, and his pinch runner, Josh Brown, was advanced to second on a sacrifice bunt by Luke Persico. Baggio Saldivar followed with an infield single.

Two batters later, Rosso threaded a ground ball past Arguellez and a diving Cole Mears at second to score Brown and Saldivar.

"Garrett was throwing really well. It was good to get some runs on the board for him," Rosso said. "We've had a lot of come-from-behind wins. We stay focused for seven innings and never give up. When you get a win like this, it just motivates you going into the next games."

The last time Hart had to recover from a late hole was a 2-1 win over Saugus on April 20 in which the Indians scored two runs in the seventh inning.

The Cowboys, who played crisp, error-free defense the entire game, set up a similar situation Friday after Harry Bennett's RBI double in the fifth put Canyon up 1-0.

Cowboys outfielder Jacob King reached base to lead off the inning when his fly ball was dropped in right field. King moved to second on a sacrifice bunt by Kevin Morrice and came around to score when Bennett's fly ball carried deep over Kevin Bailey's head in right.

"We came out fighting hard and battled our butts off," Bennett said. "We are trying to get wins and get to the playoffs. ... We believe that as long as we get one or two runs, (Arguellez) is going to back us up as best as he can."

But with Hart's clutch sixth inning and Gooding's consistency on the mound, the Indians were able to recover and come out with the win.

"(Arguellez) was doing just as good as I was," Gooding said. "They got one run off me, so I knew I had to come out and put up zeroes."

Rosso and Tenorio both finished 2-for-3 for the Indians, while Bennett and Morrice wound up hitting 2-for-3 each for the Cowboys.
